The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improve-
ment hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the vacation
of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and
order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning
At the intersection of the Hunter and New Castle Road southeast, running parallel with State
Route #148 in a northwest direction and intersecting with State Route #148 on the lands of Fred
Russell Heirs and the northwest boundary of the following described property.
Being a part of the northwest quarter of Section 10, Township 6 and Range 5 and bounded as follows
Beginning at the southwest corner of said quarter section at a stone, thence east 71-28 rods to
the west side of Captina Creek; thence up said creek north 40 degrees east 58-8; thence north 172
degrees west 54-72 rods; thence south 792 degrees west 91-8 rods to the west boundary of said
section; thence 80-78 rods to the place of beginning.
This road has been abandoned by the public and has become a nuisance to the community as a whole
is used by undesirable persons.


