

ROAD PETITION

For the Location and Establishment of a Road in Warren Township,
 Improvement No. 123 Petitioned for by Floyd Turner and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the location and establishment of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at a point in the public road about 900 feet North west from the Southwest corner of the South-east Quarter of Section 23, Township 8, in Range 6, in Warren Township, Belmont County, Ohio, and running thence in a North-west direction through the lands belonging to the estate of Alexander W. Ogg, deceased, and the lands of F. P. Hartley and Sarah P. Hartley, to a point near the barn on said Ogg lands; thence Westerly in the best general direction through said Ogg lands about 300 feet; thence Southerly and Southwesterly through the lands of F. P. Hartley and Sarah P. Hartley, and the lands of the heirs of Lewis Turner, deceased, to a point about 450 feet South of the South-west corner of said Section 23; thence Westerly in the best genral direction through the lands of D. S. Lowe to a gate on the public road leading from Fairview to Barnesville, Ohio, which gate is used as the present outlet from said lands of D. S. Lowe to said public road.

The conditions of the above obligation are such, that WHEREAS, application has been made by Floyd Turner and others to the Board of Commissioners of the said Belmont County, for the location and establishment of a public road, on briefly the following line, to-wit:

THEREFORE if, 1st. The petition be not granted; or if 2nd. The Commissioners shall order a portion of the compensation and damages to be paid by the petitioners, and the petitioners fail to pay same by the time fixed by the Commissioners: Then in either such case the said applicants will pay into the treasury of said County the COSTS AND EXPENSES incurred in the proceedings for said improvement.

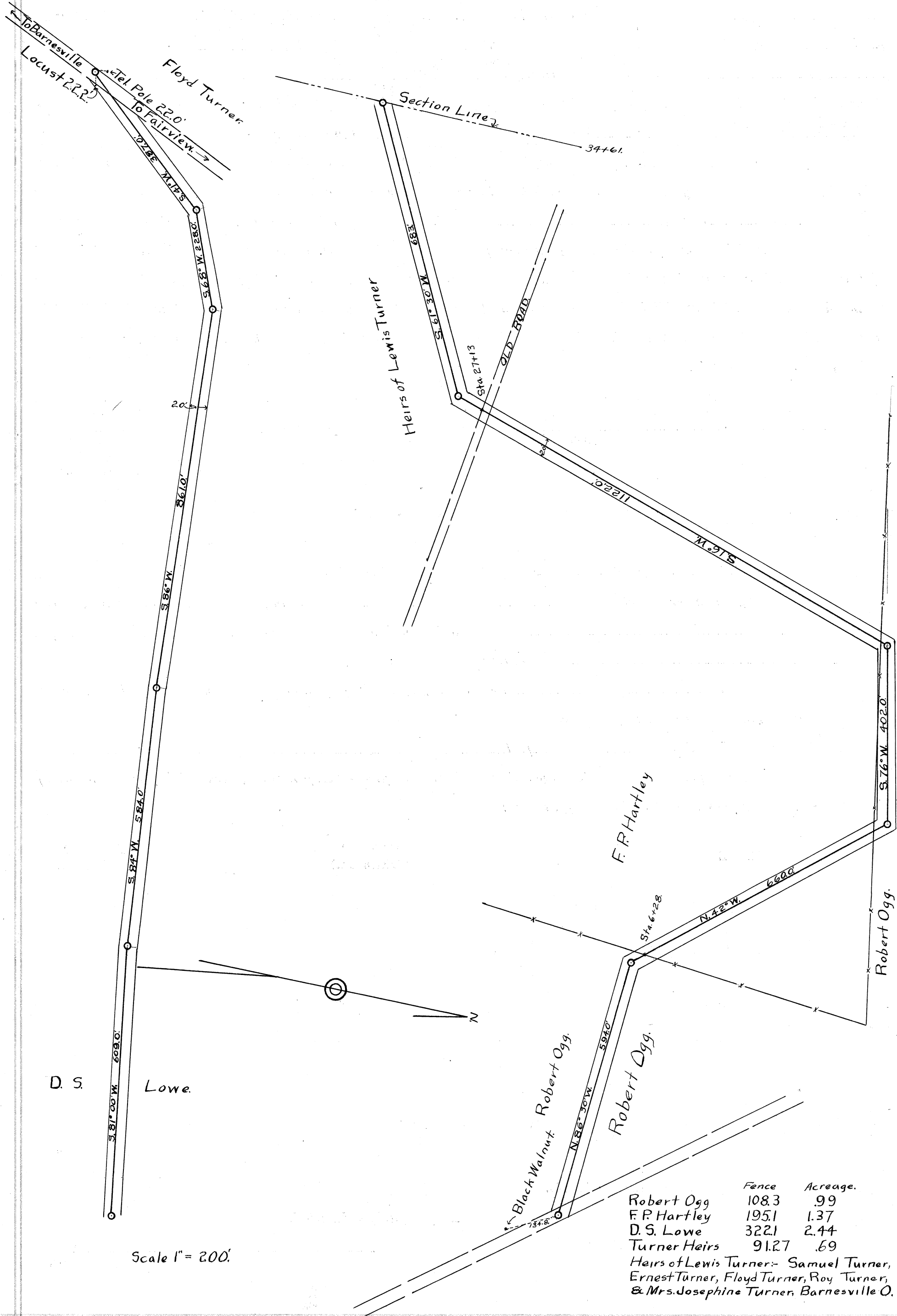
