Fogle Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that Albert Greenwood and others, have filed a petition in the office of the Commissioners of the County, on the 6th day of September 19 21, for the establishment of a

They also fixed the 17th day of October 19 21, at 1 o'clock P. M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Bellaire Daily Leader a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.
