

ROAD PETITION

For the Vacation of a Road in Union Township,
 Improvement No. 122 Petitioned for by Thomas D. Fritter and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the vacation of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning rods South from the center of Section (17) Township (8) and Range five (5) and running in an Easterly direction to a point east of T. D. Fritter's residence where it joins the road known as The Bannock, Lafferty and Mt. Hope Pike, the length of this piece of road is about (75) seventy five rods. The closing of this piece of road leaves an open road to the pike for all residences and users. on the line between mile Ogizovich and Thomas D. Fritter.

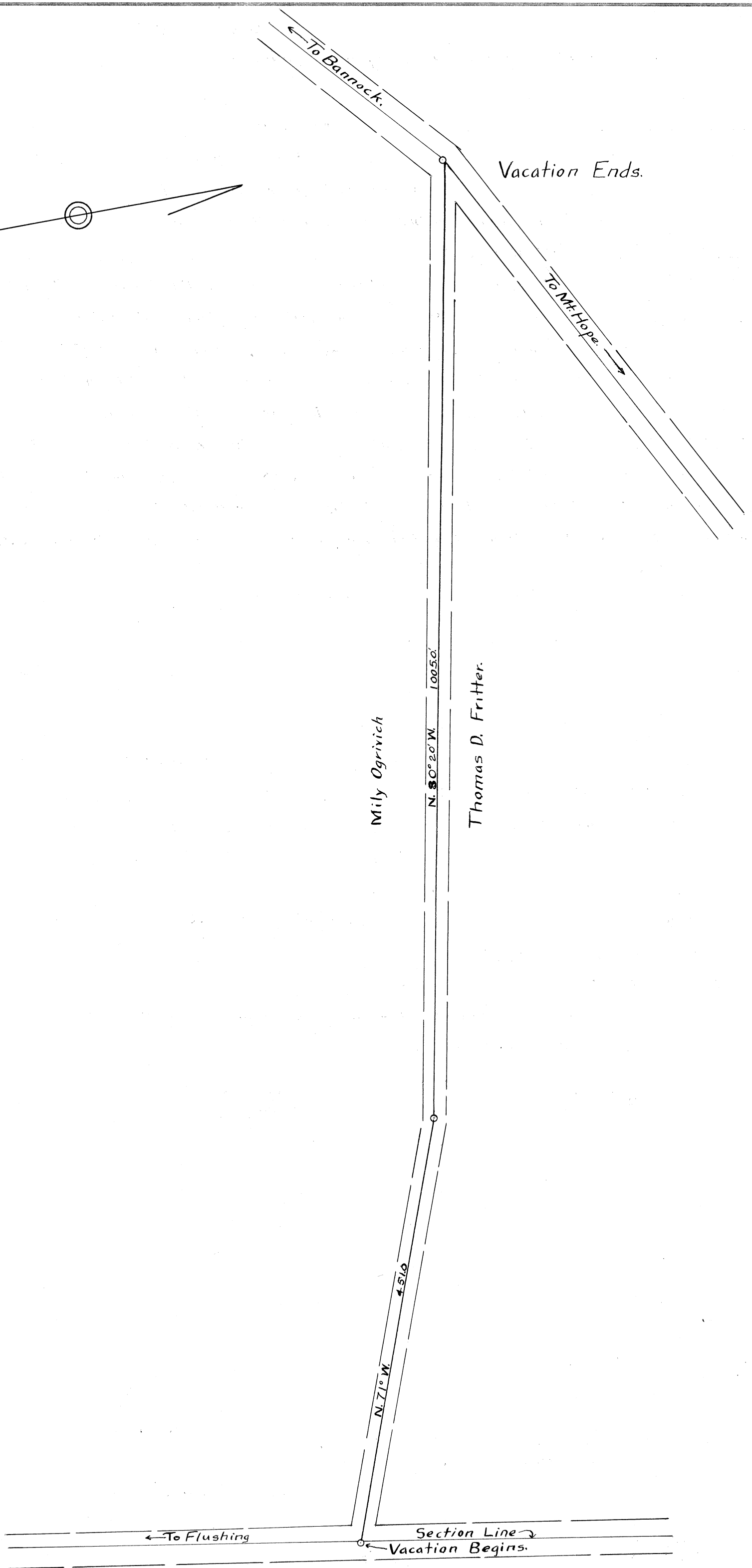
