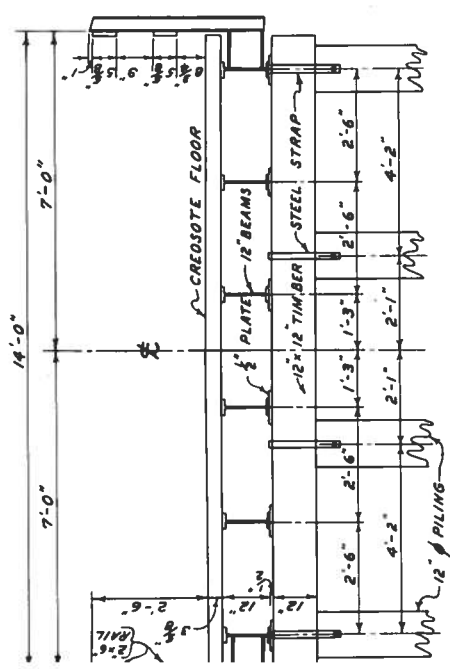

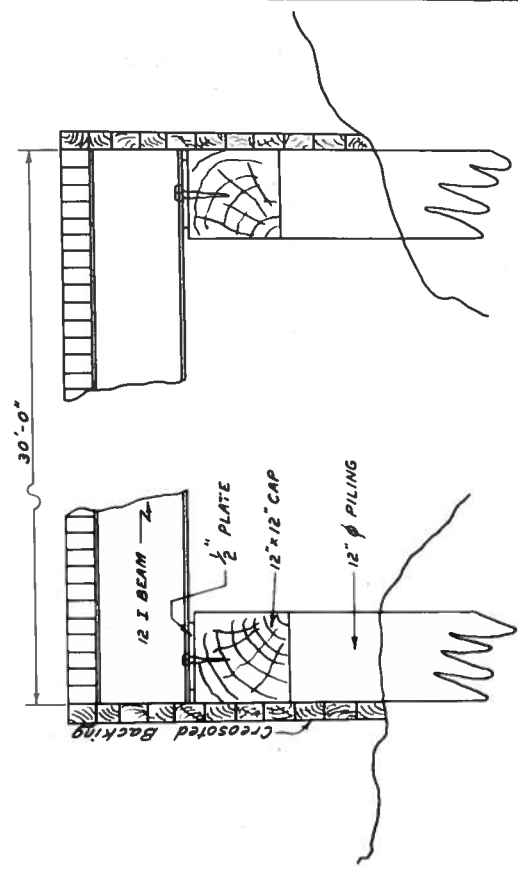

