Yours The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said county, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Alteration of of the County road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to known as the Peyton such road, to-wit: Beginning at Harrison road in said County, in Sec 14 and partly in Sec 15 in Richland Tp between the following points to-wit: Beginning at a point 13 rods east of the New Grove School house; thence north to a point intersecting old road near a budding white oak tree, thence following the old road to a point where the same bends in a northeasterly direction opposite and west of the farm house on the farm of Jno C Kintner; and thence north to or near a sugar tree at the line between the lands of Susan Hammond and said Kintner; thence north through the lands of said Hammond to a point intersecting the road known as the Barresville Road at a point about 79 rods east of the west line of said sections 14 & 15. To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

The undersigned, in obedience to your order, dated June 3<sup>rd</sup> 1889, proceeded, on the Sixth day of August to survey and mark the Alterations proposed in the road described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

Beginning at a stake in the middle of the road leading from the Harrison road to the St. Clairsville and Vannock pike. said stake is about 13 rods east of the Pine Grove school house. and fifteen feet south of the section line between sections 13 & 14 from which a white — 12 inches in diameter bears south 30. E 25 1/2 links. another white oak 18 inches in diameter bears south 39 1/2 west 44 links.

In obedience to your order, issued at your Jan session, A. D. 1889, we the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with James McMillen Surveyor, at St Clairsville on Aug. 6 1889 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially the duties required of us in said order.

Matthew Davis and O. H. Davis were selected by us as chain carriers, and J. B. Magee as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed Alteration of a County road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the \_\_\_\_\_ of said road as follows:

In our opinion, the alterations hereby contained stated, render unnecessary the following described part of the original road to wit: So much of said old road as lies between the following points to wit: From the Pine Grove school house to the budding white Oak tree named in said petition, and from the point where said old road bends in a northwesterly direction opposite and west of the farm house of J. O. Lintner to the point where the same intersects the road known as the Baumsville road.

We would respectfully report that the said alteration of said road to be made for the following reasons: Because the same avoids one very steep hill and other heavy grades on said old road, and being over much better ground, makes a great much better road, in respect to grade, distance, and public utility, and further the alterations that we have recommended, can be made at very little cost, and that the same can be maintained, better easier, and at much less cost, than those portions of said old road, which in our opinion are rendered useless by said alterations.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such Alteration shall be established thirty feet in width.
