

## ROAD PETITION

For the Vacation of a Road in Kirkwood Township,  
Improvement No. 125 Petitioned for by James A. Boyd and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the vacation of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at the James A. Boyd farm in Kirkwood Township, Belmont County, Ohio, on the paved brick road, and running thence nearly East through the lands of James A. Boyd and distance of about three hundred ~~yards~~ <sup>yards</sup>; thence nearly South, but bearing a little to the East, between the lands of James A. Boyd and Esther Acton a distance of about three eights of a mile; thence in the same direction nearly South through the lands belonging to the estate of Henderson M. Griffin, deceased, a distance of about three eighths of a mile to the public road known as the Sandy Hollow road.

THEREFORE if, 1st. The petition be not granted; or if, 2nd. The Commissioners shall order a portion of the compensation and damages to be paid by the petitioners, and the petitioners fail to pay same by the time fixed by the Commissioners: Then in either such case the said applicants will pay into the treasury of said County the COSTS AND EXPENSES incurred in the proceedings of said improvement.

Boyd Jr and others, have filed a petition in the office of the Commissioners of the County, on the 30th day of January 1922, for the vacation of a

public road, along the following route, to-wit: Beginning

the same was this day considered by the Commissioners, and it appearing that said petition is regular and in conformity to law, and that the said Joseph G. Boyd Jr. has filed herein a bond as required by law. It is ordered that the 28th day of February 19 22, at 10 o'clock A.M., be fixed as a date to view the same, at which date they will meet at the commencing point and go over the route of said proposed road.

They also fixed the 27th day of March 19 22, at 1 o'clock P.M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Barnesville Enterprise a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

Boyd, Jr and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view road petitioned for by Joseph G. Boyd, Jr. and others, in the Barnesville Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in said county required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the Commissioners on this 28th day of February 19 22, met at the time and place in said notice designated and did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in writing on or before the 10th day of April 1922, the time set for the hearing, and shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, accompanied with a statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation whose land is to be taken if the proposed improvement is established. Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than thirty feet nor more than sixty feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

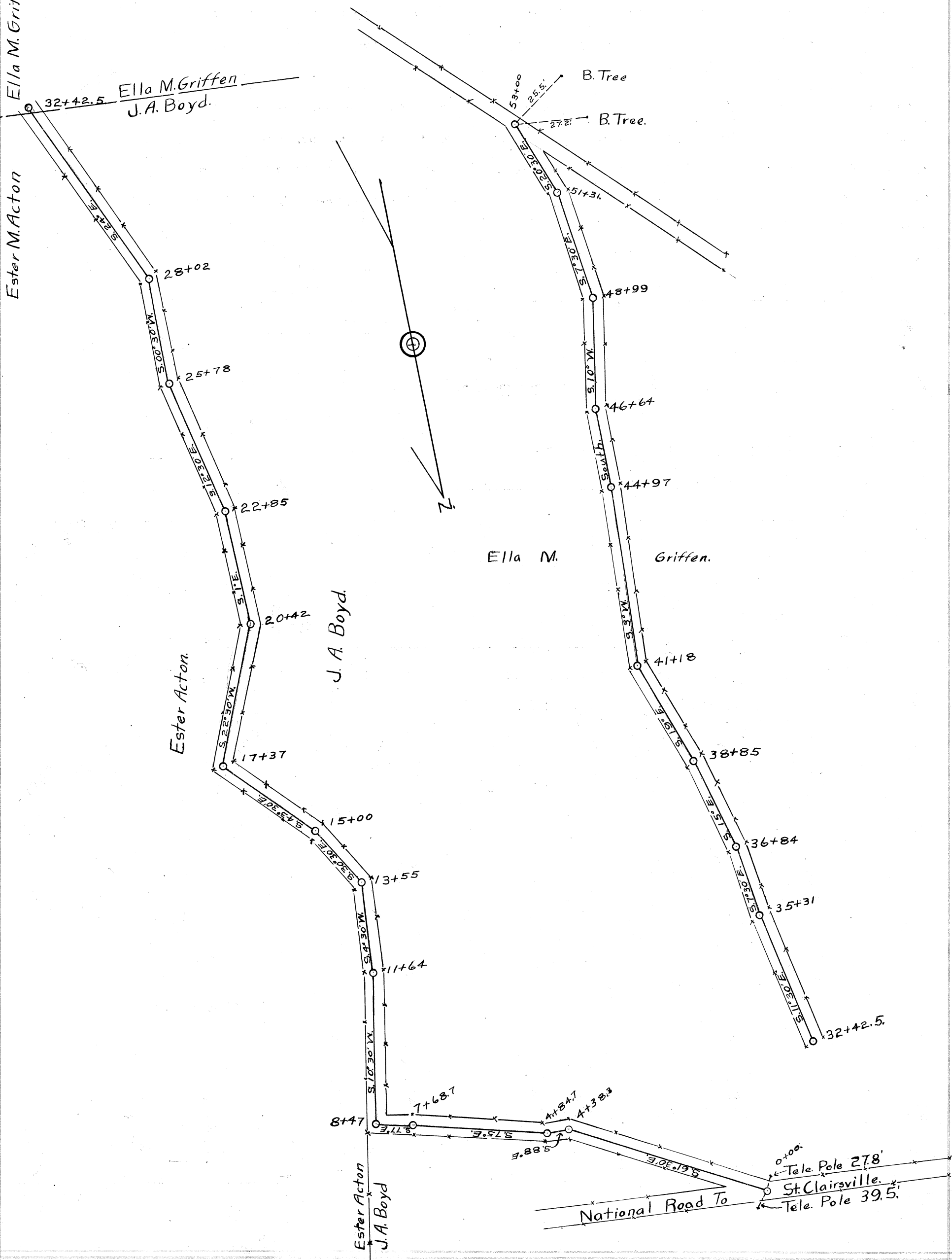
