For the Establishment of a Road in Colerain Township,
Improvement No. 483 Petitioned for by Arthur Hrabak and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Establishment of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order

the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning ~~page~~ at a point from which the s. w. corner of lot #1 of Maynard bears N. 20° 50' E. 150 0', said point of begining is on the east side of the St. C. - Maynard Harrisville Rd. (county highway # 12), thence parrellel to and 15' south of the south line of lot #1, of Maynard, S. 690 0', E. 124' more or less, thense north 750 0' E. 1450 0' more or less to a point which is 15' East of the east line of the Lorain Coal and Dock companies 44' strip of land, thence 15' east of said east line of 44' strip of land, N. 130 10', W. 355' more or less, thence S. 760 50', W. 55' more or less to the end at a point in the East line of the St. C. - Maynard - Harrisville road (county highway #12) from said point or end, the N. W. corner of lot # 12 of Maynard bears S. 200 50', W. 190 0'.

It is ordered that the 16th day of Nov. 19 44, at 1.30 o'clock P. They also fixed the 20th day of Nov. 19 44, at 3.00 o'clock P. M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

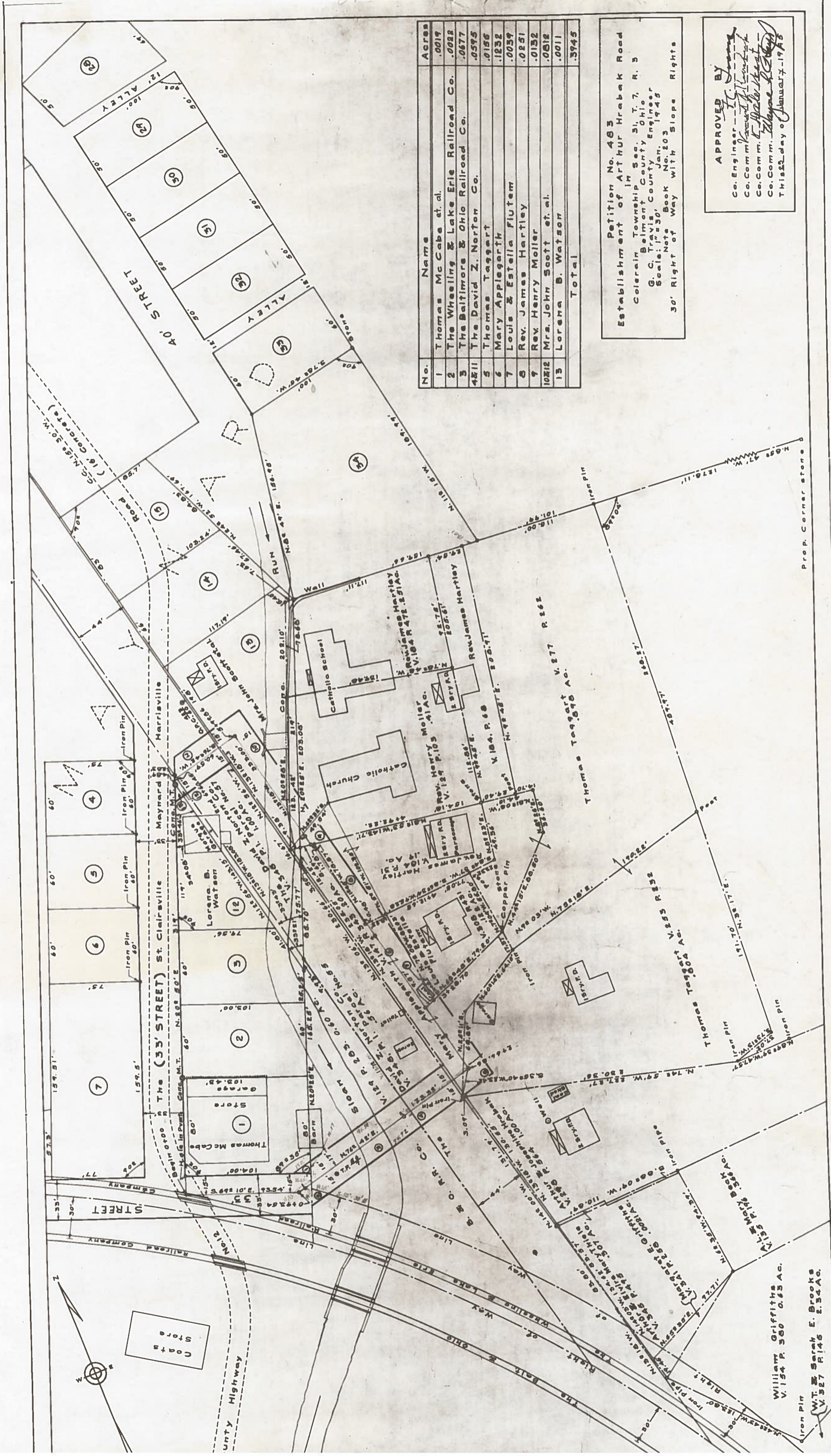

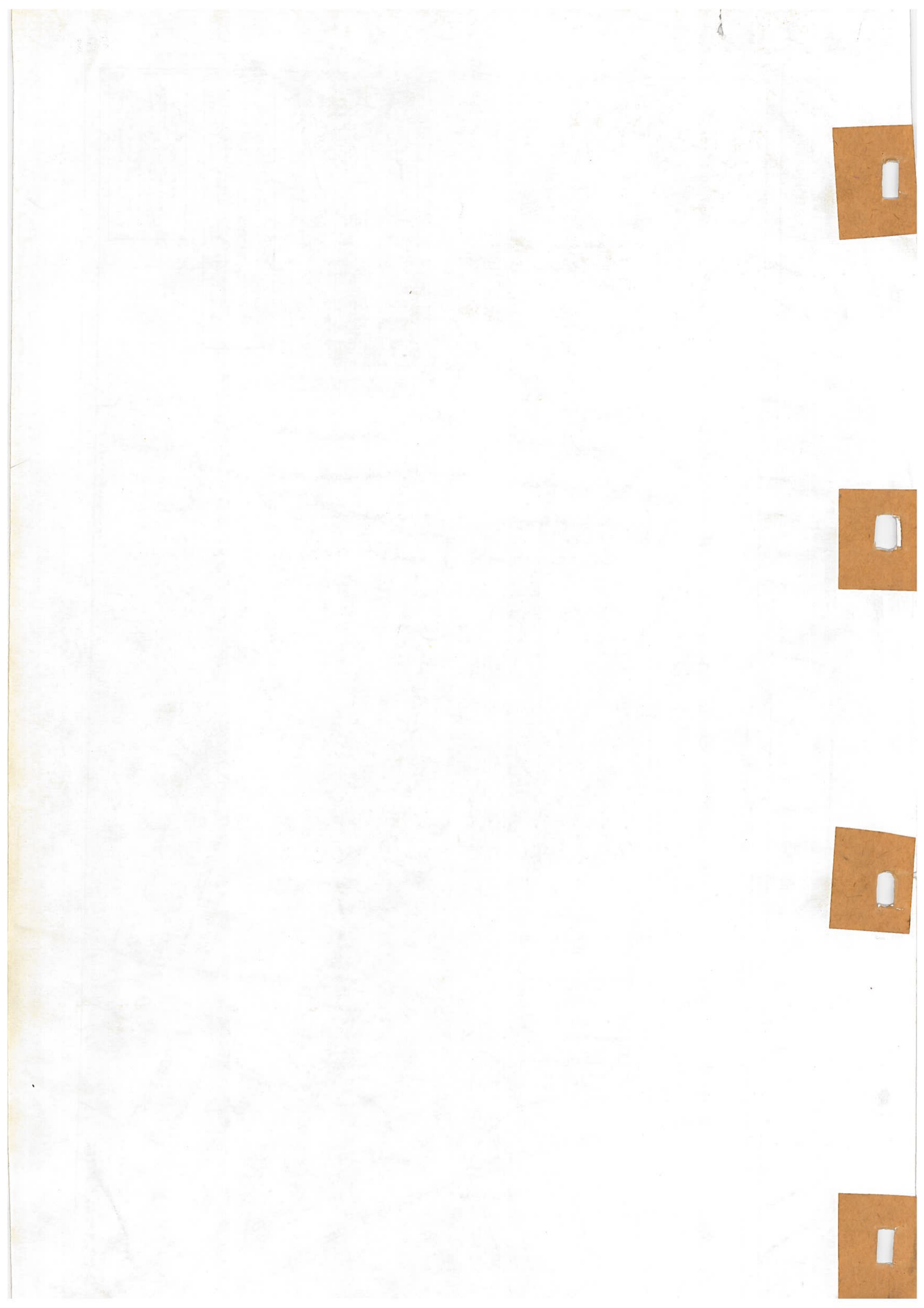
