Hartley and others, have filed a petition in the office of the Commissioners of the County, on the 29th day of July 1953 for the Establishment of a public road, along the following route, to-wit: Beginning

the same was this day considered by the Commissioners, and it appearing that said petition is regular and in conformity to law, and that the said Silas H. Hartley has filed herein a bond as required by law. It is ordered that the 9th day of Sept. 1953, at 2:30 o'clock P.M., be fixed as a date to view the same, at which date they will meet at Commencing Point and go over the route of said proposed road.

They also fixed the 21st day of Sept. 1953, at 11 o'clock A.M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Barnesville Whetstone a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

Hartley and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view road petitioned for by Silas N. 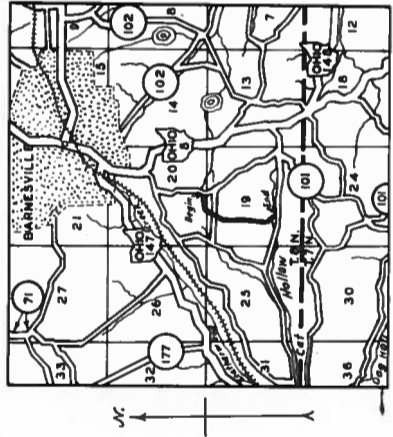

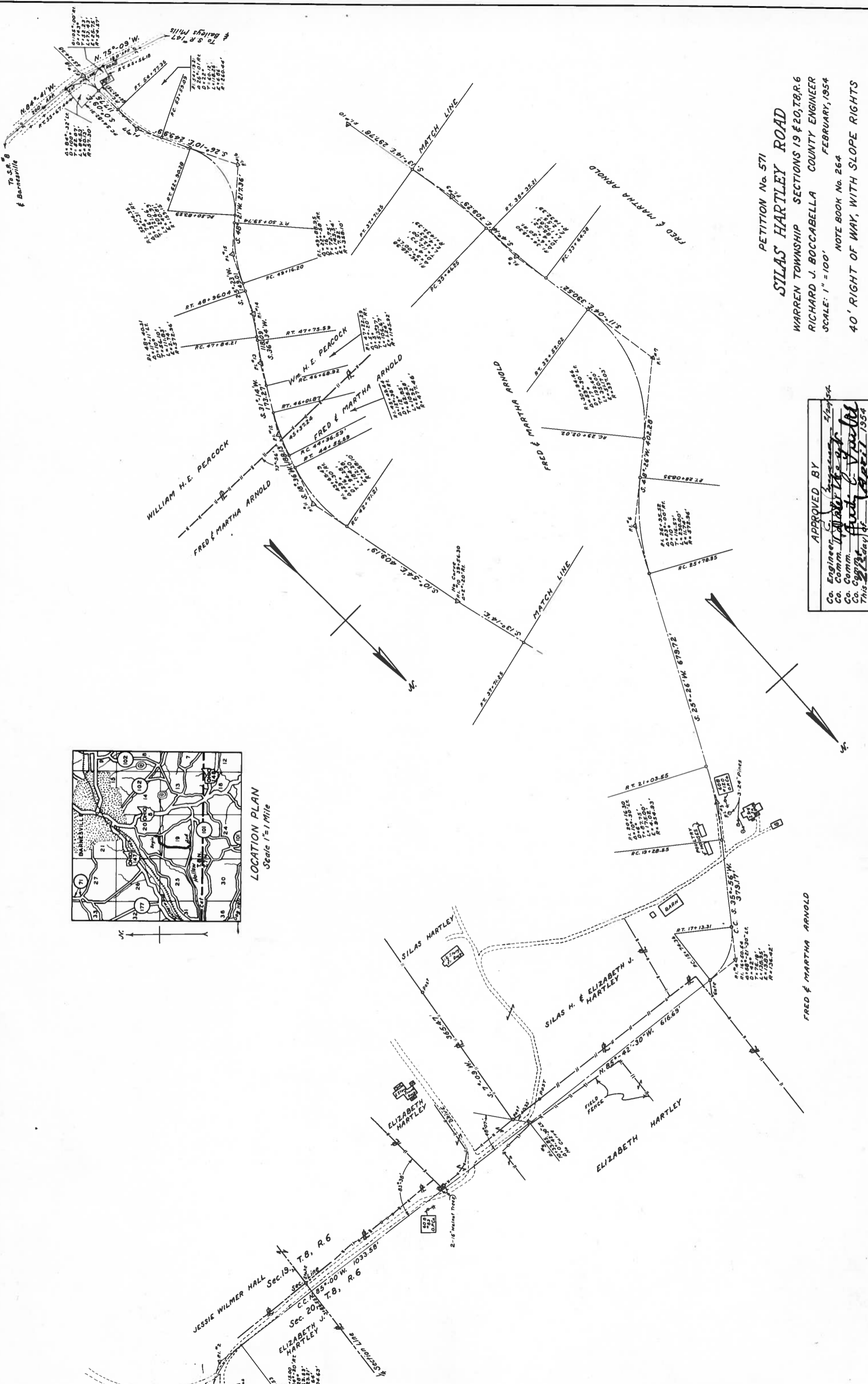

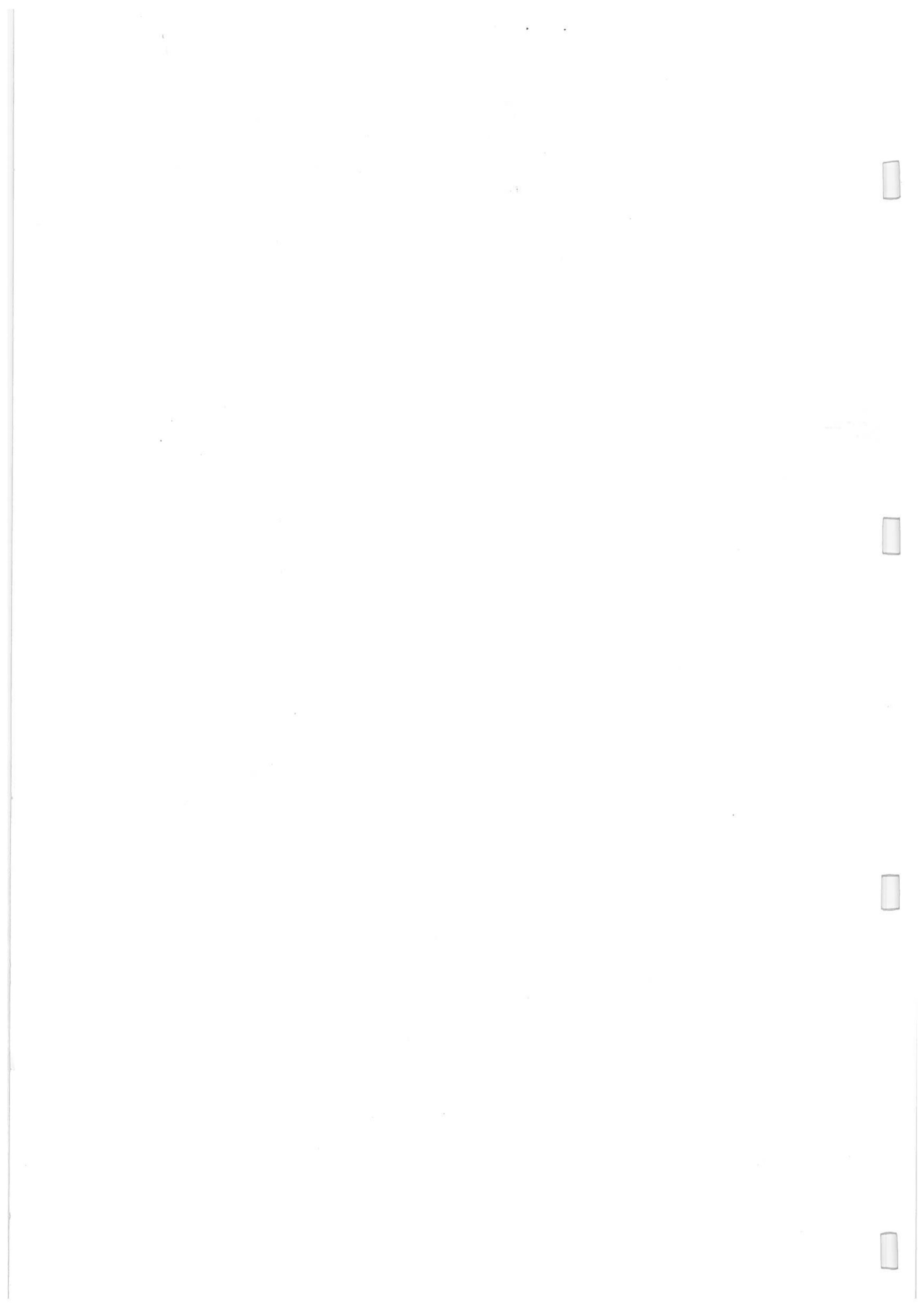


LOCATION PLAN
