

PUBLIC ROAD PETITION IMP. No. 762

St. Clairsville, Ohio, June 9th, 1975

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

The undersign petitioners, freeholders of said County residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience and welfare require the Vacating of all of T-168 a Public Road on the line hereinafter described, and make application to you to institute and order proper proceedings in the premises, for Vacating such road, the same not being a road on the State Highway System.

The following is the general route and termini of said road:

Beginning at the centerline intersection of Kirkwood Township Road No. 712 and Kirkwood Township Road No. 168, said beginning point situated in State of Ohio, County of Belmont, Township of Kirkwood, Section 19, thence from place of beginning Northwesterly for a distance of 1,500 feet, more or less, to the terminus of the portion of road herein petitioned for vacation, said terminus situated in State of Ohio, County of Belmont, Township of Kirkwood, Section 19, and referenced as follows. From the Northwest corner of Section 19, South along the West line of said Section for a distance of 2,500 feet, more or less. Thence at a right angle thereto East for a distance of 175 feet, more or less, to the terminus, total distance petitioned for vacation being 1,500 feet, more or less, (0.28 mi.)

Consolidation Coal Company, Central Division, the petitioner, herein states that it is owner of surface or right to mine coal underlying and adjacent to said road and that the travelling public will not be inconvenienced by said vacation.

WHEREAS, On the 25th day of June, 1975, the time heretofore fixed for view of the proposed improvement, we, the Board of County Commissioners having jurisdiction in said matter, went upon the line of said proposed improvement and made personal view of the proposed route and termini thereof, and after full investigation and due consideration of all the facts and conditions pertaining thereto; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That we do find and consider said improvement of sufficient public importance to instruct the County Engineer to make an accurate survey and plat of the same, and furnish an accurate and detailed description of the proposed improvement describing the center line and right of way lines thereof.

Said County Engineer shall also furnish an accurate and detailed description of each tract of land which he believes will be necessary to be taken in the event the proposed improvement be made, together with the name of each owner.

Said County Engineer shall also, at the time of making such survey, set stakes at the termini of each right of way line and at all angles between such termini, and at sufficient other points on the right of way lines so that the bounds of the proposed improvement may be discernible to property owners and other interested persons; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the said County Engineer be and he is hereby directed to make a report in writing to this Board, on or before the 16th day of July, 1975, the date fixed for the final hearing, setting forth his opinion either for or against said proposed improvement, and the width to which said improvement shall be opened, which shall not be less than thirty feet; said report shall be accompanied by said plat and detailed and accurate descriptions, and filed with the County Commissioners, and this cause is continued until said date.

