the N. E. Quarter of Sec. 22 of said Wayne Township, Belmont County, Ohio, thence in a north-west
direction to the most suitable point on the line separating the lands of Martha Sutton and Mary
J. Thomas; thence west along said line to the south-west corner of the lands of the said Wartha
Sutton; thence south-west and north-west in curved line conforming to and following the contour
of the lands of Nathan E. McFarling; thence north of, but parallel with the present road to some
suitable point on the lands of Chas. Briggs on or near the northeast base of the hill on the
south part of the lands of said Chas. Briggs; thence around the north side of said hill to some
point near a clump of oak trees on the line between the lands of Chas. Briggs and Fletcher Wilcox
thence in a south-west direction to some point in the present road near the forks of the road
leading to buildings on the lands of C. H. Winland.


