

ROAD PETITION

For the VACATION (Griffith Rd) of a Road in Wheeling Township,
Improvement No. 585 Petitioned for by and Others

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Vacation of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order

the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at a point at the intersection of Township Road, herein petitioned for vacation, with State Highway No. 9, said point being located in the northwest quarter of Section 20, Wheeling Township, (Twp. 8), Range 4, Belmont County, Ohio, and is referenced as being located the following courses and distances from the northwest corner of Section 20; From said reference point (N.W.Cor. of Sec. 20), S. 2° 30' 10" W. 1411.00 feet along the west boundary of Section 20 to a point in the Section line; thence at right angles to said section line S. 87° 29' 50" E. 236.82 feet to the place of beginning,

(A) Thence from said point of beginning at the intersection of Township Road and State Highway No. 9 and following along the center line of Township Road herein petitioned for vacation the following courses and distances; S. 83° 01' 10" W. 148.10 feet; S. 88° 20' 20" W. 91.00 feet to the west boundary of Section 20, said point being located S. 2° 30' 10" W. 1441.78 feet from the northwest corner of said section.

(B) Thence entering into Section 26, S. 88° 20' 20" W. 364.16 feet; S. 89° 17' 00" W. 881.07 feet; S. 84° 28' 20" W. 124.58 feet; S. 77° 43' 20" W. 173.98 feet; S. 67° 02' 10" W. 64.00 feet; S. 51° 48' 00" W. 77.62 feet; S. 37° 19' 30" W. 100.60 feet; S. 3° 22' 00" W. 170.29 feet; S. 6° 07' 00" W. 112.64 feet; S 15° 39' 40" W. 111.13 feet; S. 19° 33' 30" W. 161.31 feet to the south side of bridge over Campbells Run, the western terminus of Township Road herein petitioned for vacation, said point is referenced as follows; From the southwest corner of the northeast quarter of Section 26 (also is center of Section 26), N. 2° 22' 30" E. 633.93 feet along the west boundary of the northeast quarter of Section 26, S. 87° 37' 30" E. 756.38 feet to the western terminus point.

The foregoing Township Road is situated in Sections 20 and 26, there being 239.10 feet (0.045 mi.) in Section 20 and 2341.46 feet (0.444 mi.) in Section 26 making a total length of 2580.56 feet (0.489 mi.).

All the foregoing described Township Road is in Wheeling Township (Twp.'8), Range 4, Belmont County, Ohio and is a dead-end road, said Township Road having been previously vacated west of the western terminus herein above mentioned and it is herein alleged that the vacation herein petitioned will not inconvenience the traveling public.

That portion of Township Road herein petitioned for vacation situated in Section 20 (Captioned "A" in description) is on property of Lyle Morgan and the portion in Section 26 (Captioned "B" in description) is on property owned by Pittsburgh Consolidation Coal Company.

