

ROAD PETITION

For the Re-location and Construction of a Road in Wayne and Washington Township,
Improvement No. 126 Petitioned for by William Crooks and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the re-location and construction of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning on the Crabapple Road at the boundary line of the Townships of Wayne and Washington; thence through the lands of James Phillips, thence through the lands of Frank Shepherd, thence through the lands of Isaiah Phillips, thence through the lands of Loga Perkins and Minnie Perkins to intersect the Belmont Ridge Road near the Road leading up from Piney Creek.

The Commissioners shall order a portion of the compensation and damages to be paid by the petitioners, and the petitioners fail to pay same by the time fixed by the Commissioners: Then in either such case the said applicants will pay into the treasury of said County the COSTS AND EXPENSES incurred in the proceedings of said improvement.

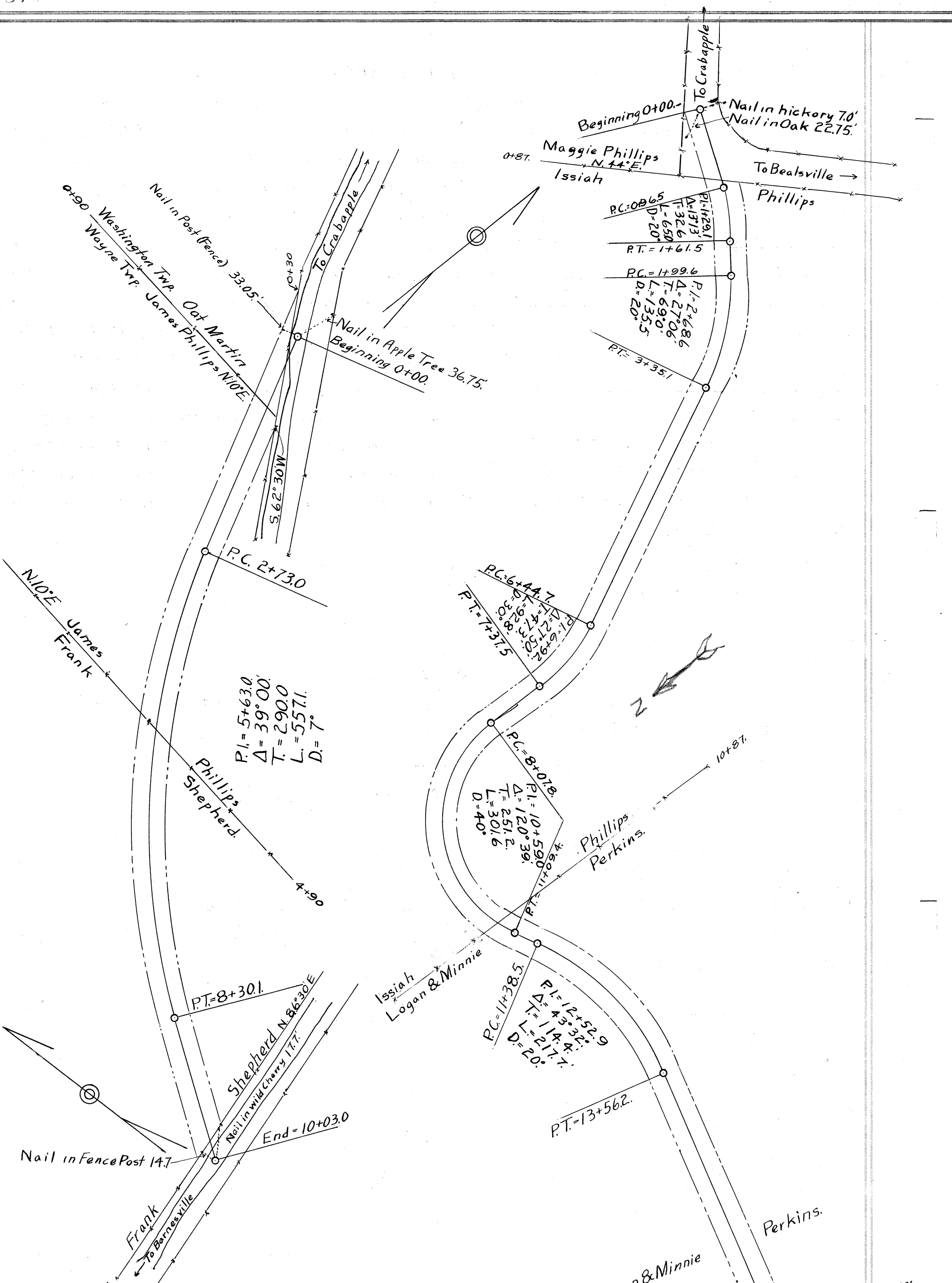
