

ROAD PETITION

For the Vacation & Relocation of a Road in Goshen Township,
 Improvement No. 590 Petitioned for by Ray L. Oden (Brown Rd.) and Others
 TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Vacation & Relocation of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at a point in the middle of the Road at the North West Corner of the Ray Oden property in Goshen Township and turning in a Southwesterly direction sufficient to be on a straight line to meet the present road at the South east corner of the John Zaleski property.

Said changes if granted will allow a road to be built on the top of the proposed dam which is to be constructed for the purpose of enlarging the present Reservoir of the Village of Bethesda, Ohio, and further that said changes if granted will eliminate two very bad curves on the present road and will also eliminate a bad hill.

This Road lies east of Bethesda, Ohio and runs from Bethesda past the village water reservoir and wells.

2. The width should be 30 feet

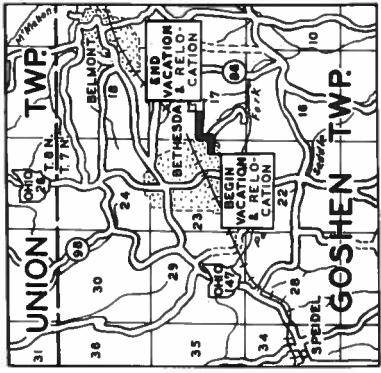

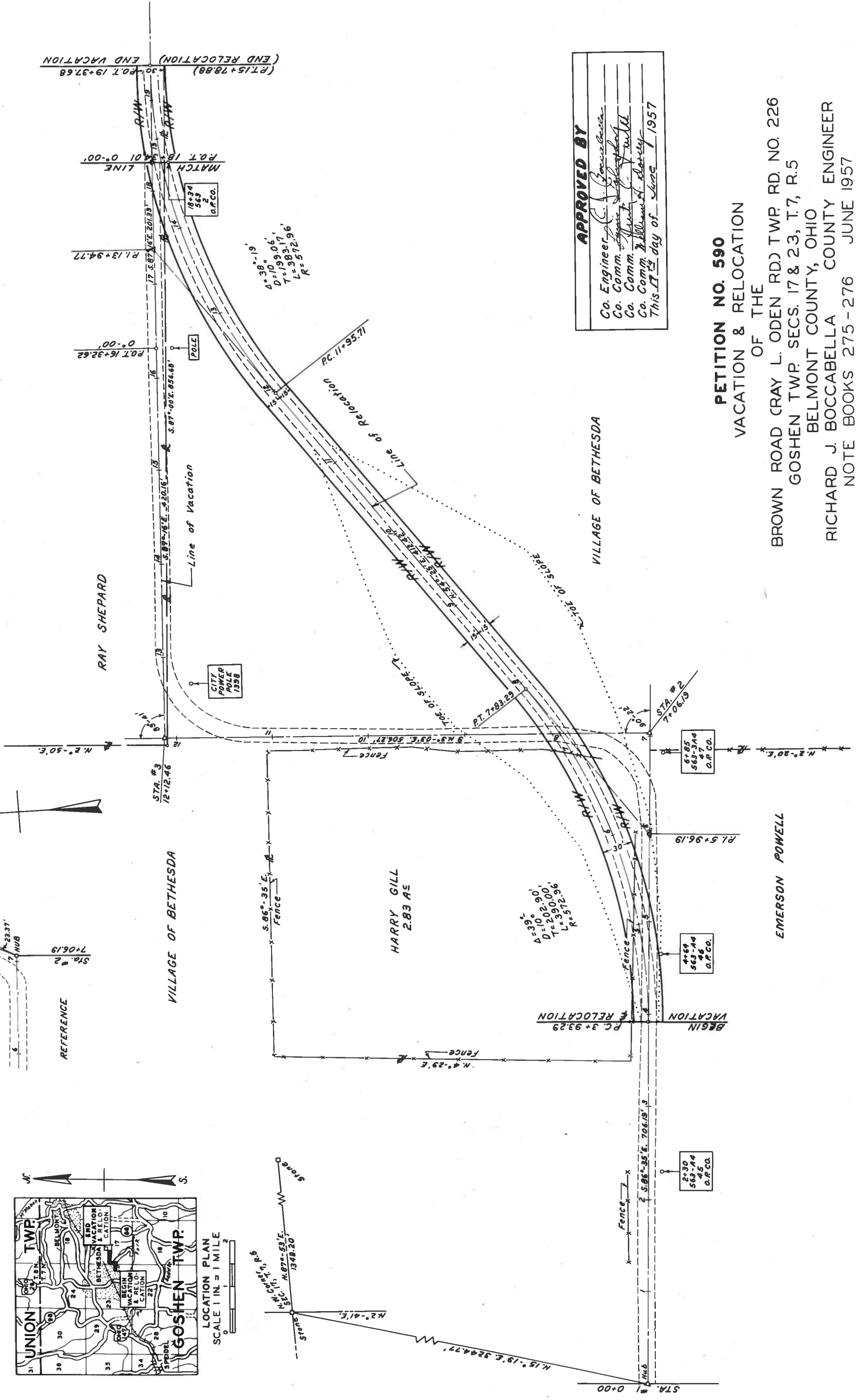

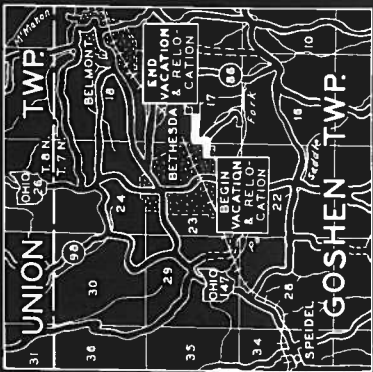

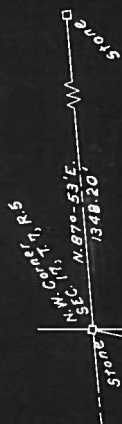
