

ROAD PETITION

For the vacation of a Road in Pease Township,
 Improvement No. 116 Petitioned for by Ed. Kizer and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the vacation of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning in the north line of the National Pike at a point about 100 feet west of the stone bridge crossing Wheeling Creek in Pease Township, Belmont County, Ohio; thence following Wheeling Creek Road north westerly to a point in said Wheeling Creek Road where another road leading to the National Pike intersects said Wheeling Creek road, said intersection being east of the Crymble reservation.

Kizer and others, have filed a petition in the office of the Commissioners of the County, on the 14th day of November 19 21, for the vacation of a

public road, along the following route, to-wit: Beginning

the same was this day considered by the Commissioners, and it appearing that said petition is regular and in conformity to law, and that the said Ed. Kizer has filed herein a bond as required by law. It is ordered that the 13th day of December 19 21, at 1 o'clock P. M., be fixed as a date to view the same, at which date they will meet at the commencing point and go over the route of said proposed road.

They also fixed the 3rd day of January 19 22, at 2:30 o'clock P.M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Martins Ferry Times a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

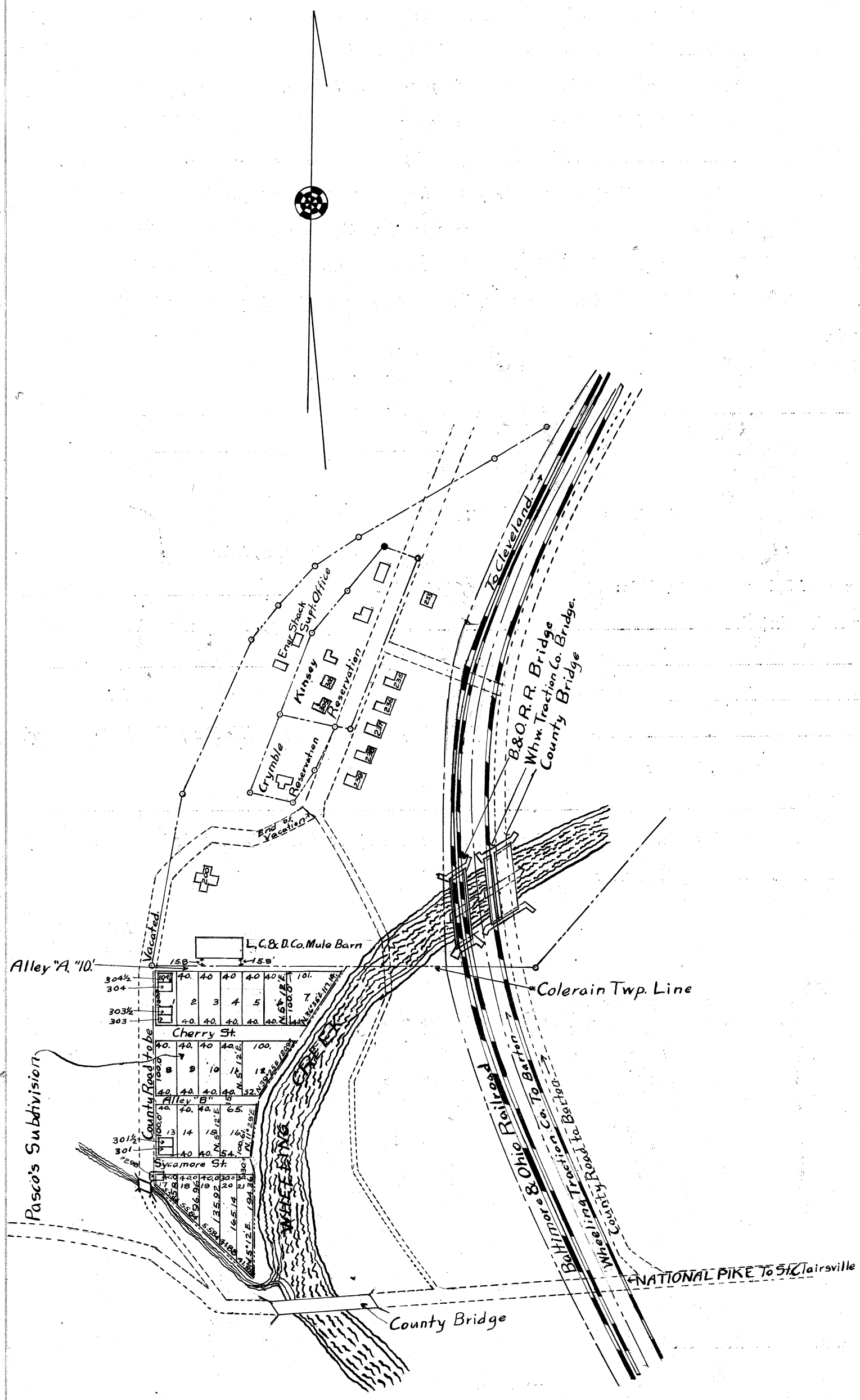
