two Alleys ~~of a Public Road~~ on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning on the Swingle Road in Farmington and extending in a westerly direction approximately 312 feet, being 16 feet in width; the second alley connecting with the above described alley and extending in a northerly direction approximately 60 feet being 14 feet wide, reference to the Farmington Plat in Colerain Township, Belmont County, Ohio

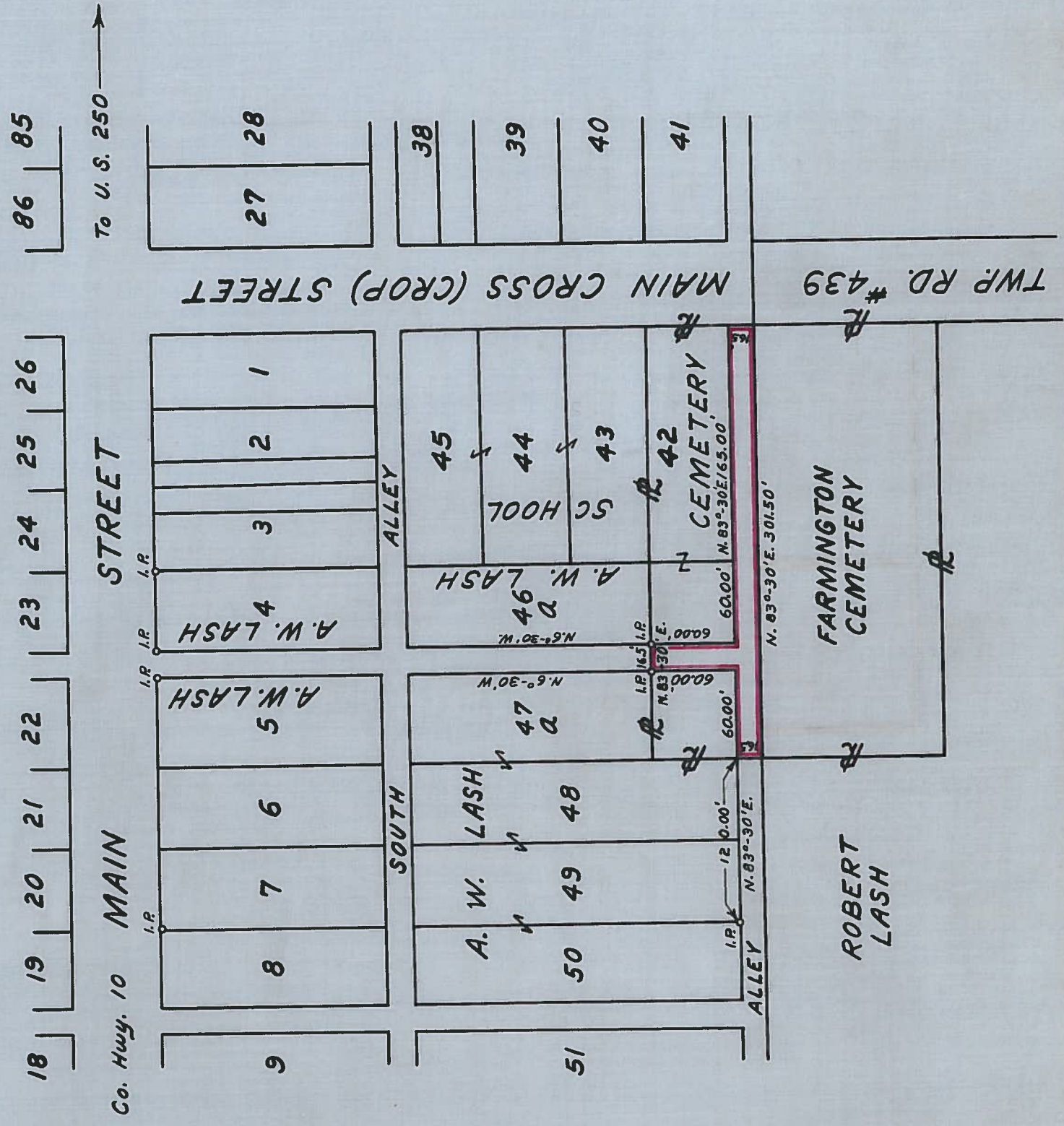
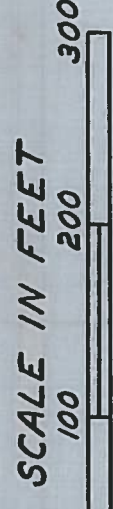

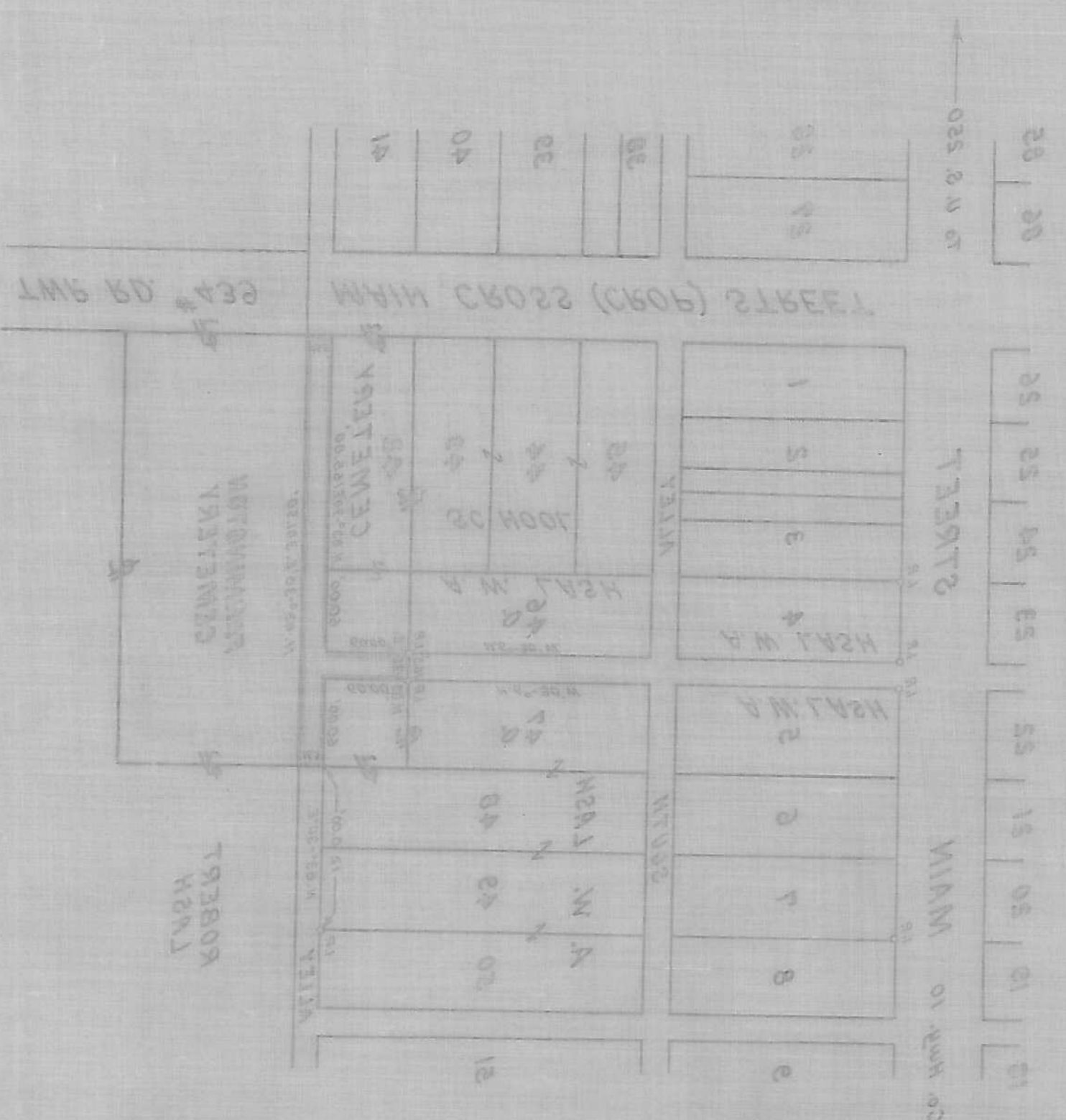
