They also fixed the 18th day of June 1958, at 11:00 o'clock A.M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

VACATION OF SOUTH STREET IN MOUNT OLIVETT

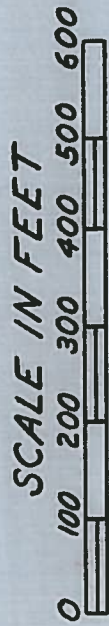

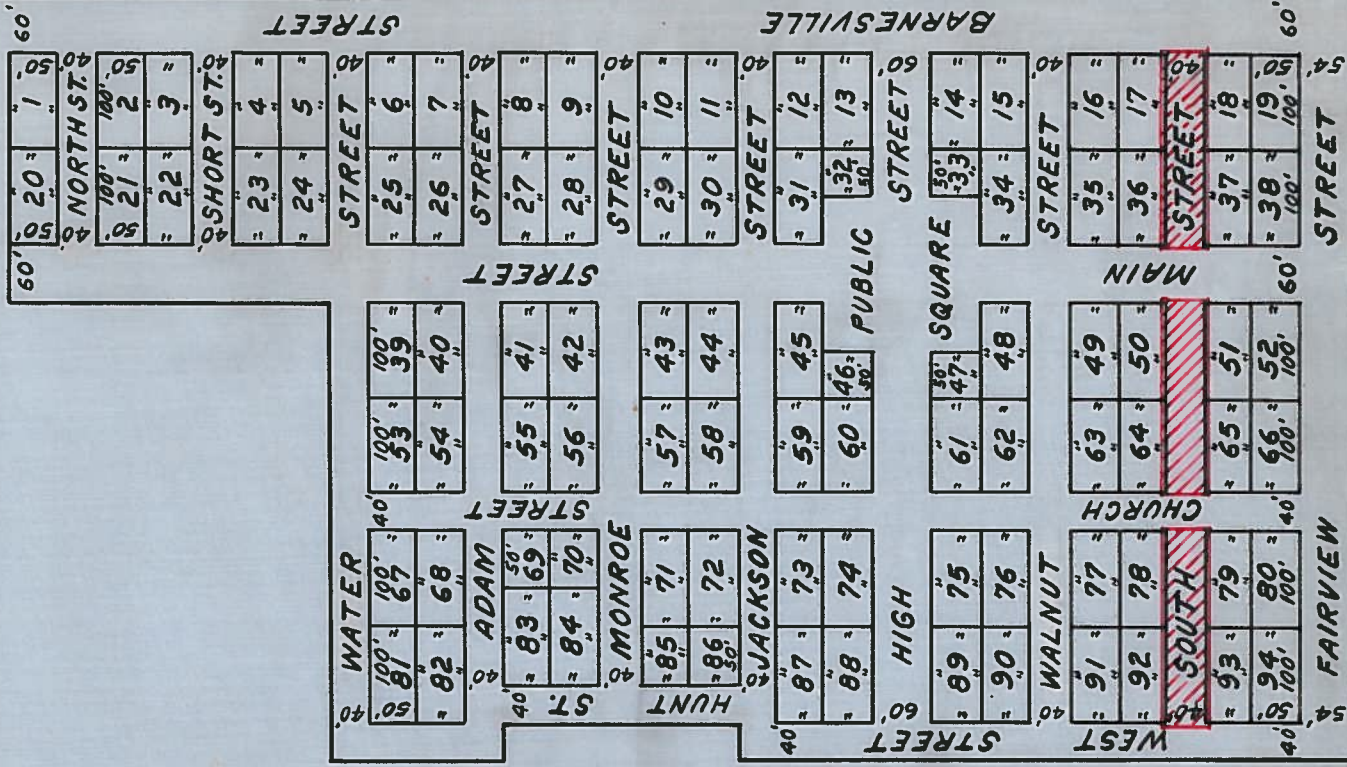