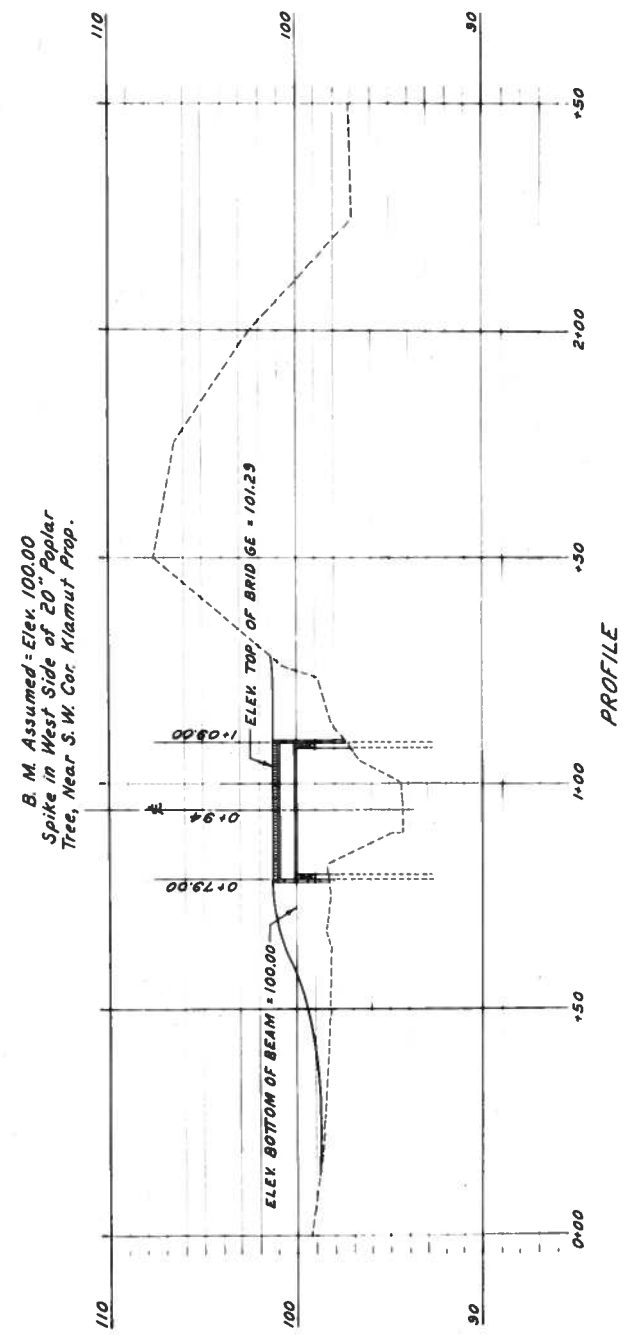

 SIDE VIEW





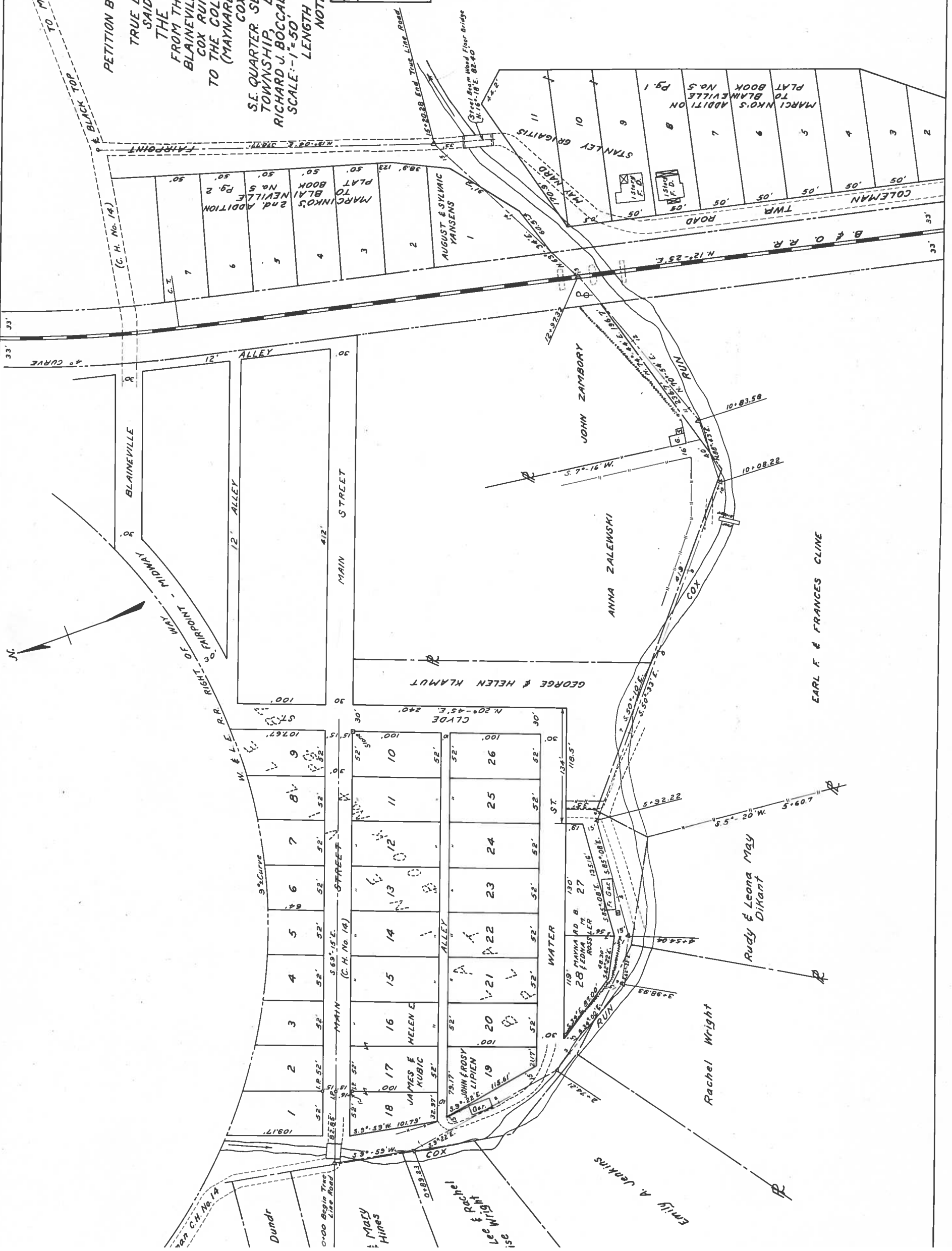
