TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Vacation & Relocation Of a part Co. Rd. #16 of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at a point in the center of County Road No. 16, said northerly terminus point being located in the Southeast quarter of Section 33, Wheeling Twp. 8, Range 4, Belmont County, Ohio, about 472 Ft. east of the Western boundary of the Southeast quarter of Section 33 & about 224 feet South of the Northern Boundary of the Southeast quarter of Section 33; thence along the center line of County Road No. 16 the following: Southeasterly 1095 feet more or less; thence Southwesterly 2365 feet more or less, to a point in the center of County Road No. 16, at the southern terminus of portion herein petitioned for temporary, now permanent vacation, said Southern terminus is referenced as follows: from the Northwest Corner of Section 32, S. 2°-16' W. 2940.10 feet along the Western boundary of Section 32; thence at right angles to the Section line S. 87°-44' E. 2775.45 feet to the Southern terminus point. All of the foregoing described Road is in Sections 32 & 33, the total length of which is 5996 feet more or less. The temporary vacation is herein petitioned for a period of five (5) years.

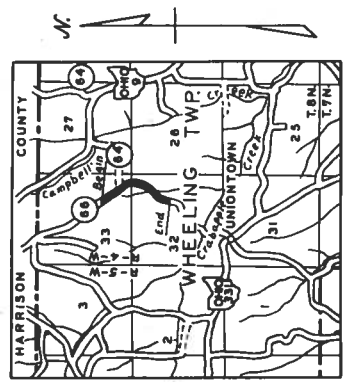
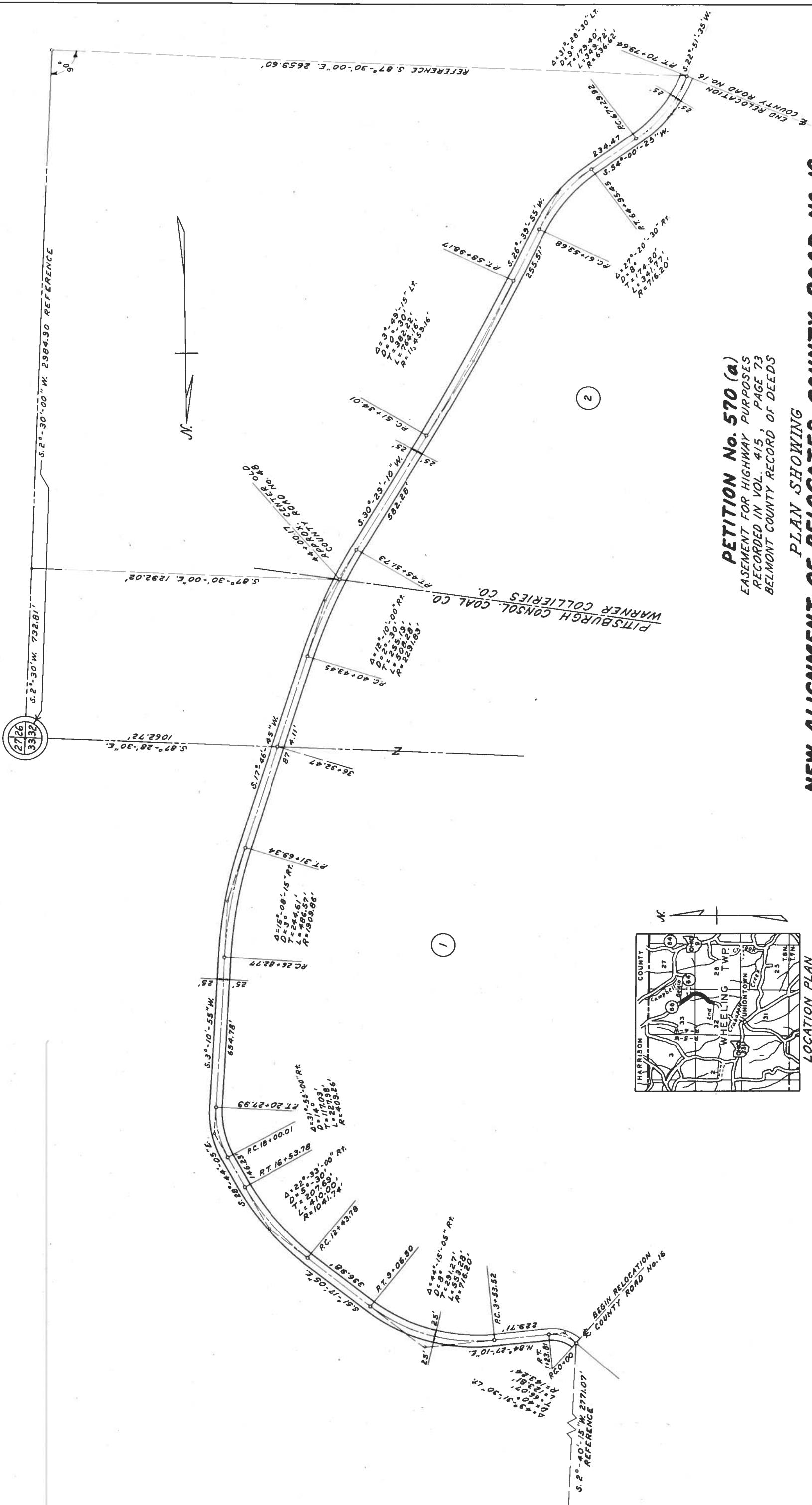
