


The Commissioners met in regular session, and

The Trustees of Colerain Township this day presented to Board of Commissioners, the Plat and survey of a strip of land in Colerain Township, Sec 24, owned by E N Boggs, which strip of land the said Trustees request Board to purchase for road purposes, to provide entrance to Colerain and Bartow Pike for certain persons who are prevented from getting onto Pike by reason of the grading on said Pike destroying the road heretofore used by said persons as an outlet to road.


Said Boggs agrees to deed to Belmont County for Road Purposes the strip of land shown in Plat (which is filed with Auditor) for the sum of \$50. said strip of land being 16 feet wide and 219 $\frac{1}{4}$  feet long, and the Board being of the opinion that said outlet to Pike is necessary and the sum asked for land being reasonable and just, that said road will be of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment out of the County Treasury; it is therefore ordered that the County Auditor draw his order on the County Treasurer in favor of E N Boggs for \$50, that the survey and Plat of said road be recorded in Road Record and that said road be established a public highway 16 feet wide.



LAKE STREET: Beginning for the same in the west division of Section 23, Township 7,

Range 5 in J E Hunt's East line 15 feet from the south west corner of the Epworth Park grounds and running south  $87\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  East 34.35 ft - 30 ft wide. ## Report of Viewers.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

In obedience to your order, issued at your March session, A. D. 1892, we the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with John A. Bond Surveyor, at High Ridge U. P. Chardon on March 19, 1902 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

If any Viewer is unable to attend here after by whom the vacancy was filled.

W. A. Bond and Albert Hearn were selected by us as chain carriers, and James E. Dixon as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed county road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the establishment of said road as follows:

We would respectfully report that the said county road ought to be granted for the following reasons:

Because there is no public road on the route surveyed it would be of great public utility and can be made at a reasonable expense.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such road shall be established 33 feet in width. full length except along hillside from Station 22 to 35 which is to be 40 feet in width.


