WHEREAS, On the....2/st, day of.................. 19 , 79, the time heretofore fixed for view of the proposed improvement, we, the Board of County Commissioners having jurisdiction in said matter, went upon the line of said proposed improvement and made personal view of the proposed route and termini thereof, and after full investigation and due consideration of all the facts and conditions pertaining thereto; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That we do find and consider said improvement of sufficient public importance to instruct the County Engineer to make an accurate survey and plat of the same, and furnish an accurate and detailed description of the proposed improvement describing the center line and right of way lines thereof.

Said County Engineer shall also furnish an accurate and detailed description of each tract of land which he believes will be necessary to be taken in the event the proposed improvement be made, together with the name of each owner.

Said County Engineer shall also, at the time of making such survey, set stakes at the termini of each right of way line and at all angles between such termini, and at sufficient other points on the right of way lines so that the bounds of the proposed improvement may be discernible to property owners and other interested persons; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the said County Engineer be and he is hereby directed to make a report in writing to this Board, on or before the day of-..............-bru a ry...................., 1979., the date fixed for the final hearing, setting forth his opinion either for or against said proposed improvement, and the width to which said improvement shall be opened, which shall not be less than thirty feet; said report shall be acompanied by said plat and detailed and accurate descriptions, and filed with the County Commissioners, and this cause is continued until said date.

PROLUSED IMPROVEMENT OF COUNTY HIGIIYAY NO. 80
(IMPROVEMENT NO. 815)

Situated in Richland Township, Belmont County, Ohio and further known as being located in the west half of Section 27, Township 7, and Range 4.

The point of beginning for a description of the center-line of said proposed improvement is at a point located in the center of U. S. Route 40 , said point being located South 5 deg. 01' West 835.25 feet, South 75 deg. $14^{\prime}$ East, 757.72 feet and South 76 deg. $35^{\prime} 15.5^{\prime \prime}$ East, 357.91 feet from a stone at the Northwest corner of Section 27, (the bearing of the west line of Section 27 being South 5 deg. 01 ' West).

Thence from said point of beginning (Station 0+00) South 22 deg. 40' 36' West, 1759.63 feet to the P.C. of a curve (Station 17+59.63).

Thence with a curve to the right having a radius of 366.80 feet, an arc distance of 195.26 feet, and a chord bearing and distance for said arc being 55' South 37 deg. $36^{\prime \prime}$ West, 192.96 feet to the P.T. of said curve (Station 19+54.89).

Thence South 53 deg. $10^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime}$ West, 440.09 feet to the P.C. of a curve (Station 23+94.98).

Thence with a curve to the left having a radius of 398.03 feet, an arc distance of 329.75 feet, and a chord bearing and distance for said arc being South 29 deg. $26^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime}$ West, 320.40 feet to the P.T of said curve (Station 27+24.73), said point being located in the center-line of existing County Highway No. 80, said point being located North 05 deg. $42^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime}$ East 97.75 feet from a point in the North expansion plate of the County Highway No. 80 bridge over Interstate Route No. 70.

- point in the north expansion plate of the Route No. 80 Bridge over Interstate 1 Route No. 70; thence from said beginning point and through lands now owned ( by Robert Fleagane, the following two courses and distances: S. $84^{\circ}$ 17' $24^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$. 20 feet to a point in the easterly side of Route No. 80 ; thence with a curve to the left having a radius of 80 feet for an arc distance of 185 and 05/100 feet, chord bearing and distance for said arc being S. $60^{\circ} 33^{\prime}$ 24" E. 146 and $47 / 100$ feet to a point in the westerly line of the aforedescribed Parcel A; thence with same S. $53^{\circ} 10^{\prime} .36^{\prime \prime}$ W. 52 and $45 / 100$ feet to a point; thence with a curve to the left having a radius of 418 and $03 / 100$ feet for an arc distance of 216 and $48 / 100$ feet, chord bearing and distance for said arc being S. $38^{\circ} 20^{\prime} .27^{\prime \prime}$ W. 214 and $07 / 100$ feet to a point in the centerline of said Route No. 80 ; thence with same N. $05^{\circ} 42^{\prime \prime} 36 \prime$ E. 274 and 7/10 feet to the place of beginning, containing Three Hundred Sixteen, One Thousandths (316/1000) of an acre, more or less.

DESCRIPTION OF A RIGHT OF WAY THROUGH PROPERTY NOW OWNED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO.

