It is further ordered, that the County Auditor issue, in the name of the Board, an order to the Trustees of Putney Tp, directing them to cause said road to be opened according to law.

The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said county, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Alteration of a County road on the line hereinafter described, and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to

Richland Township in said County, one known as the Peyton Harrison road
the other Barnesville roads, between the following points to-wit: 1st alteration
of the first named roads, beginning at a point 13 rods east of the Pine grove
school house, thence north to a point intersecting old road near a building
white oak tree, 2nd alteration of said road, beginning at a point where the
present road buds in a north easterly direction, opposite and west of the
farm house on the farm of J. E. Kintner and running thence in a northerly di-
rection to a point on the Barnesville road 30 rods west of the law

SURVEYOR'S REPORT.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

The undersigned, in obedience to your order, dated July 3, 1888, proceeded, on the 7th day of Aug 1888 to survey and mark the County road described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

Beginning at a stake in the road leading from the Pinegrove Schoolhouse, to the St. Clairsville and Warner Pike on the lands now owned by Wm Warner Jr said stake is in the middle of the road; and a white oak tree 12 inches in diameter bears S 30° E 25¹/₂ links; another white oak 18 in. in diam. bears S 39° 4' N 44¹/₂ links; running thence through the lands of Jno. C. Kintner N 10° E 32 poles Station 1; thence N 31° 1/2° E 3.68 poles to Sta. 3; thence N 43° 3/4° E 17 poles to Sta 4; thence N 26° E 12 poles to Sta 5; thence N 13° 1/4° E 8 poles to Sta 6; thence N 1° N 14 poles to Sta 7; thence N 7° 1/2° E 46 poles to Sta 8; thence N 5° E 34 poles to Sta 9; thence N 4° N 79.48 poles to Sta 10, it being 3 links north of a large sugar, and on the land line between the said Kintner and Robt Hammond; thence up the N. W. bank of a run N 45° 1/2° E 20 poles to Sta 11; thence N 33° 3/4° E 18.69 poles to Sta 12; thence N 63° E 13.83 poles to Sta 13; thence N 36° 1/2° E 21.50 poles to Sta 14; thence N 7° N 14.50 poles to Sta. 15; thence N 30° N 14 poles to Sta 16; and thence N 16° E 2.60 poles to a stake in the St. Clairsville road from which a marked locust post bears N 54° 1/4° E 34¹/₂ links, another locust post, bears N 44° N 34¹/₂ links.

Beginning for the Magee road at Sta 10, on the Kintner and Hammond line three links north of a large sugar tree; and running thence along said line N 87° N 67.70 poles to the section line; and Magee line; and thence N 70° 1/2° N 127 poles to a stake in the Barnesville road, opposite a gate from which a Black Oak two ft. in diam. bears N 73° 3/4° N 38 links.

We would respectfully report that the said new road & alteration ought to be established for the following reasons:

Because the old road is practicably impossible during the winter & because of the steep grade it is almost impossible for a heavy load in the summer while the alteration shortens the road & affords any easy grade without doing material damage.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such new road & alteration shall be established thirty feet in width.
