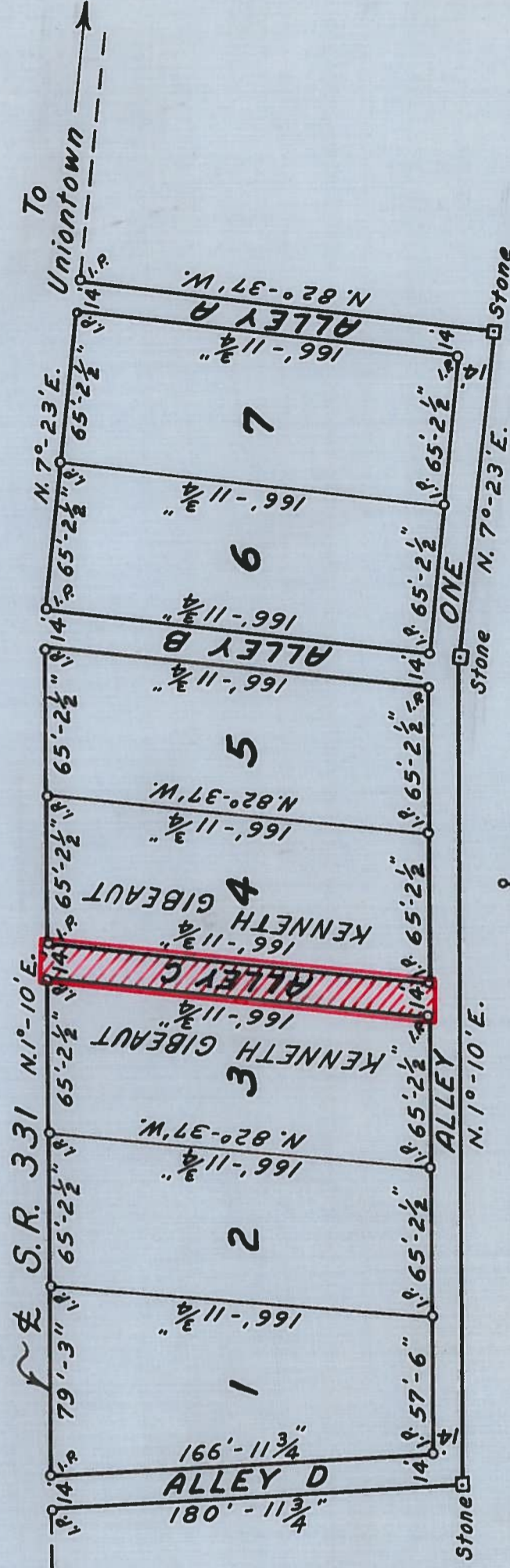

Beginning for a description of the Vacation of Alley "C" in Caldwell's Addition to Bannock, as Recorded in Plat No. 5, Belmont County Recorders Office, at an Iron Pin at the N.E. corner of Lot No. 3, said Iron Pin is the intersection of the South Line of Alley "C" with the West Line of Alley One; thence along the North Line of Lot No. 3, 166'-11³/₄" to an Iron Pin at the N.W. corner of Lot No. 3, where the North Line of Lot No. 3 intersects the Centerline of State Route No. 331; thence along the Centerline of Route No. 331, N. 1°-10'E. 14.00' to an Iron Pin at the intersection of the South Line of Lot No. 4 to the Centerline of Route No. 331; said Iron Pin being also the S.W. corner of Lot No. 4; thence along the South Line of Lot No. 4 S. 82°-166'-11³/₄" to an Iron Pin at the S.E. corner of Lot No. 4; Iron Pin is also the intersection of the Line of Alley "C" with the West Line of Alley One; thence S. 1°-10'W. to the place of beginning.
