

### ROAD PETITION

For the ALTERNATION of Part of a Road in YORK Township,  
 Improvement No. 572 Petitioned for by \_\_\_\_\_ and Others  
**TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:**

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the ALTERNATION  
of Part of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order

the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning Where state route intersects the within road and at the southwest corner of Dover Church Cemetery in Section 33, YORK Township; thence North 13 deg. 34' 42" West 123.08 feet; thence North 12 deg. 15' East 230.86 feet; thence North 9 deg. 01' East 306.64 feet; thence North 14 deg. 47' East 138.41 feet; thence North 4 deg. 15' 12" East 93.80 feet; thence continuing northerly through Section 33 and into Section 34.

It is proposed to vacate said road over the following course; Beginning at the southwest corner of said Dover Church Cemetery; thence North 13 deg. 34' 42" West 123.08 feet to the true point of beginning for said vacation; thence North 12 deg. East 230.86 feet; thence North 9 deg. 01' East 306.64 feet to the end of the vacated portion of said route.

Part of said road shall be re-located on the following courses and distances: Beginning at the point last mentioned about as to the terminus of the vacation; thence South 65 deg. 17' 42" East 151.78 feet; thence South 26 deg. 40' 33" East 204.15 feet; thence South 49 deg. 24' 18" East 235.31 feet; thence South 68 deg. 06' 15" East 373.56 feet; thence South 46 deg. 53' 10" East 208.5 feet to State Route #148, all as more fully shown by print attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

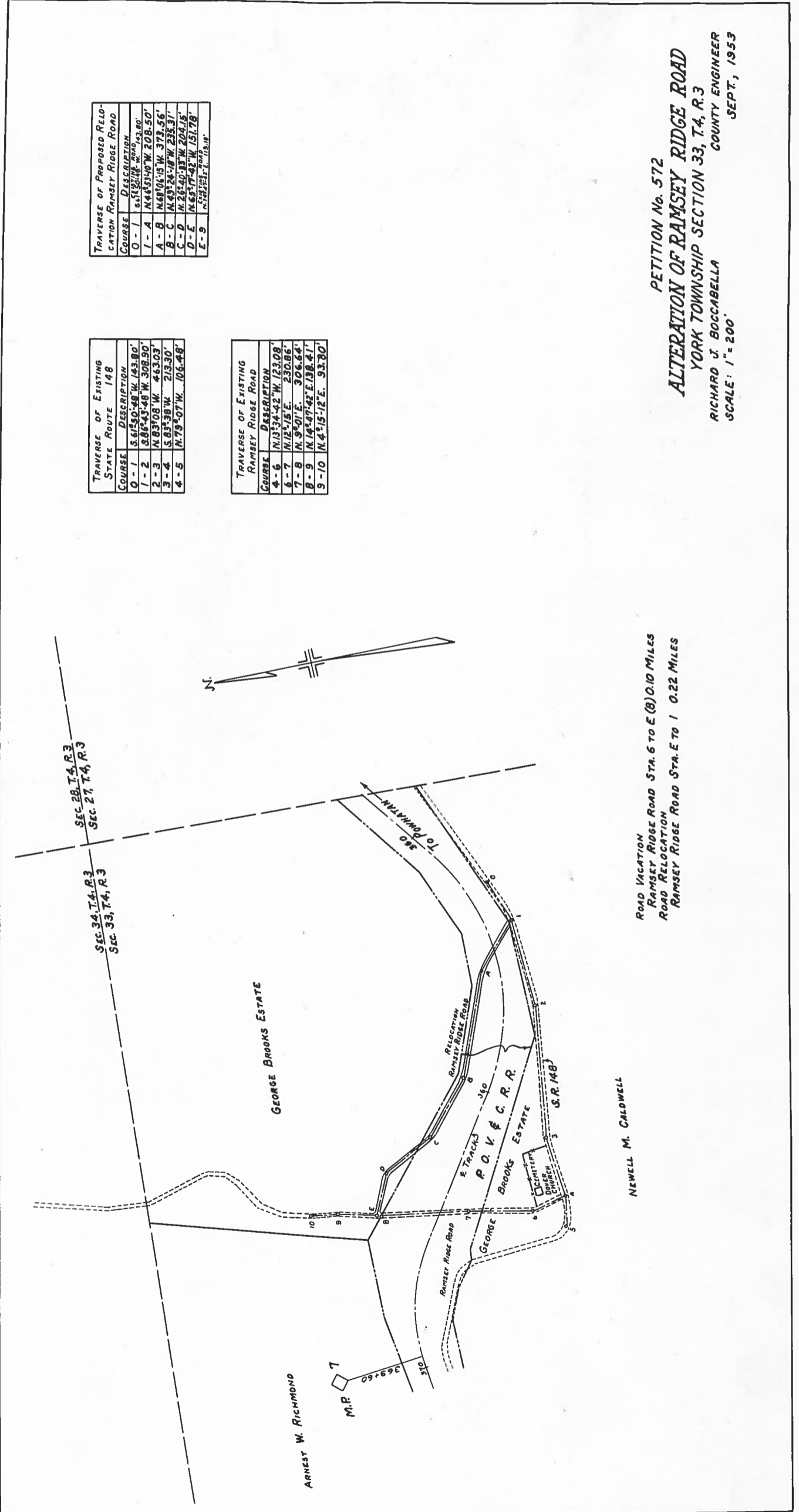
1. My opinion is that the granting of the improvement but with the following changes, which in my judgment should be made, to-wit: should be granted

