Ault and Calvin Trigg, Ella McMillen and others and Thomas McMannis and others, ending at a road called Bellaire and Jacobsburgh Road, near residence of T. J. McKelvey in Mead Township, Belmont County, Ohio.*

They also fixed the 3rd day of November 1919, at 10 o'clock A. M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Belmont Chronicle a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.
