For the Vacation of a Twp. ~~of a~~ Road in Wheeling Township,
Improvement No. 570-d Petitioned for by The Pittsburgh Consolidation Coal Co. and Others
TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Vacation

..... of a ~~Public~~ ^{Twp.} Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at a point at the intersection of County Road No. 48 and the Township Road Herein petitioned to be Vacated, said westerly terminus point of herein petition being located in the northeast quarter of Section 32, Wheeling Township, Twp. 8, Range 4, Belmont County, Ohio, about 800 feet south of the north boundary of Section 32 and about 20 feet west of the eastern boundary of Section 32; thence along the center line of the Township road herein petitioned to be vacated the following: In a Southerly direction 485 feet more or less; thence in a Southeasterly direction 5662 feet more or less to the eastern terminus of Township Road herein petitioned to be vacated, said point is referenced as bearing S. 87°-14'-10"E. 3587.17 feet from the southwest corner of Section 26. All of the foregoing described township road is in Section 26 and 32, the total length of which is 6147 feet more or less.

 once a week for three consecutive weeks in the St. Clairsville Gazette a newspaper published and
 having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

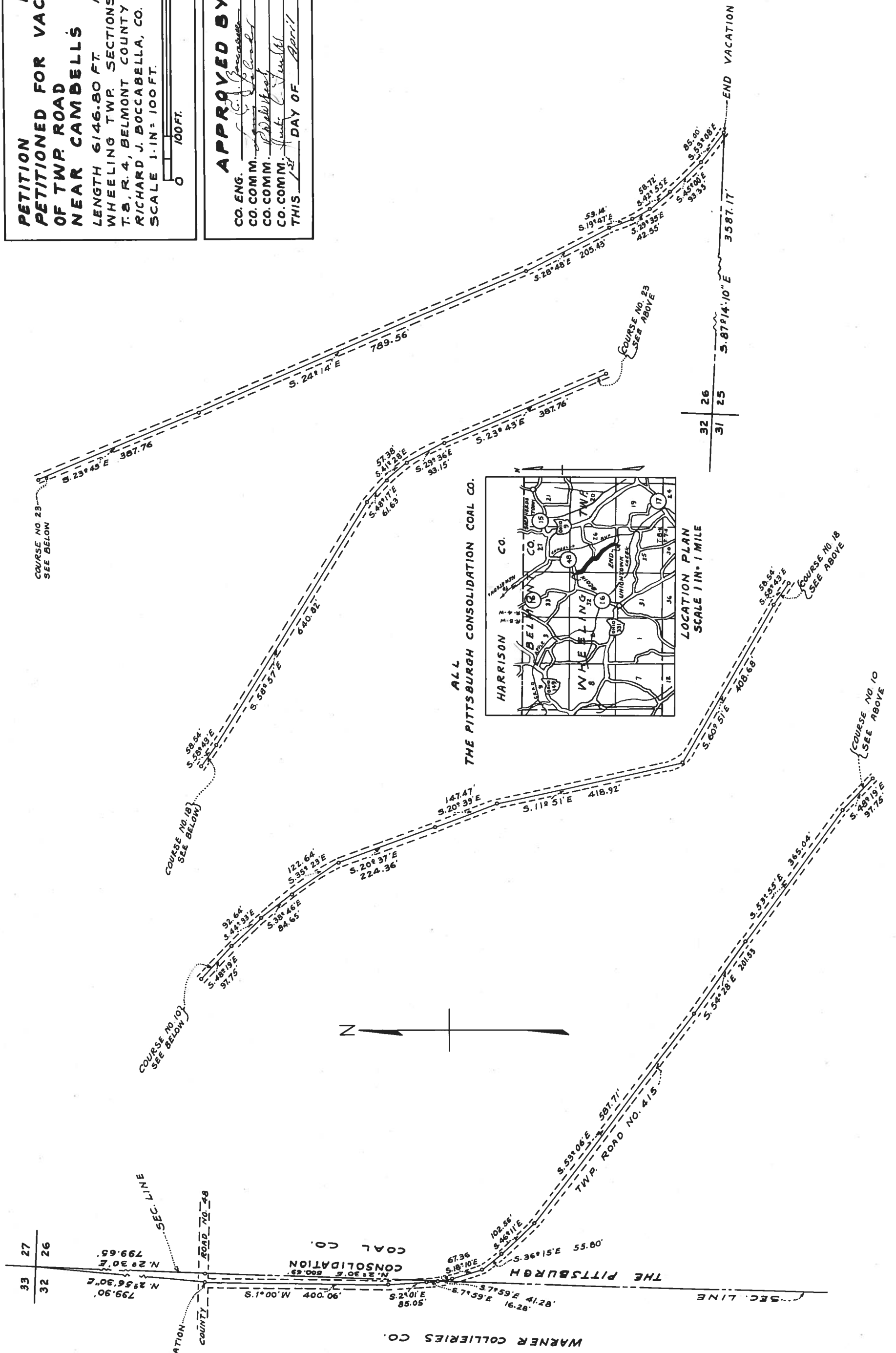
