

## ROAD PETITION

For the Vacation & Relocation of a Road in Union Township Township,  
Improvement No. 626 Petitioned for by J. B. Martin and Others

## TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Vacation & Relocation of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning for said alteration at a point in Fox Trail Road, Township Road No. T-207, at one of the corners on the west side of the State Park property now owned by the State of Ohio, which point is in Union Township, Section 7, Township 8, Range 5 and said point bears approximately East 1200 Feet and N. 30°. East 130 Feet from the center of said section; thence from said place of beginning for said alteration and with a gradual curve to the left and in a Northwesterly direction through the lands of the State of Ohio and Elmer A. and Elva A. Hogue to a point near the intersection of the Shriver or Martin Road, (Township No. 263) and the Loy (some places mis-spelled as Lox) Township Road No. 92 and the end of said alteration; and we also pray for the vacation of so much of the Fox Trail Road, Loy Road and Shriver Road that will be rendered useless by the above mentioned alteration

Martin has filed herein a bond as required by law. It is ordered that the 7<sup>th</sup> day of Sept. 1960, at 2:00 o'clock P.M., be fixed as a date to view the same, at which date they will meet at Beginning Point and go over the route of said proposed road.

They also fixed the 14<sup>th</sup> day of Sept. 1960, at 11:00 o'clock A.M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Gas St. Clairsville Gazette a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

3. Estimated compensation and damages, due each person, firm or corporation (with a \* before the name of each minor or other person under disability), to-wit:

