TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Vacation of a Part of Twp. Rd. No. 337 a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning Vacation of part of township road No. 337.

Situated in the township of Wheeling, County of Belmont and State of Ohio, and being part of township road No. 337. Beginning for its Southern terminus at a point 600 feet north of the intersection of township road No. 337 with Belmont County Highway No. 10, thence in the north westerly direction 2400 feet to a point terminus of said part to be vacated and remainder of township road No. 337 to remain unvacated.

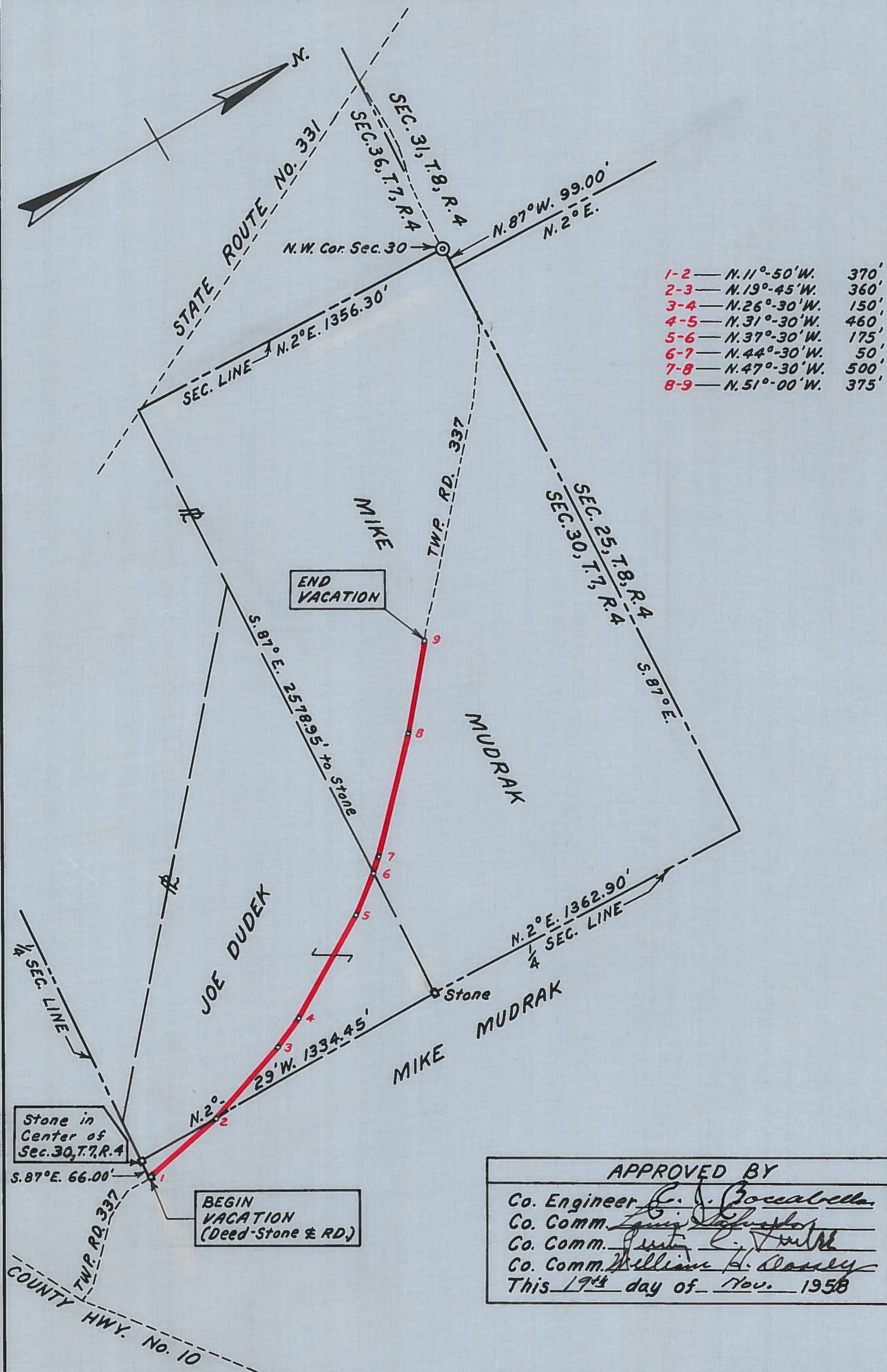

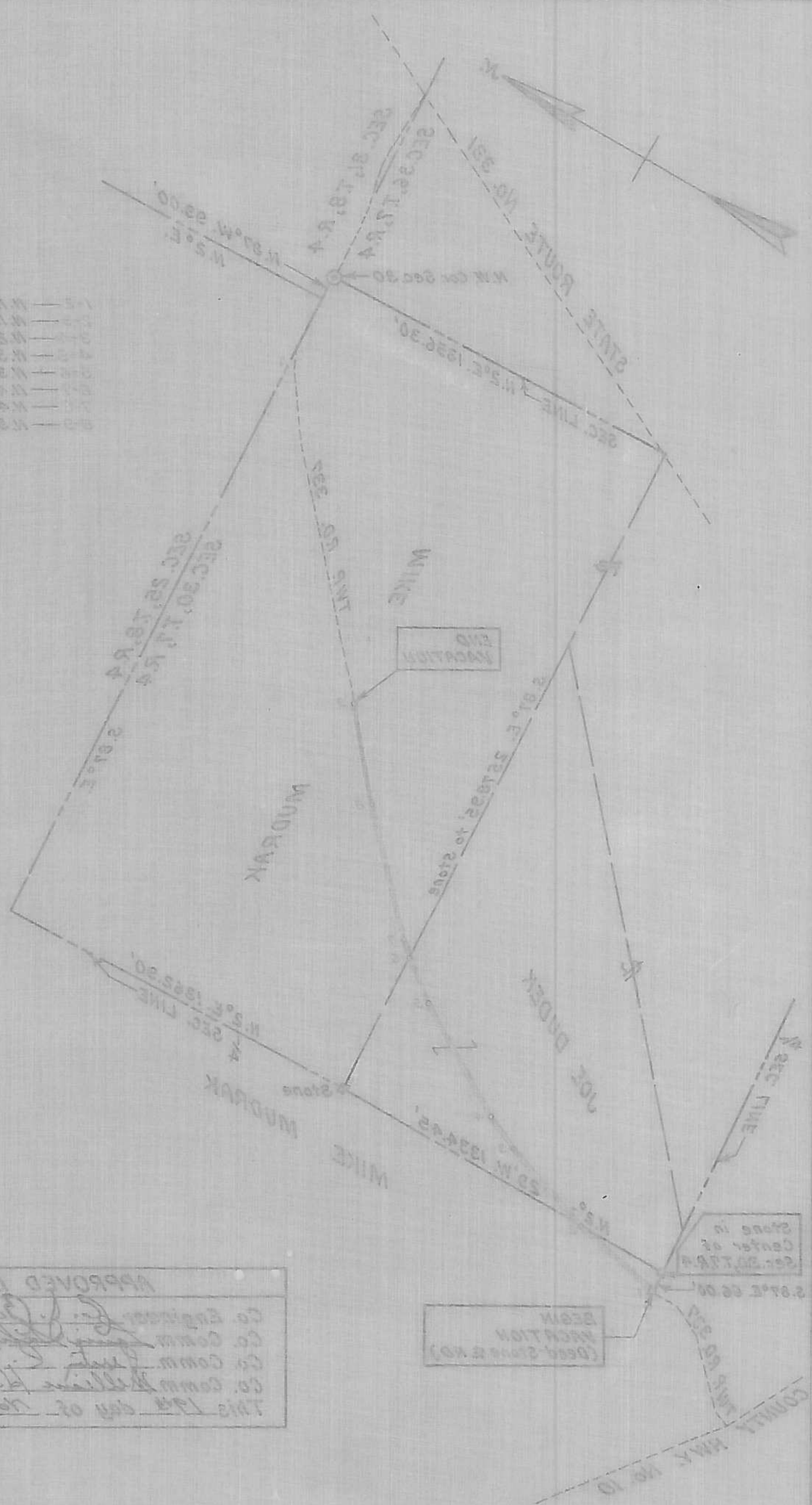
