are reasonable and just; that said road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said compensation and damages out of the County Treasury, and no petition for review having been filed, it is ordered that the County Auditor, issue his warrant on the County Treasurer in favor of said claimants for the amount of compensation and damages so awarded to them respectively, that the several reports of the Viewers with the survey and plat of said established road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway forty feet in width; that the County Auditor issue the necessary order to the Trustees of Somerset Township to open said road according to law.


