TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the location -----

Daniel in Wheeling Township; thence thru the lands of Alice Chicksa in Wheeling Township; thence thru the lands of Harris heirs in Richland Township; thence thru the lands of Newell Barnes in Richland Township to a point in the road which leads to State Route #9. Also a short stub starting on the J. C. Daniel farm in a northerly direction to the lands of Louie Triplett all in Wheeling Township.

3. Estimated compensation and damages, due each person, firm or corporation (with a * before the name of each minor or other person under disability), to-wit:

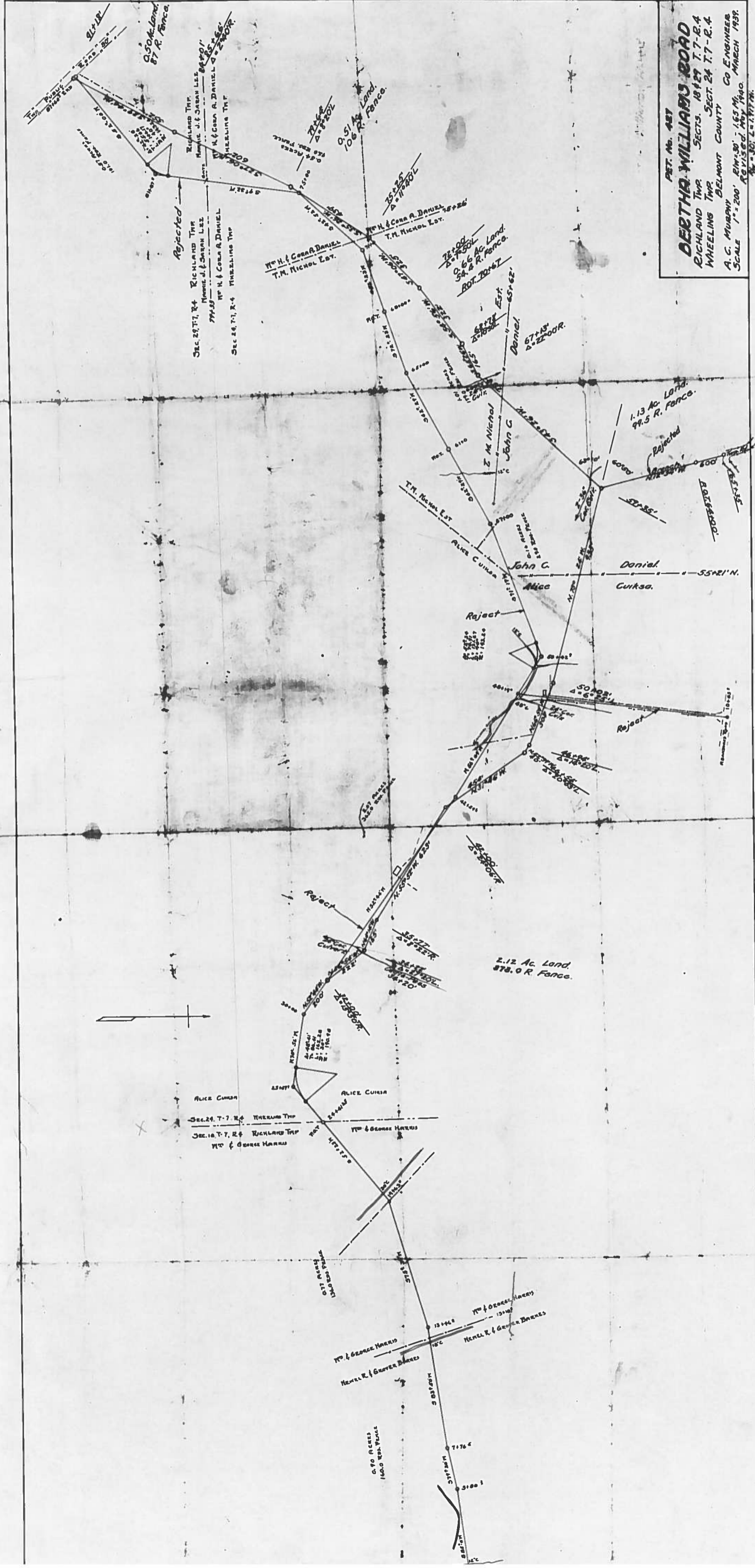

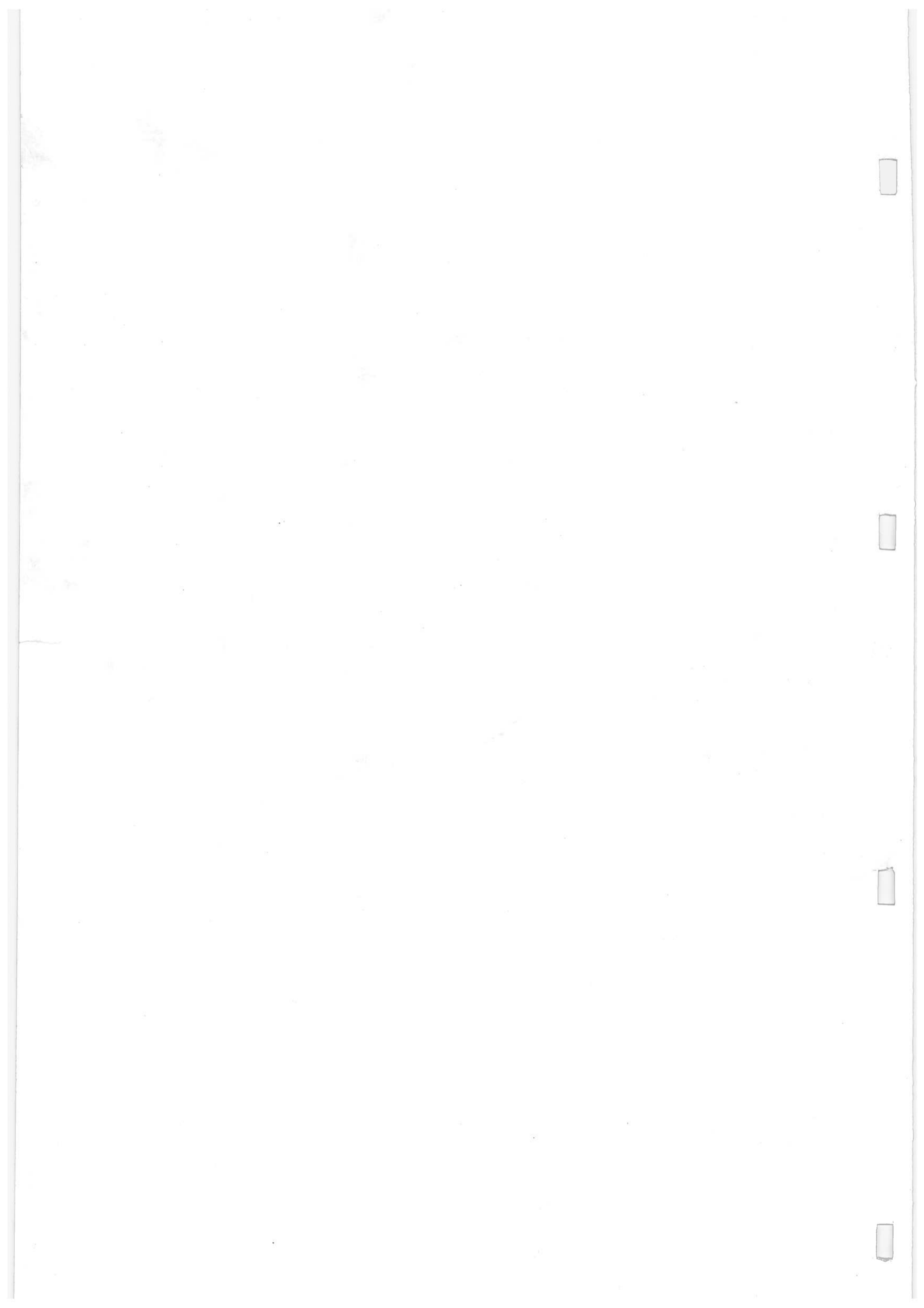
