

ROAD PETITION

For the Establishment of a Road in Pease Township, Improvement No. 117 Petitioned for by John Moore and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the establishment of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: *Beginning* at a point on the Ohio Valley Pike/leading from Bridgeport, to Bellaire, Ohio, at or near Stop No. 5, on the Wheeling Traction line running from said Bridgeport to said Bellaire, Ohio; thence in a westerly direction upand along what is commonly known as "Moores Run" (formerly Walkers Run), to a point on the lands now owned by James Caruth, and thence on said lands to a point on the lands of Joseph Deceife, and thence on the lands of The West Wheeling Coal Company to a point on said lands and the intersection of the Road leading from West Wheeling to the High Ridge Road leading from Bellaire, Ohio, to the National Road.

THEREFORE if, 1st. The petition be not granted; or if, 2nd. The Commissioners shall order a portion of the compensation and damages to be paid by the petitioners, and the petitioners fail to pay same by the time fixed by the Commissioners: Then in either such case the said applicants will pay into the treasury of said County the COSTS AND EXPENSES incurred in the proceedings of said improvement.

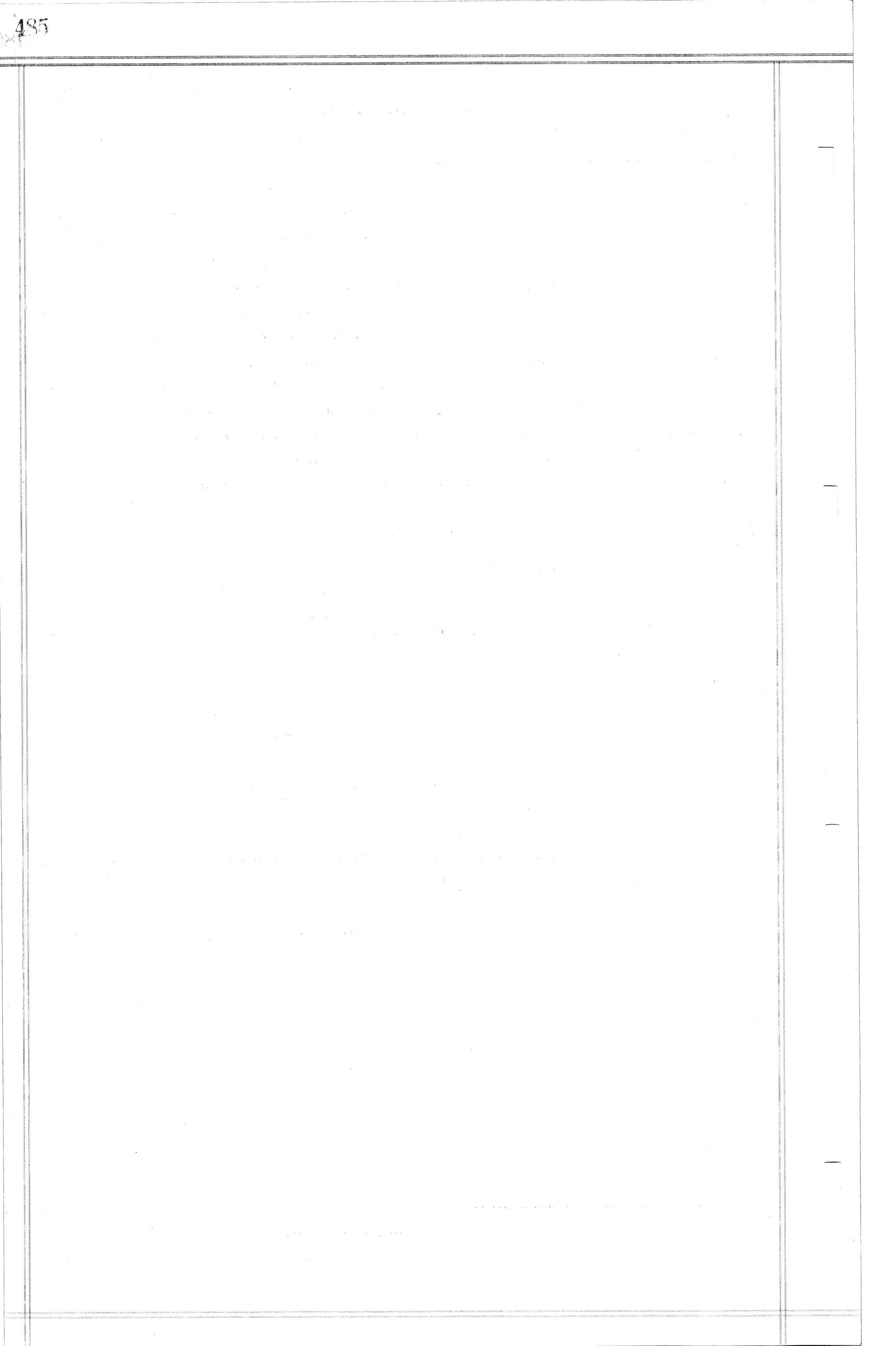