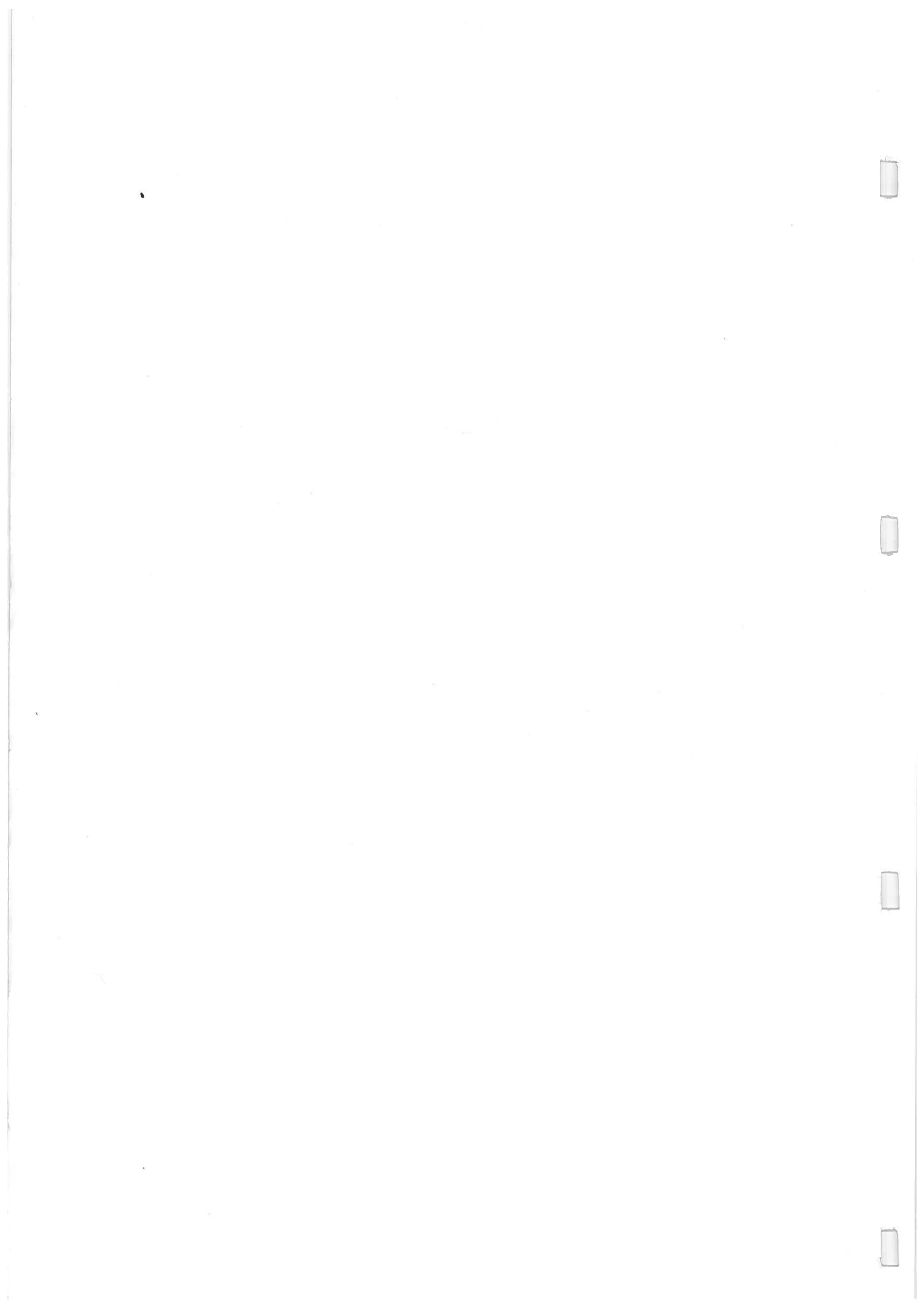
