

ROAD PETITION

For the Vacation of a Part (Twp. Road No. 421) of a Road in Wheeling 1 Township, Improvement No. 595 Petitioned for by Pittsburgh Consolidation Coal Co. and Others

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Vacationing of a Part of

of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at a point in the center of Township Road No. 421 (commonly called Metro Road) at or near the center of Section 21, said point being about 550 ft. South of the intersection of County Road No. 64 with Township Road No. 421; thence southerly following along the quarter section line 2620 ft. (0.50 miles) more or less; thence easterly generally following the south boundary of Sec. 21, 2610 ft. (0.49 miles) more or less; thence in a north easterly direction, 400 ft. (0.08 miles) more or less to the East boundary of Section 21, said point being located about 140 ft. From the Southeast corner of Sec. 21, the total length thereof being 5630 ft. or 1.07 miles more or less.

The foregoing described road being located in sections 20 & 21, Wheeling Twp. (T. 8), Range 4, Belmont County, Ohio, and is a portion of Township Road No. 421 known as Metro Road.

Petitioners allege that no serious inconvenience will result from the vacating thereof, since travel over this road is very limited and no dwellings or buildings are situated along the road described.

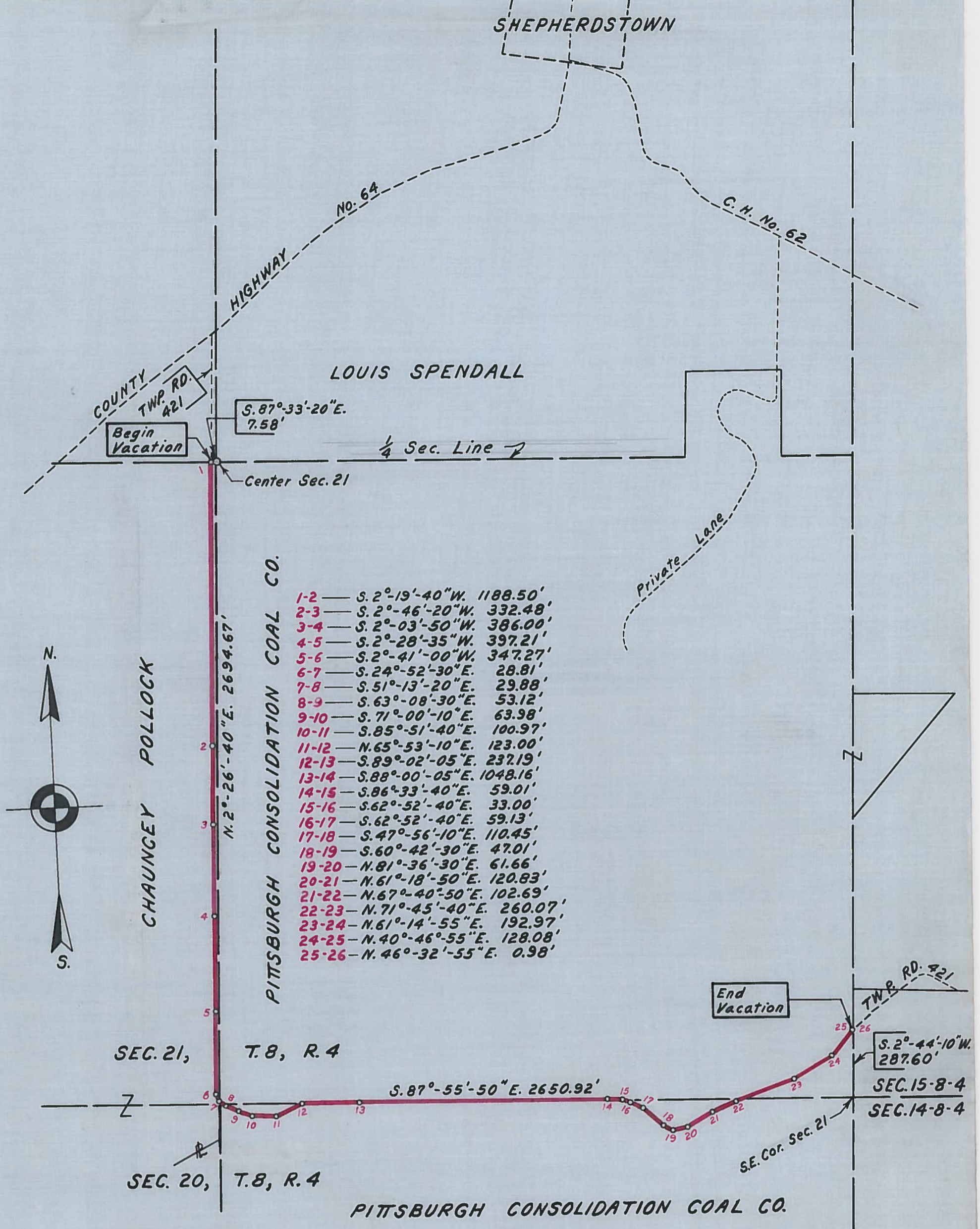

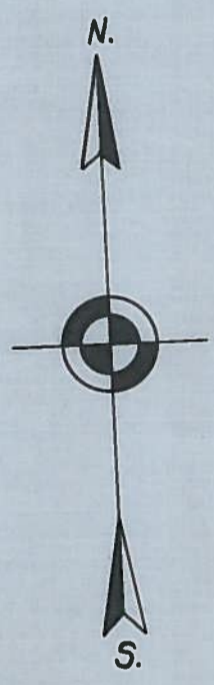
