

ROAD PETITION

For the vacation of a Road in Flushing Township,
Improvement No. 328 Petitioned for by Geo. W. Brokaw and Others
TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the vacation of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning
Being a township road leading from the Brokaw School House running south and intersecting a township road which leads from Uniontown and Flushing County Road going north. The portion which we ask for closing would be that part of said road beginning at about 150 feet from a creek located on the property of John L. Cunnard. Thence running west 500 feet abutting the John L. Cunnard farm, thence north 300 feet on the land abutting the John L. Cunnard farm. Thence west 500 feet along the land abutting the John L. Cunnard farm. Thence north 40 rods abutting the lands of Geo. W. Brokaw and John L. Cunnard. Thence north along the Campbell Heirs and the Geo. W. Brokaw farms to a point within 50 feet of the farm gate leading into the farm of the Campbell Heirs.

They also fixed the 11th day of April 1932, at 1.30 o'clock P.M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Daily Times a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.