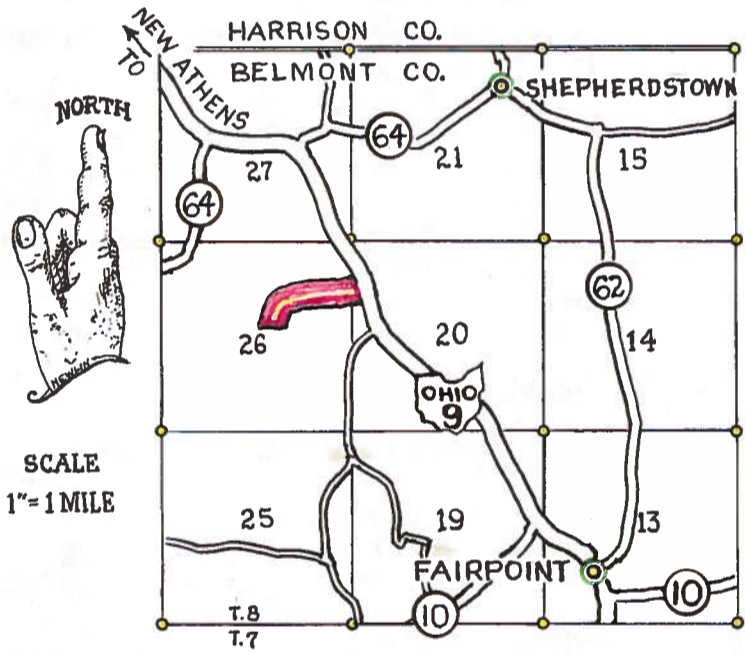

Beginning at a point at the intersection of Township Road, herein petitioned for vacation, with State Highway No. 9, said point being located in the north west quarter of Section 20, Wheeling Township, (Twp. 8), Range 4, Belmont County, Ohio, and is referenced as being located the following course and distances from the Northwest corner of Section 20; From said reference point the North West Corner of Section 20 bears S. 2° 30' 10" W. 1411.00 feet along the West boundary of Section 20 to a point in the Section Line; thence at right angles to said section line S. 87° 29' 50" E. 236.82 feet to the place of Beginning. Stations, Bearings and Distances of the center line are listed below. Station #3 is located on the Western boundary of Section 20 and said point being located S. 2° 30' 10" W. 1441.78 feet from the North West corner of said section. Station 14 is at the south side of a bridge over Campbell's Run, and is the Western terminus of the Township Road herein petitioned for vacation, said station #14 is referenced as follows; From the south West corner of the North East Quarter of Section 26 (also is center of Section 26), North 2° 22' 30" E. 633.93 feet along the West boundary of the North East quarter of Section 26, South 87° 37' 30" East 756.38 feet to the Western terminus point.

The Township Road is situated in Sections 20 and 26, there being 239.10 feet (0.045 mile) in Section 20 and 2341.46 feet (0.444 mile) in Section 26 making a total length of 2580.56 feet (0.489 mile).

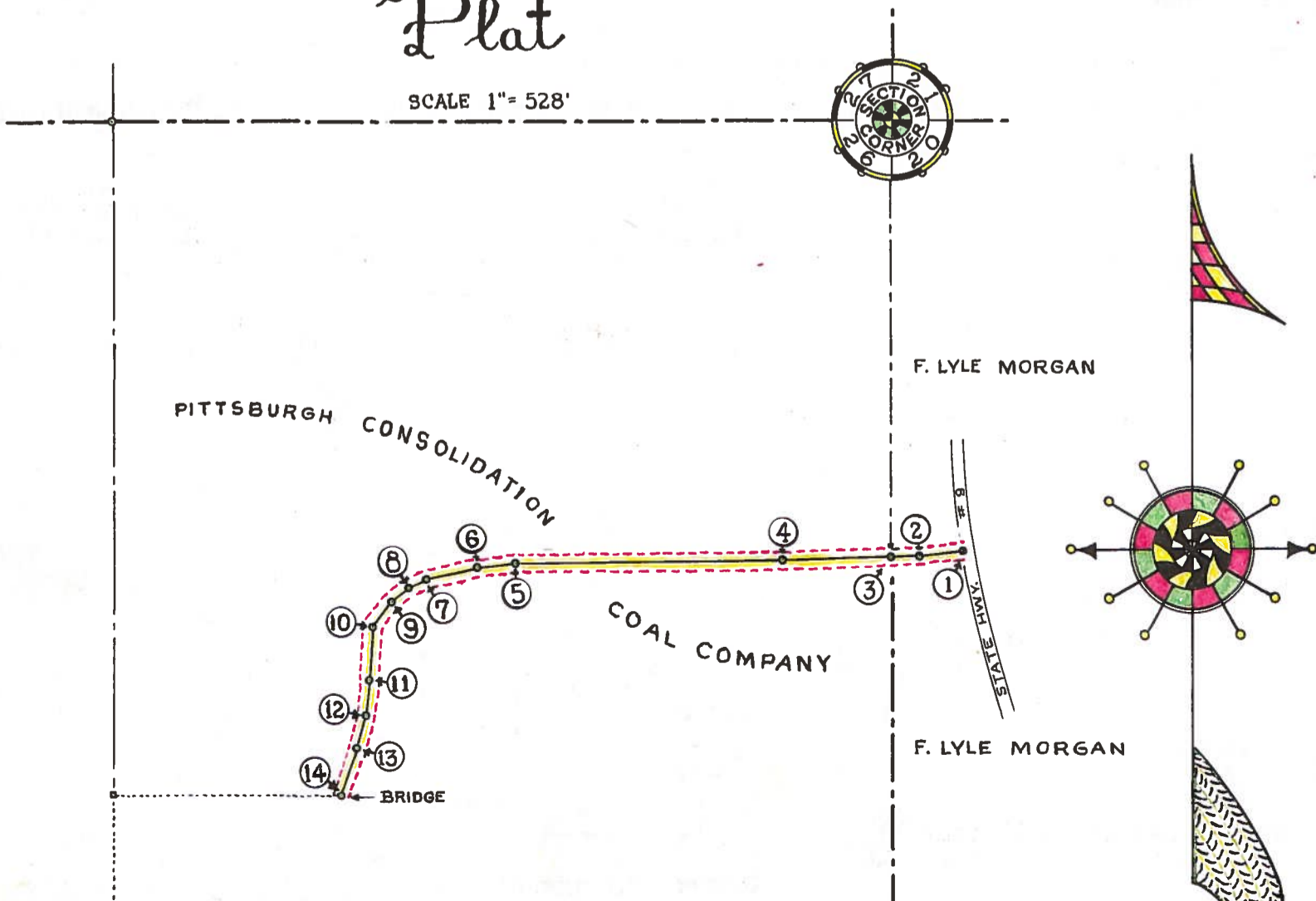