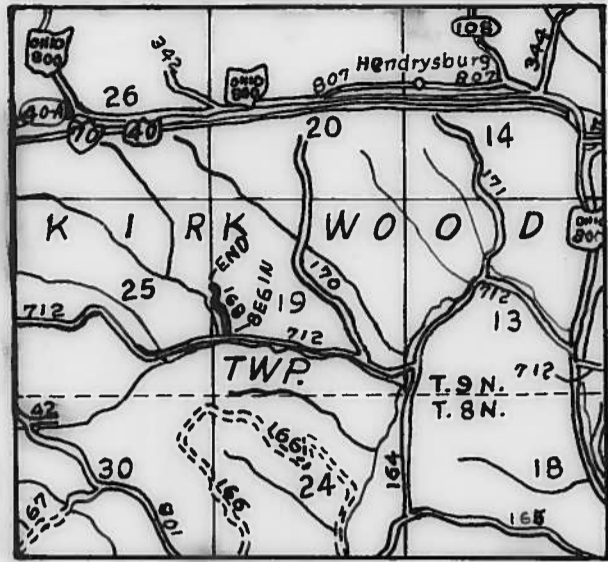

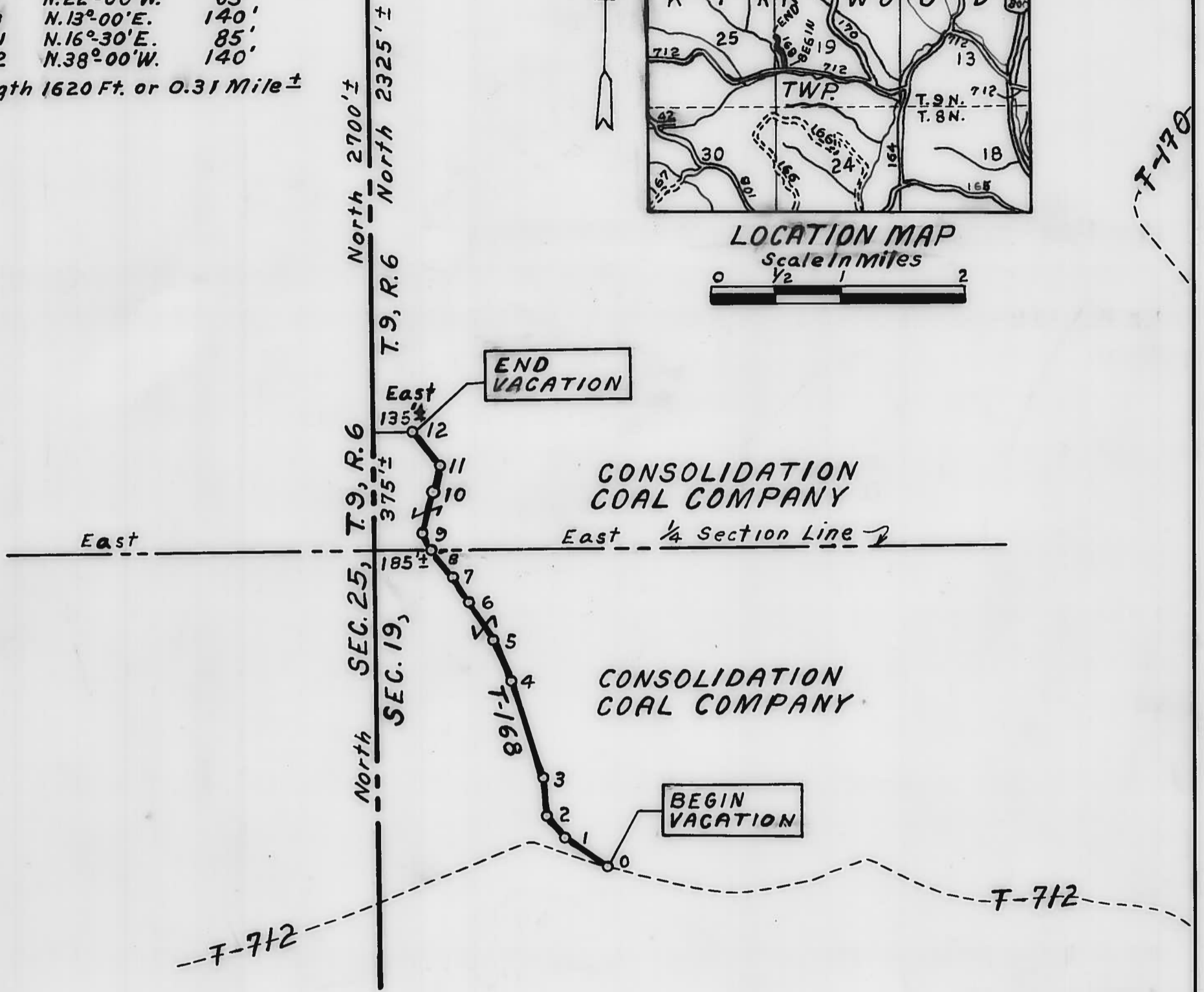

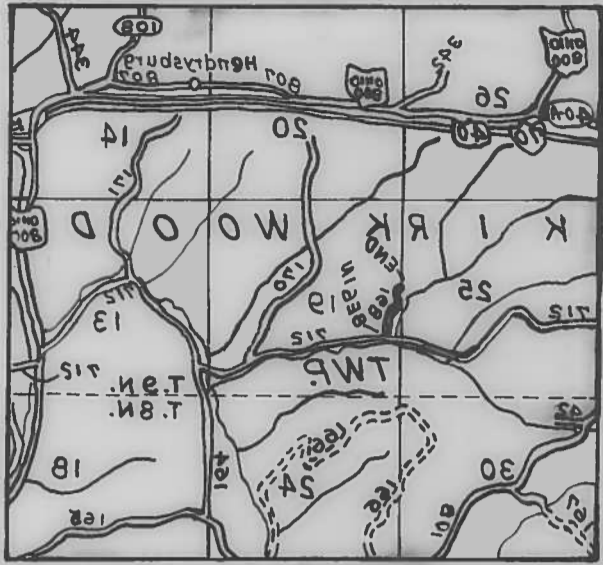
