

ROAD PETITION

For the construction of a Road in Warren Township, Improvement No. 210 Petitioned for by J. F. Hinds and Others TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the,proposed improve- ment hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the construction of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning At a point on the Public Road leading from Barnesville to Fairview, said beginning point being South 100 feet and West 200 feet from the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of Section 30, Township 8 and Range 6 in said County, running thence in a Southwesterly direction across the lands of J. F. Hinds to a point about 50 feet Northwest of the J. F. Hinds residence; thence in a Southwesterly direction continuing across the lands of said J. F. Hinds to a point about 100 feet North of the Southwest corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 30; thence in a Northwesterly direction across the lands of Luther Cowgill to a point near a Coal Bank on the West side of the Creek; thence in a Southwesterly direction to the South side of the residence of the lands of Luther Cowgill and to the Public Road leading from Fairview to Barnesville a distance of approximately one mile.

Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than thirty feet nor more than sixty feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

Pursuant to your order dated September 20, 1927, I make my report to you as follows, in the matter of the construction of the public road petitioned for by J. F. Hinds and others.

1. My opinion is that the granting of the improvement; but with the following changes, which in my judgment should be made, to-wit: is necessary.
2. The width should be 40 feet.
3. Estimated compensation and damages, due each person, firm or corporation (with a * before the name of each minor or other person under disability), to-wit:

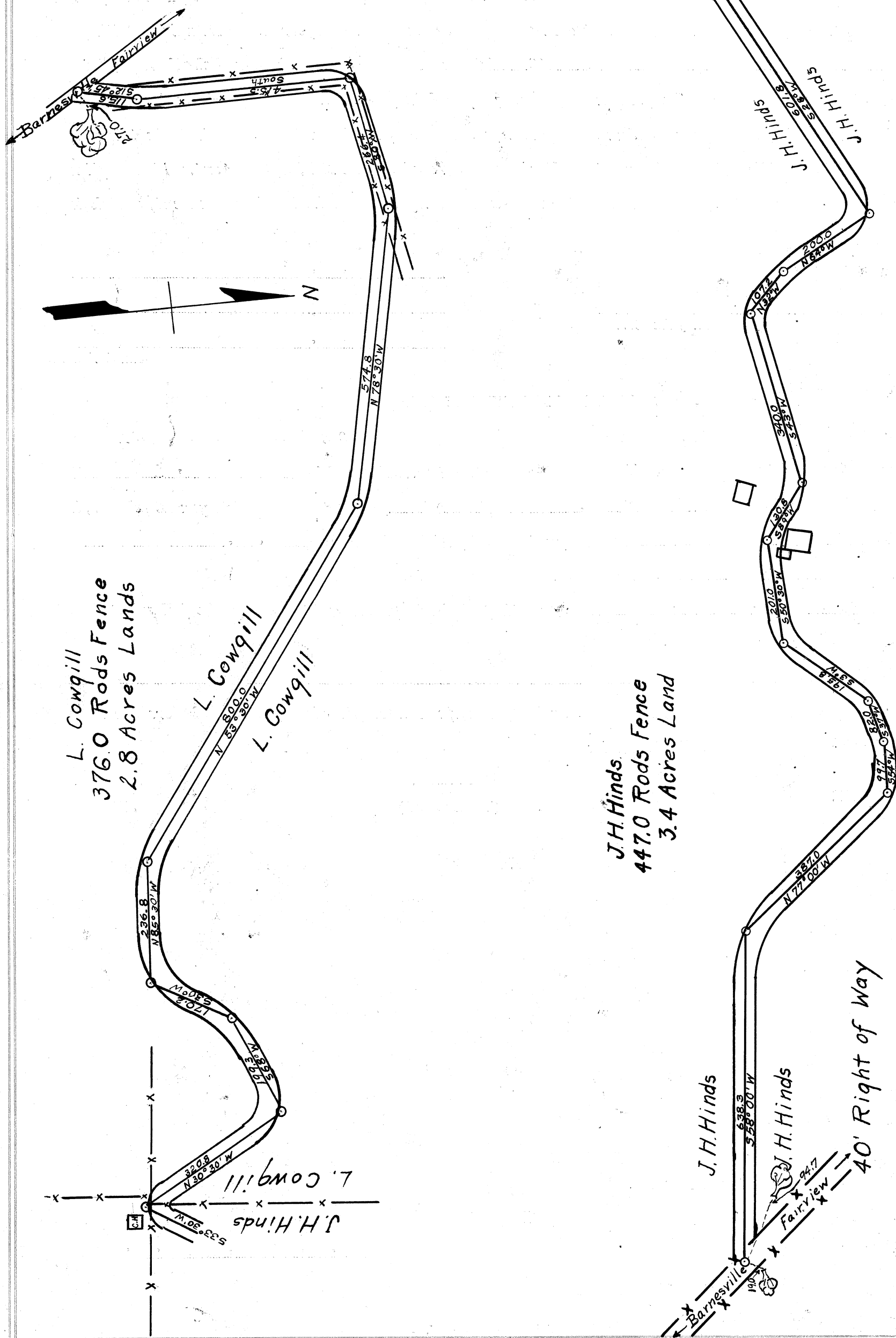
