## TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Establishment of Hillview Lane ~~as~~ a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order

the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at 60 feet from Entrance of

Toad Hollow Road, Pultney Township, turn left off same road making a oblong loop for approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile ending on Toad Hollow Road  $\frac{1}{10}$  mile from entrance, said route being through lands of W<sup>m</sup> H. Smith and Emily Smith in Pultney Township, Belmont County, Ohio.

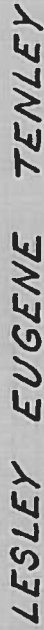
