

ROAD PETITION

For the Alteration of a Road in Richland Township,
Improvement No. 113 Petitioned for by Grover C. McKelvey and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Alteration of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the Barnesville and St. Clairsville Road, in Section 25, Township 7, Range 4, Richland Township about 200 feet south of the Thomas McKelvey residence; thence westerly through the Thomas McKelvey farm and the lands of Julia Birdsong and Frank S. Waddell, to the Great Western and Lamira Road at a point near the Richland Township and Smith Township line. The same was

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

McKelvey, Jacob Parkinson and others are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, for the use of Belmont County, in the penal sum of One Hundred Dollars, to the payment of which well and truly to be made, we do hereby jointly and severally bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators.

The conditions of the above obligation are such, that WHEREAS, application has been made by Grover C. McKelvey and others to the Board of Commissioners of the said Belmont County, for the Alteration of a public road, on briefly the following line, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the Barnesville and St. Clairsville Road, in Section 25, Township 7, Range 4, R1 Richland Township, about 200 feet south of the Thomas McKelvey residence; thence westerly through the Thomas McKelvey farm and the lands of Julia Birdsong and Frank S. Waddell, to the Great Western and Lamira Road at a point near the Richland Township and Smith Township line.

THEREFORE if, 1st. The petition be not granted; or if, 2nd. The Commissioners shall order a portion of the compensation and damages to be paid by the petitioners, and the petitioners fail to pay same by the time fixed by the Commissioners: Then in either such case the said applicants will pay into the treasury of said County the COSTS AND EXPENSES incurred in the proceedings of said improvement.

McKelvey and others, in the Belmont Chronicle, a newspaper of general circulation in said county required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the Commissioners on this 12th day of September 19 21, met at the time and place in said notice designated and did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in writing on or before the 26th day of September 19 21, the time set for the hearing, and shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, accompanied with a statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation whose land is to be taken if the proposed improvement is established. Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than thirty feet nor more than sixty feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

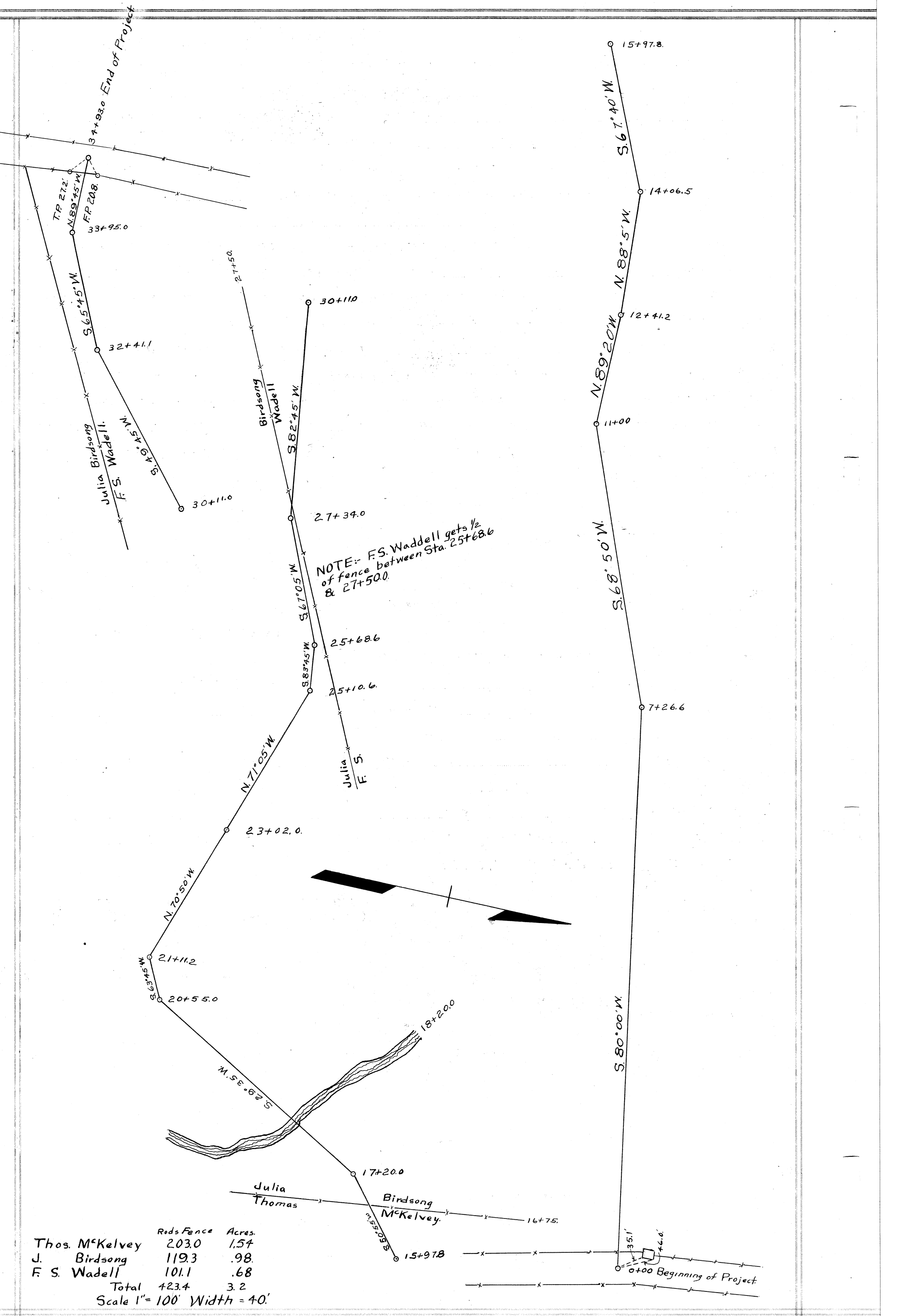
