

ROAD PETITION

For the Vacation of a Part of Old U.S. 40 of a Road in Richland Township,
Improvement No. 615 Petitioned for by Beulah S. Stewart and Others

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Vacation
..... of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order

the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at a point approx. 40 Ft. to the left of Station 48+00 and thence following the E of the old Brick National Road to a point approx. 40 Ft. to the left of Station 56+50

The Stations noted above are the same as used by the State Highway Dept. on their 1931 Survey of the relocation of the National Highway.

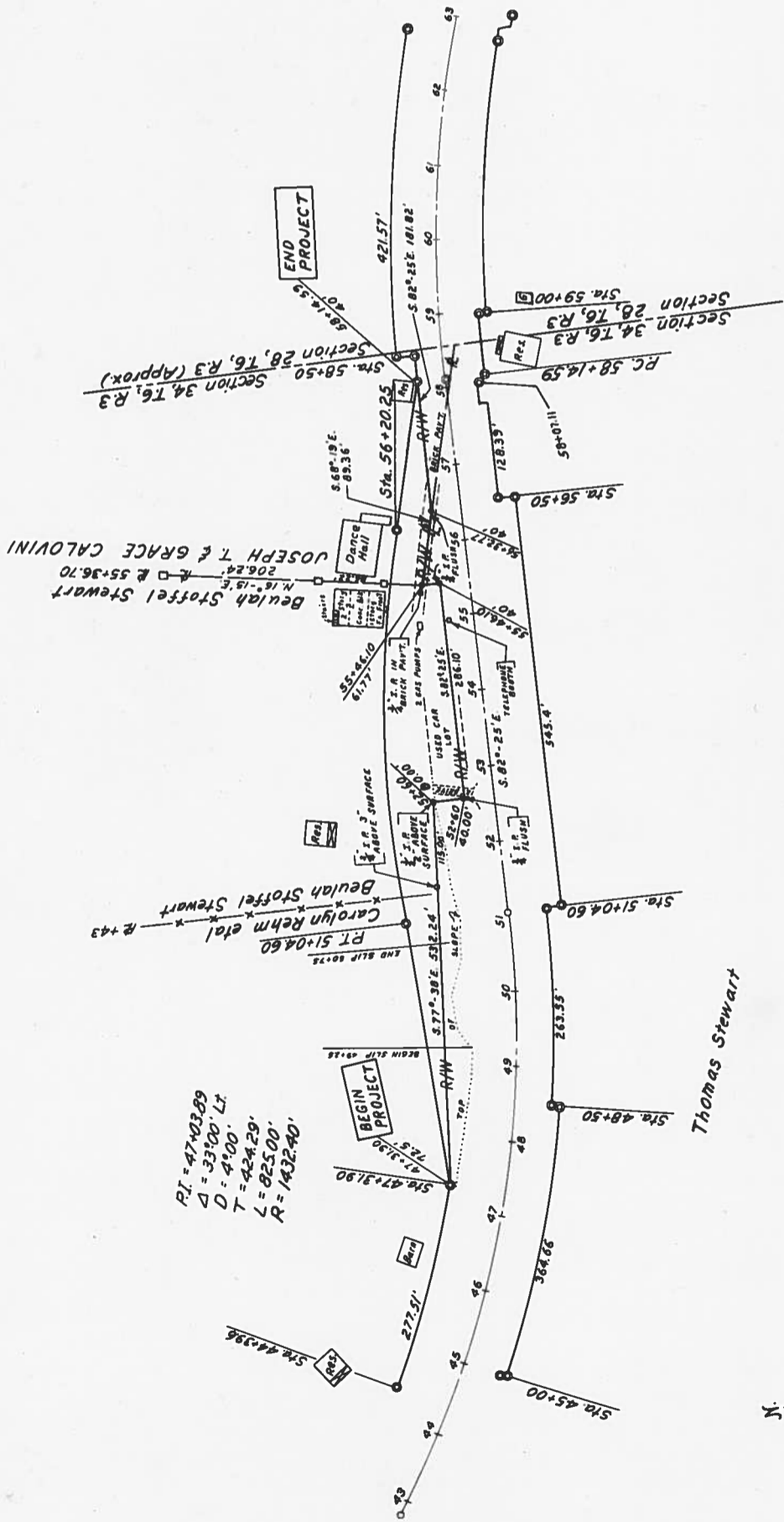
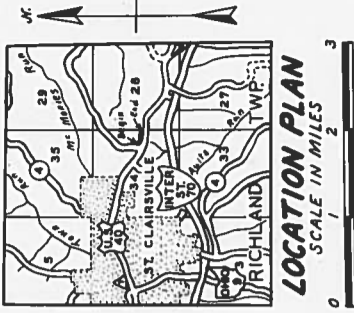