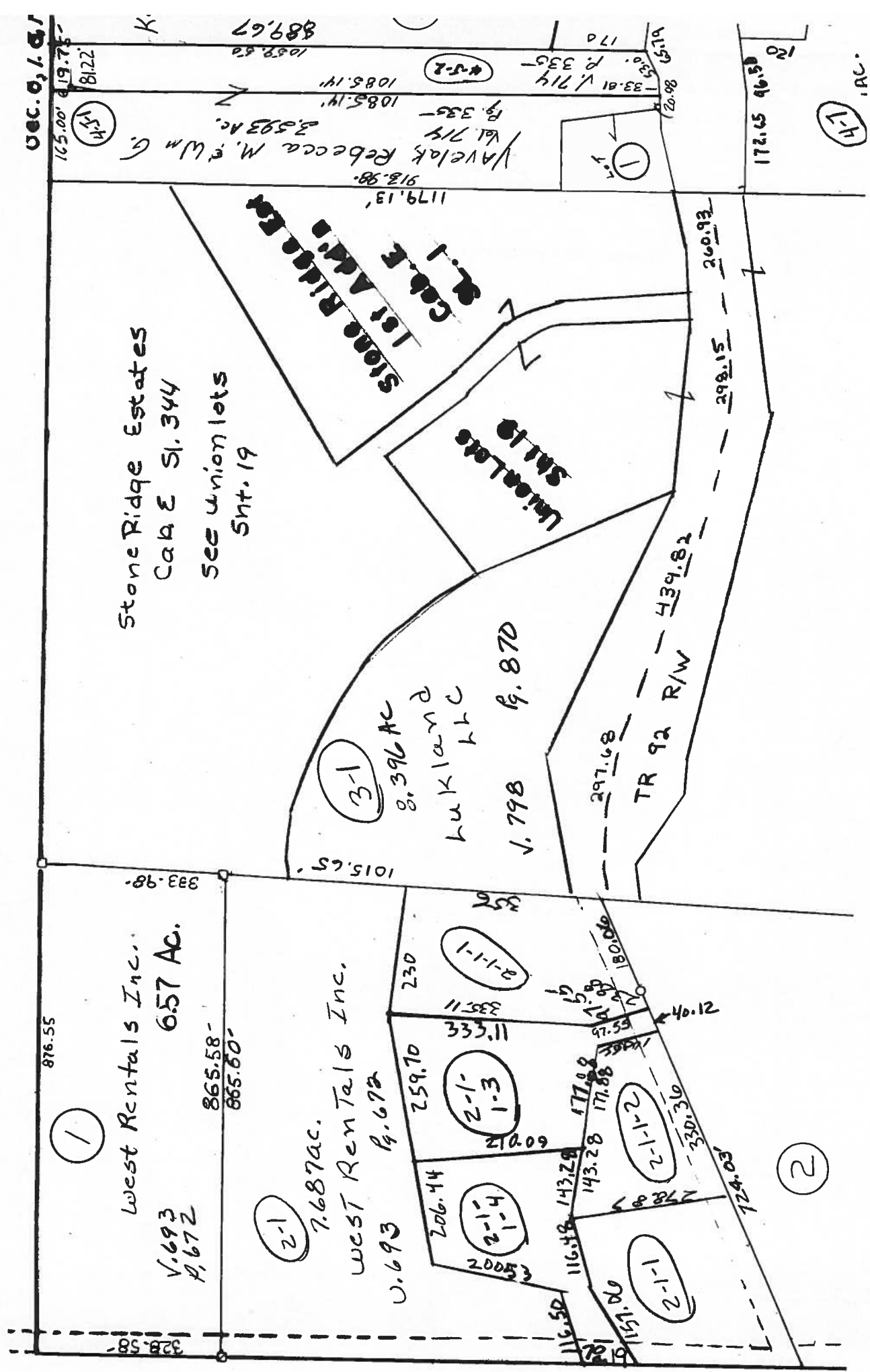

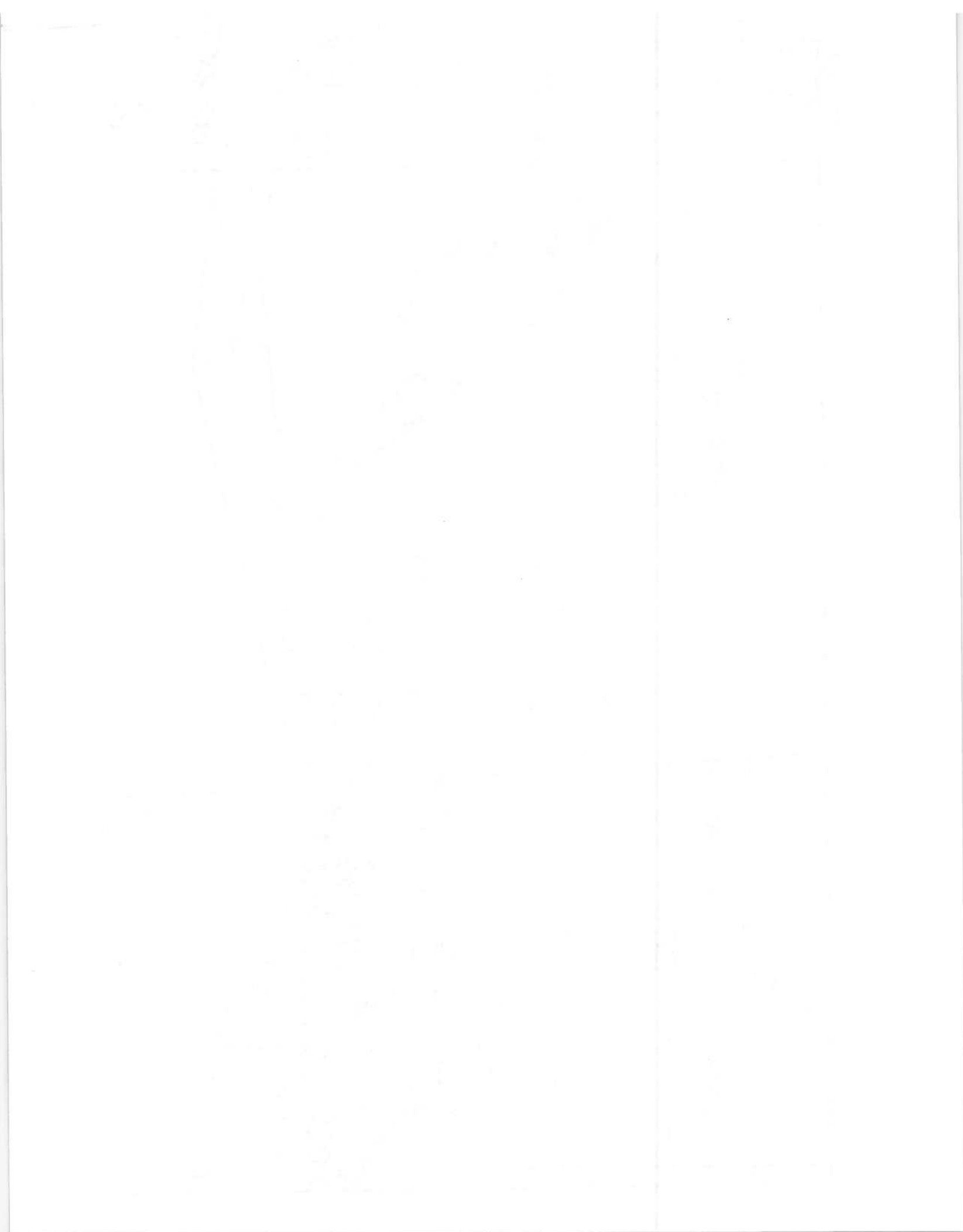

