

ROAD PETITION

For the Reviewing and opening of a Road in Washington Township,
Improvement No. 127 Petitioned for by T. W. Brown and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the reviewing and opening of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at the foot of the hill of the Brown-Williamson Road, thence in an Easterly direction through the lands of L. G. Moore to Piney Creek; thence erecting a bridge across said creek; thence in an easterly direction through the lands of Crawford Perkins intersecting the Belmont Ridge Road at the residence of the said Crawford Perkins.

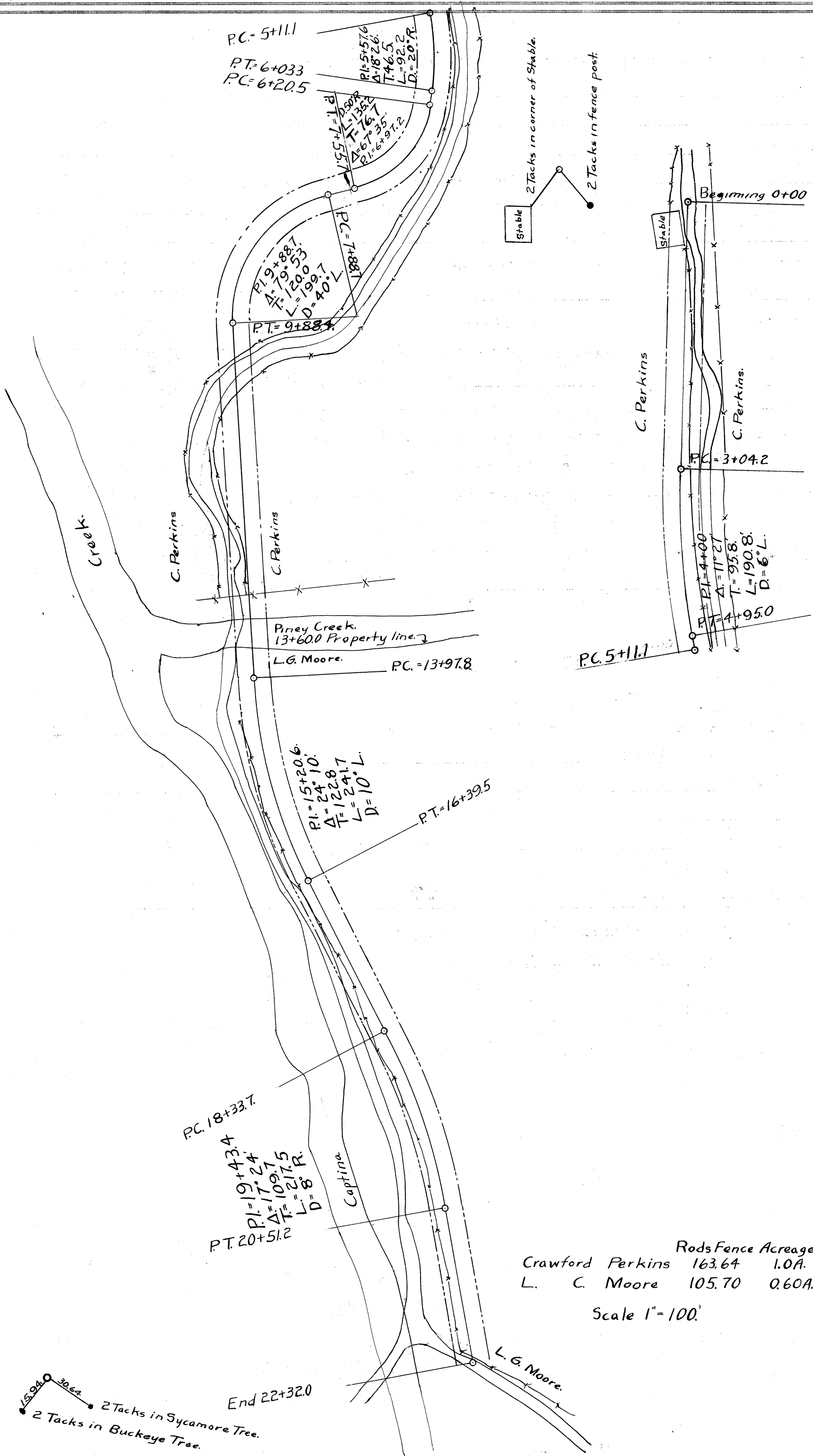
