

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said county, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Alteration of a County Road on the line hereinafter described, and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to cause the establishment of such road, to wit:

Beginning at or near a tree intersecting the County Road running in a northerly direction to Whitney and Warrock through the lands of Rott Irvin and Wall Irvin and thence in a westerly direction through the lands of the said Robert Irvin to where the old mill set was and thence along the fence to the heirs of Wm Fulton nearly opposite the residence of Thos Coon, and thence nearly in the same direction through the lands of the said heirs of Wm Fulton and along the fence to a small Ash near the lines of the heirs of Wm Fulton and the lines of M C & E B Gross, and thence through the lands of the said M C & E B Gross to or near a small Black Walnut, intersecting the County Road running north through the lands of M C & E B Gross and Albert McKelvey to Whitney and Warrock. The Conditions of the above obligations are such, That whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Belmont County for the Alteration of a County road on the following line, to-wit:

Beginning at or near a tree intersecting the county road running in a northerly direction to Whitney and Warrock through the lands of Robert Irvin and Wall Irvin and thence in a northerly direction through the lands of the said Robert Irvin to where the old Mill set was, and thence along the fence to the lands of the heirs of Wm Fullin nearly opposite the residence of Thos Coen and thence nearly in the same direction through the lands of said heirs of Wm Fullin and along the fence to a small ash near the lines of M C Gross & E B Gross, and thence through the lands of the said M C & E B Gross to or near a small Black Walnut intersecting the County road running with through the lands of M C & E B Gross and Albert McKelvey to Warrock and Whitney

M C Cross and E B Cross were selected by us as chain carriers, and Marion Cross as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed Alteration of Co. Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the Alteration of said road as follows:

In our opinion the alteration has contemplated render unnecessary the following described part of the original road, to wit;

All that part of original road lying between the junction of roads south of Beginning of the proposed Alteration to the junction of roads near hedge south of western end of said alteration (being the old road sought to be changed).

We would respectfully report that the said Alteration ought to be granted for the following reasons:

The original road is in the bed of the run the greater portion of the way and it is impossible a part of the time in winter and in its present location it never can be improved so as to make a good road. Public necessity demands the change of route. The proposed alteration takes the road out of the run and places it on good ground for road bed. The grades are easy or slight and the distance not increased. The cost of construction will not necessarily be very expensive being mostly through cultivated lands the owners of which ask no compensation for land appropriated.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such Alteration shall be established 30 feet in width.

The undersigned, in obedience to your order, dated June 5<sup>th</sup> 1901, proceeded on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June to survey and mark the Alteration of County Road described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

The following is a description of an Alteration of a County Road near Marbletown in Th 6. R 4 Sec 10 petitioned for by M C Gross et al and Viewed by John Workman, Miles Hart, and John Garrett, on June 27-1901,

Beginning for the same at a Gas Pipe on the west side of a public road from which a white oak 24" d bears N 20° 15' W 53° 4" and a White Oak 15" d bears N 29° W 63° 8". Thence N 17° W 386.92' to sta No 2. Thence N 25° 28' W 276.75' to sta No 3. Thence, N 2° 15' E 159.42' to sta No 4 near a small run. Thence N 48° 03' W 632.92' to sta No 5 near Robt Coopers house. Thence N 37° 35' W 273.33' to sta No 6. Thence N 75° 05' W 137.17 to sta No 7. Thence N 44° 28' W 125' to sta No 8. Thence N 60° 46' 158.83' to sta No 9. Thence S 83° 29' W 141.83' to sta No 10.
