

ROAD PETITION.


For Establishing Road in Mead Twp

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

The undersigned resident freeholders of said county, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the location of a county road along the following described route, to-wit:

Beginning for the same in Mead Township at a point in the county road on Wegee creek near the residence of Mary W Mahaffey; thence over her lands northwesterly and near the line of a township road; over the lands of Ollie Milligan, James Workman, Martha Hathorn, Merriman K Meek heirs of Joseph Huffman and Board of Education and Mead Township Sub-district No. 7 to intersect the county road near the School house in said sub-district No 7.

Said petitioners therefore ask that such proceedings may be had to establish such road as may be required by law.

That we, M N Meek, Martha Hathhorn and J W Hathhorn,
are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, for the use of Belmont County, in the penal sum of Two
Hundred Dollars, for the true and faithful payment of which well and truly to be made,
we bind ourselves, jointly and severally, our heirs, executors and administrators, by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated at St. Clairsville this 1st day of June 1893.

The Conditions of the above obligations are such, That whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Belmont County for the opening of a County road on the following line, to-wit:

Beginning for the same in Mead Township at a point on the county road on Weegee Creek near the residence of Mary W Mahaffey; thence over her lands northeasterly and near the line of a township road; over the lands of Ollie Milligan, Martha Hathorn, James Workman Merriman N Meek, Heirs of Joseph Huffman, and Board of Education of Mead Township, Sub-district No. 7, to intersect the county road near the school-house in said Sub-district No. 7.

Now if the said applicants shall pay into the Treasury of the said County the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or when the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be in full force in law.

The Commissioners met in regular session at their office, and the Board being satisfied that the foregoing petition was signed by at least twelve freeholders of the County, residing in the vicinity of the establishment of said county road, and that the proper notices had been given according to law, bond filed, approved and accepted, thereupon the Board appointed Wm McFarland, Wm King and W W Watt three disinterested freeholders of the County, viewers, and John A. Bond surveyor of said proposed road, to meet at place of residence of J W Hathorn on July 10th 1903, for the purpose of discharging their official duties relative to the object prayed for in the foregoing petition. And the Auditor is authorized to notify all non-resident land owners by publication, as required by law.

Report of Viewers.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

In obedience to your order issued at your meeting October 12th session A. D. 1893, we the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with John A. Bond Surveyor, at Heath, Ohio on July 10th Oct. 21st and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

Wm Mc Farland being unable to attend to the duties assigned R S Hutchison was chosen as viewer and duly qualified.

If any Viewer is unable to attend here state by whom the vacancy was filled.

David Brown and John Dunfee were selected by us as chain carriers, and M K Meek as a marker, who were also duly sworn. last view

We then proceeded to view said proposed County road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the establishment of said road as follows: after making report on July 10th, 1903, under an order of the commissioners dated June 1st, 1903, and the county commissioners not being satisfied with said report issued an order dated Oct. 12th, 1903, (see page 151) for a review and corrected report. A part of the first report with corrections indicated is made a final report by the viewers and surveyor.

We would respectfully report that the said County road ought to be granted and opened for the following reasons:

First, better grade; second, better ground and shorter distance; third, it practically avoids one heavy hill; fourth, the interests of the public in general will be promoted.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such proposed county road shall be established 30 feet in width.

The Commissioners met in special session.

Final action having been deferred on the foregoing petition at the session held Sept 9th, 1903, and at the session held Oct. 12th 1903, the viewers and surveyor were directed to review said proposed road and to make corrected report. Said review having been had and report of same made to this board, it is ordered that compensation and damages be awarded and paid out of the county treasury to the said claimants as follows:

Surveyor's Report.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

The undersigned, in obedience to your order, dated October 12th, 1893, proceeded on the 21st day of October to survey and mark the described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

Beginning at a stone we set in road on Wegee creek from which the N & Cov. of Mary U McHaffey's house bears S 76° 10' W 175 links and a sycamore tree bears N 53° 45' E 25 links; thence N 49° 50' W 3.80 P. to Sta. 2; thence N 34° 34' W 3.32 P. to Sta. 3 on North side of Wegee creek; thence N 50° 02' W 6 P. to Sta. 4 near foot of hill; distance from Sta. 3 to the center of P. Q & L RR 40 links; thence N 76° 09' W 16.88 P. to Sta. 5 on lands of Ollie Millison; thence N 81° 53' W 4.48 poles to Sta. 6; thence N 82° 56' W 5.16 poles; to Sta. 7; thence S 76° 50' W 14.56 poles to Sta. 8 at line between Ollie Millison and James Workman on hill; thence N 33° 31' W 3.98 poles to Sta. 9; on lands of Ollie Millison. near a large boulder on roadside; thence N 15° 50' W 7.44 poles to Sta. 10. on lands of Ollie Millison; thence N 13° 35' W 9.20 poles to Sta. 11 where 2nd route in 1st survey left the lower route at turn of hill; thence N 10° 45' W 8.60 to Sta. 14 on lands of Ollie Millison; thence N 14° 50' W 16.80 poles to Sta. 15 west of Millisons barn; thence N 20° W 17.68 poles to Sta. 16 west of old road; thence N 21° 16' W 8.20 poles to Sta. 17 intersection of 1st route; thence N 18° 30' W 31.04 poles to Sta. 18; thence N. 19° 58' W 8.32 poles to Sta. 19 opposite Hathorns barn; thence 25° 57' W 9.04 poles to Sta. 20 on east side of old road; thence N 39° 11' W 8.64 poles to Sta. 21 in road by Hathorns house; thence N 56° 41' W 21.80 poles to Sta. 22; thence N 62° 55' W 3.80 poles to Sta. 23; thence N 76° 15' W 11.44 poles to Sta. 24; thence N 40° 35' W 11.04 poles to Sta. 25 in berry patch; thence N 66° 17' W 6.52 poles to Sta. 26; thence N 84° 21' W 19.04 poles to Sta. 27 in Meeks field; thence S 89° 29' W 9.56 poles to Sta. 28 in Meeks field; thence N 81° 59' W 9.52 poles to Sta. 29 in Meeks field; thence N 62° 42' W 11.84 poles to Sta. 30 near road in Meeks field; thence N 30° 14' W 17.60 poles to Sta. 31 in edge of public road; thence N. 43° 04' W 42 poles to Sta. 32 at a point 15 feet south of Meeks garden; thence N 49° 51' W 13 poles to Sta. 33 a point 15 feet from the northeast of Meeks stable and near house; thence N 72° 11' W 3.80 poles to Sta. 34 in old road; thence N 62° 07' W 22.80 poles to Sta. 35 in old road; thence N 61° 17' W 29 poles to Sta. 36; to the line between M K Meek and school lot; thence N 79° 01' W 24.72 poles to the end in the center of public road. Set a stone at intersection of county road near No. 7 schoolhouse in Mead Township known as Mt Vernon school. Length of road 457.94 Poles = 1.431 miles.