The following right of way situate in Richland Township, Section 27, Township 7, Range 4, Belmont County, Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

PARCEL A - SIXTY FEET WIDE PLUS SLOPE RIGHTS, the centerline being more particularly.described as follows: Beginning at a point at the intersection of the centerline of $U$. S. Route 40 with the centerline of the hereinafter described right of way, said beginning point being located the following three (3) courses and distances from a stone at the northwest corner of said Section 27: S. $05^{\circ}$ O1'.W. (bearing on division line between Sections 33 and 27) 835 and 25/100 feet to a point in the centerline of U. S. Route 40 ; thence with same S. $75^{\circ}$ 14' E. (at 343 and $26 / 100$ feet passing the northwest corner of the property of the party of the first part hereto) 757 and $72 / 100$ feet to a point; thence with a curve to the left having a radius of 7,571 and 63/100 feet, for an arc distance of 357 and 94/100 feet, chord bearing and distance for said arc being S. $76^{\circ} 35^{\prime}$ 15.5" E. 357 and 91/100 feet to said beginning point; thence from said beginning point and with the centerline of said right of way S. $22^{\circ} 40^{\prime} 36{ }^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} . \mathrm{I}$ 1,732 and 17/100 feet to a point in the southerly line of said party of the part hereto, said point being located S. $84^{\circ} 51^{\prime} 50 "$ E. 75 and 02/100 feet from the southwest corner of said party of the first part hereto, containing
2.39 acres, more or less.

PARCEL B - WEST APPROACH TO ROUTE 40, $\wedge^{\text {being more particularly bounded }}$ and described as follows: Beginning at a point in the centerline of U. S.
 Route 40 at its intersection with the westerly line of the aforedescribed
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Parcel A, said beginning point being located N. $76^{\circ} 35^{\prime} 15.5^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} .20$ and 26/100 feet from the beginning point in said Parcel A; thence from said beginning point and with said westerly line S. $22^{\circ} 40^{\prime} 36^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} .176$ and 74/100 feet to a point; thence with a curve to the left having a radius of 140 and for an arc distance of 236 and 37/100 feet, 96/100 feet, $\wedge$ chord bearing and distance for said arc being N. $25^{\circ} 213^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$. 209 and $63 / 100$ feet to a point in the southerly side of U. S. Route 40 ; thence N. $13^{\circ} 24^{\prime} 44.5^{\prime \prime}$ E. 12 feet to a point in the centerline of said Route 40 ; thence with same S. $76^{\circ} 35^{\prime} 15.5^{\prime \prime}$ E. 159 and $74 / 100$ feet to the place of beginning, containing Eighteen, One Hundredths (18/100) of an acre, more or less.

PARCEL C - EAST APPROACH TO ROUTE 40, $\wedge^{\text {PLUS SLOPE RIGHTS }}$ more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the centerline of $U$. S. Route 40 at its intersection with the easterly line of the aforedescribed Parcel A, said beginning point being located S. $76^{\circ} 35^{\prime} 15.5^{\prime \prime}$ E. 20 and $26 / 100$ feet from the beginning point in said Parcel A; thence from said beginning point and with said centerline of U.S. Route $40 \mathrm{~S} .76^{\circ} 35^{\prime} \mathrm{IF} .5^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$. 100 feet to a point; thence S . $13^{\circ} 24^{\prime} 44.5^{\prime \prime}$ W. 11 feet to a point in the side of said Route 40; thence with a curve to the left having a radius of 128 and $3 / 10$ feet for an arc distance of 173 and $48 / 100$ feet, chord bearing and distance for said arc being S. $61^{\circ}$ 24' $45^{\prime \prime}$ W. 160 and 56/100 feet to a point in the aforesaid easterly right of way line of Parcel. A; thence with same, N. $22^{\circ} 40^{\prime}$ 36" E. 120 feet to the place of beginning, containing $1 / 10$ of an acre, more or less.

Said Parcels A, B and C being subject to that part of the right of way for U. S. Route 40 that is.included within the boundary of said parcel.

Said Parcel A, B and C being a part of the 46 and 63/100 acre tract of land that was conveyed by The Board of Trustees of Ohio University to The Board of County Commissioners, Belmont County, Ohio, as Section I, Parcel No. I in the deed dated August 15, 1974 and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Belmont County, Ohio, in Deed Volume 548, at page 767.

HHEREAS, Said Board has considered said report and all the testimony offered, and all the facts and conditions pertaining to said matter therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That said Board of County Commissioners do find said improvement and additions will serve the public convenience and welfare; by improving certain portions of County Road \#80, as setforth on the Engineer's Map which is attached to this Resolution and made a part hereof, by grading, draining, paving, straightening or widening and constructing or re-constructing culverts necessary for such improvements and to further locate and establish and additional county road known as County Highway \# 80 ,

BE IT RESOLVED, that all of the costs of said improvement shall be assumed by $R \& F$ Coal Company in lieu of being accessed against properties owned by R \& F Coal Company basically described as those properties upon which is situated a Coal Hashing Plant, which is located within two miles of the said improvement for the reason that this particular parcel will be most directly benefited by said improvement,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in addition to assuming all costs for said improvement $R \& F$ Coal Company is further assessed in the amount of Seventy-Two Thousand Dollars $(\$ 72,000.00)$ as damages to the residual of property owned by Belmont County and commonly known as the Oak View Property situated along U. S. Route 40, Richland Township, to which the said addition and extension of the County Road shall pass through,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said improvement as setforth and defined in said report, survey, plat and detailed and accurate descripti as filed by the County Engineer, being the same as hereby granted and said road is hereby ordered improved and extended in accordance with the specifications for said improvement; and