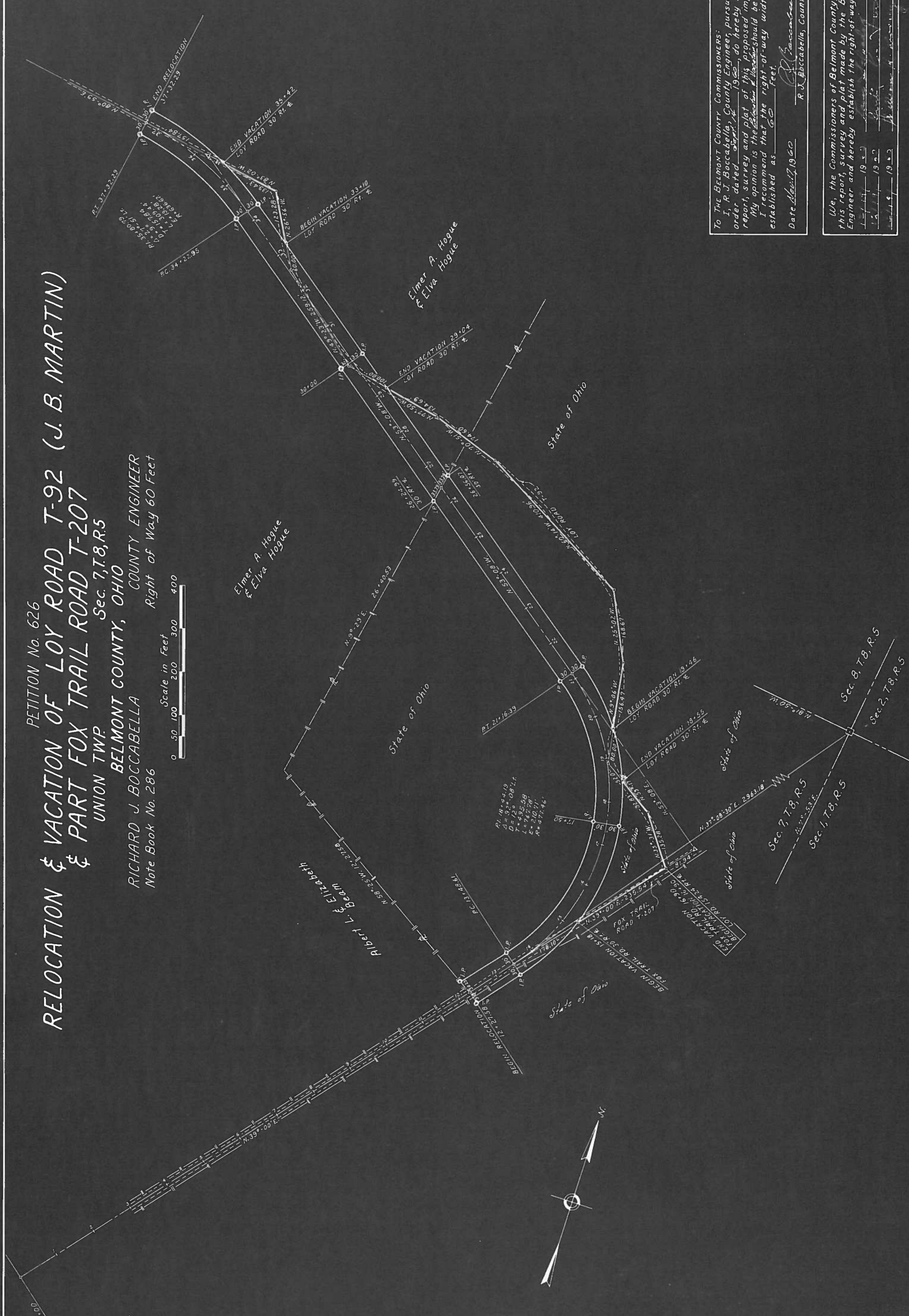
# RELOCATION & VACATION OF LOY ROAD T-92 (J. B. MARTIN) & PART FOX TRAIL ROAD T-207
