

### ROAD PETITION

For the Establishment of a Road in Pultney Township,  
Improvement No. 120 Petitioned for by H. A. Dixon and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the establishment of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning in Section No. 7, Township 6 and Range 3, Pultney Township, Belmont County, Ohio, at a point near the old dwelling house on the farm of the late J. E. Dixon in the road leading from High Ridge Church to Neffs, Ohio; thence across the lands of the late J. E. Dixon to the lands of Fletcher Benson; thence across the lands of Fletcher Benson to the lands of Edward Kirby; thence across the lands of Edward Kirby to the lands of Charles Kirby; thence across the land of Charles Kirby to the lands of Godfrey Petran to the Cemetery road leading from the Bellaire and Neffs Pike to the Alexander cemetery thence on said road the Bellaire-Neff pike. Said road being about one mile in length.

compensation and damages to be paid by the petitioners, and the petitioners fail to pay same by the time fixed by the

AND EXPENSES incurred in the proceedings of said improvement.

Dixon and others, have filed a petition in the office of the Commissioners of the County, on the 10th day of November 19 21, for the establishment of a public road, along the following route, to-wit: Beginning

the same was this day considered by the Commissioners, and it appearing that said petition is regular and in conformity to law, and that the said H. A. Dixon has filed herein a bond as required by law. It is ordered that the 20th day of December 1921, at 10:30 o'clock A. M., be fixed as a date to view the same, at which date they will meet at the commencing point and go over the route of said proposed road.

They also fixed the 10th day of January 19 22, at 1 o'clock P. M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Bellaire Leader a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

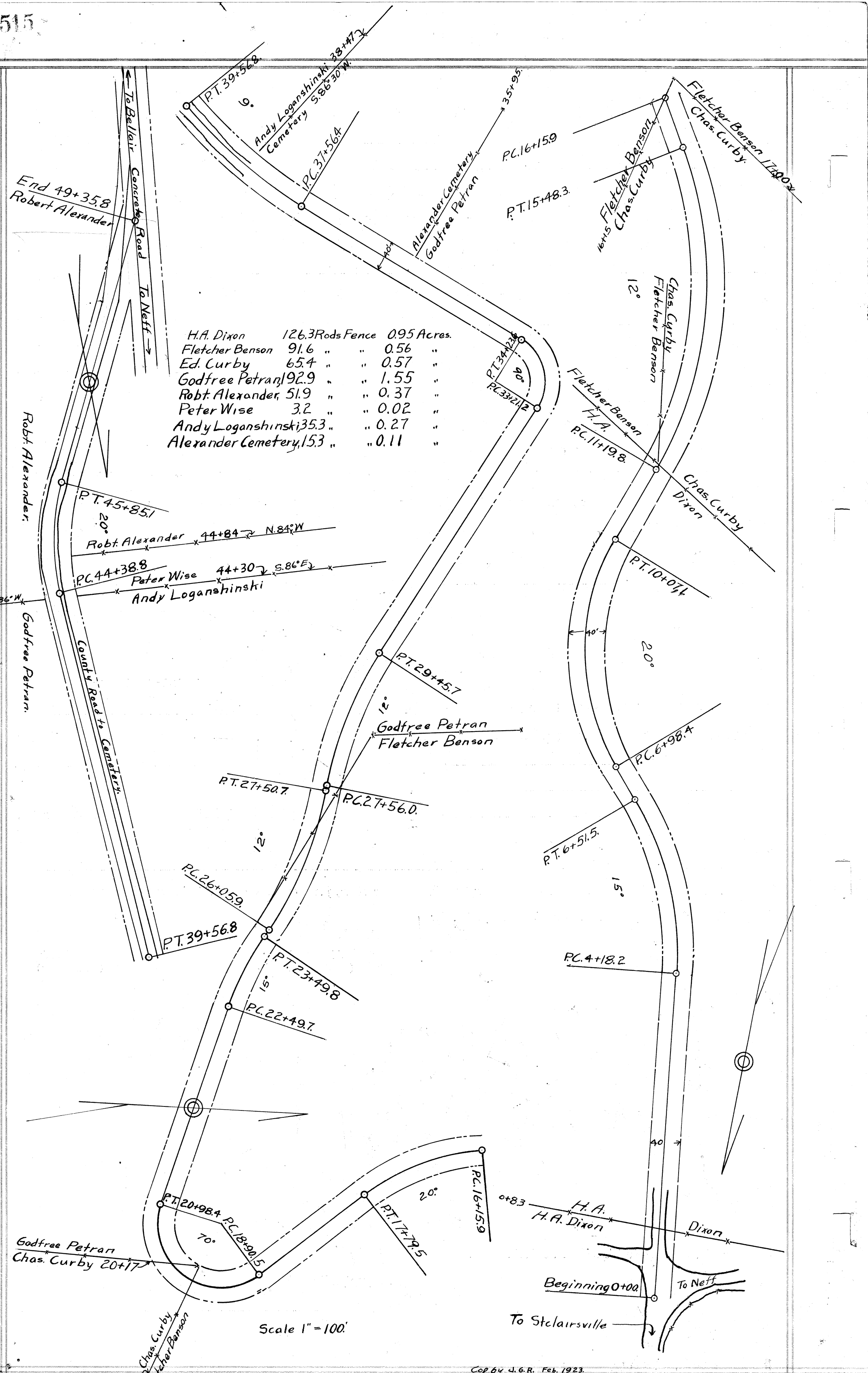