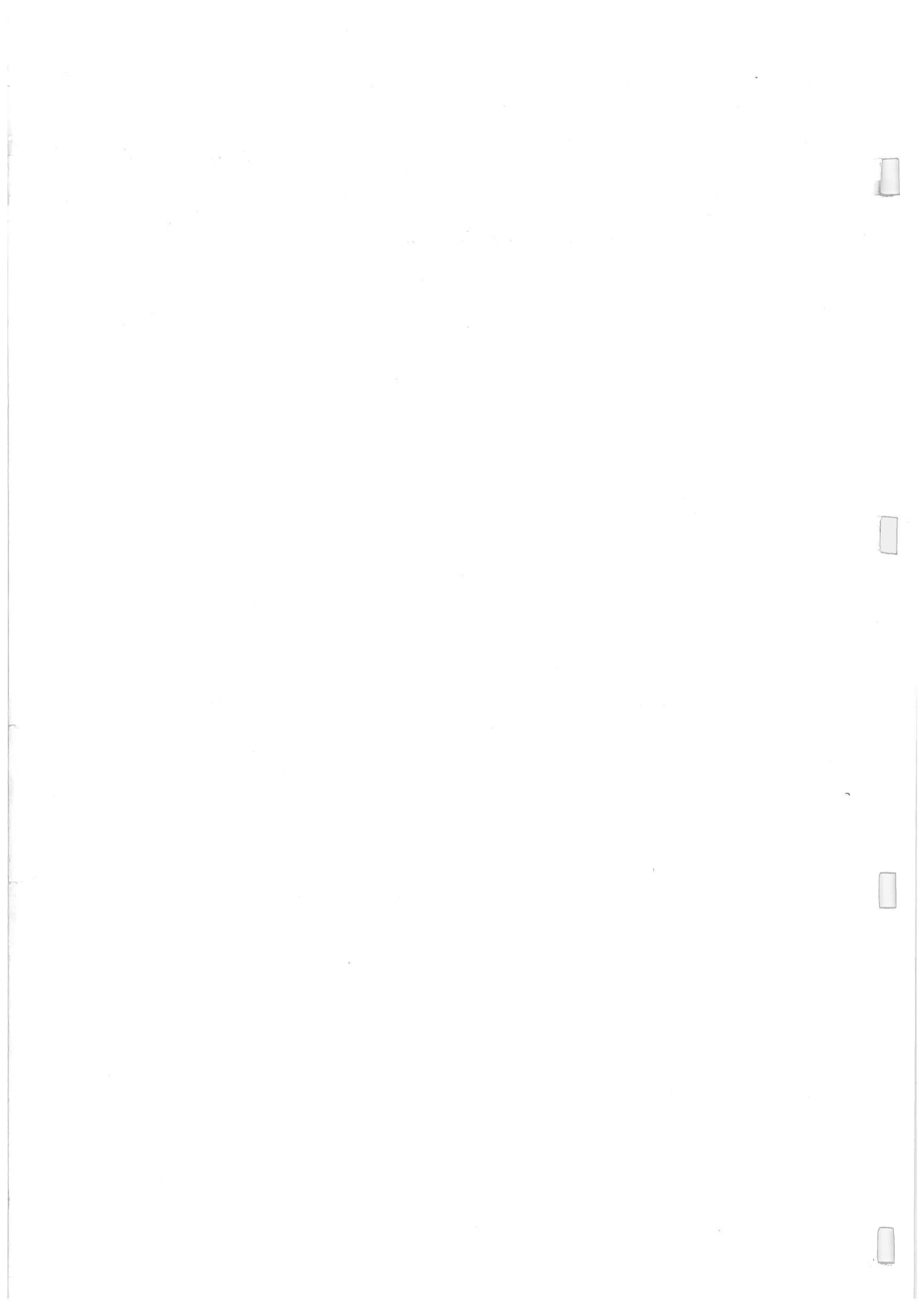
