The following is the general route and termini of said road:

Beginning at a point 1815' east of the Southwest corner of Section 2, Township 8, Range 5, in Union Township. Thence from the point of beginning and with the centerline of Township Road No. T-207 and thru the lands of Myrtle E. Watkins, north for a distance of approximately 2680 feet and there terminate.

Said County Engineer shall also, at the time of making such survey, set stakes at the termini of each right of way line and at all angles between such termini, and at sufficient other points on the right of way lines so that the bounds of the proposed improvement may be discernible to property owners and other interested persons; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the said County Engineer be and he is hereby directed to make a report in writing to this Board, on or before the 10th day of October, 1973, the date fixed for the final hearing, setting forth his opinion either for or against said proposed improvement, and the width to which said improvement shall be opened, which shall not be less than thirty feet; said report shall be accompanied by said plat and detailed and accurate descriptions, and filed with the County Commissioners, and this cause is continued until said date.

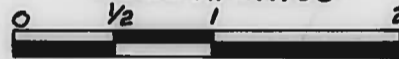

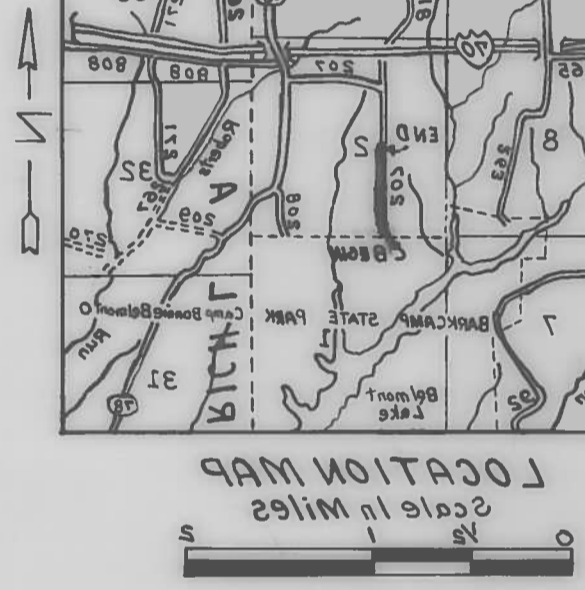

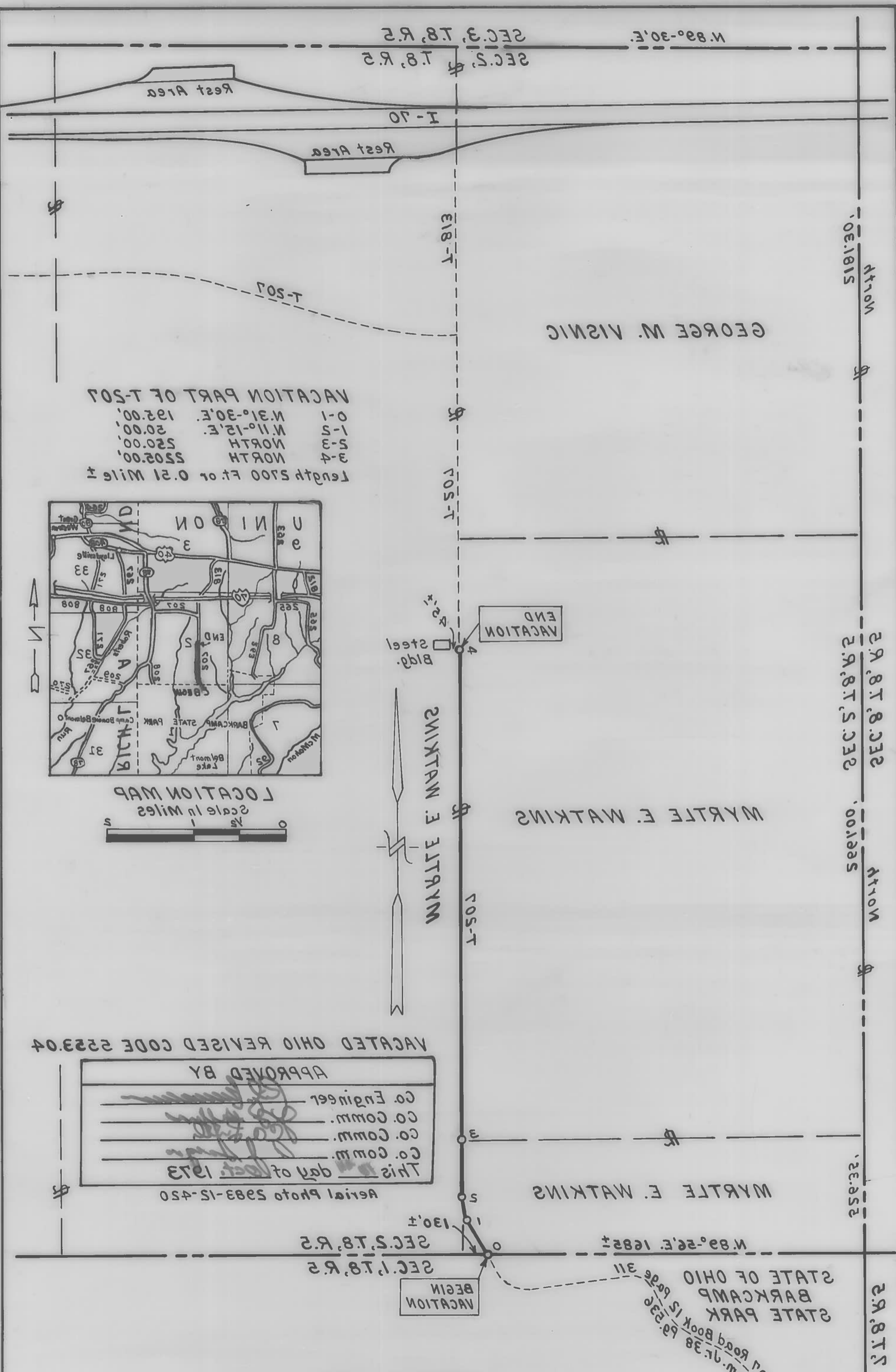
