

## ROAD PETITION

For the Establishment of a Road in Warren Township,  
 Improvement No. 128 Petitioned for by Frank Huntsman and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

*The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the establishment of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning for the same on the West side of the paved road leading from Barnesville to the National Road about three miles North of Barnesville, and on the Ida Harper farm at the present private roadway leading in a westerly direction; thence running in a general westerly or northwesterly direction with said private roadway across the lands of said Ida Harper, and Lurilla C. Hamilton to intersect the present public highway at or near the orchard on the farm occupied by Jack Walker.*

The conditions of the above obligation are such, that WHEREAS, application has been made by  
Frank Huntsman and others to the Board of Commissioners of the said Bel-  
mont County, for the establishment of a public road, on briefly the following line, to-wit:

THEREFORE if, 1st. The petition be not granted; or if 2nd. The Commissioners shall order a portion of the  
compensation and damages to be paid by the petitioners, and the petitioners fail to pay same by the time fixed by the  
Commissioners: Then in either such case the said applicants will pay into the treasury of said County the COSTS  
AND EXPENSES incurred in the proceedings for said improvement.

Fogle Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that Frank Huntsman and others, have filed a petition in the office of the Commissioners of the County, on the 3rd day of August 1921 for the establishment of a public road, along the following route, to-wit: Beginning

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Barnesville Whetstone a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

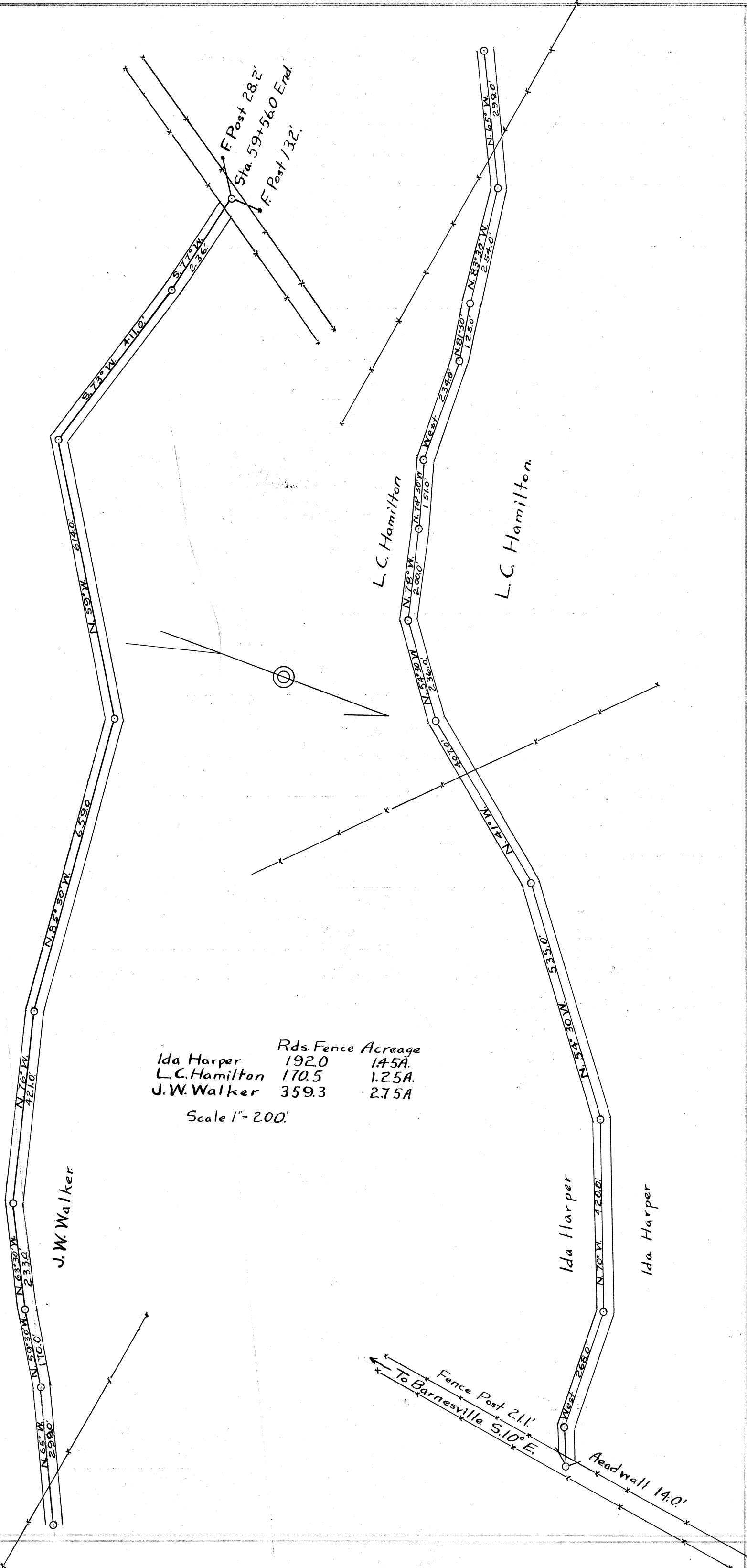
