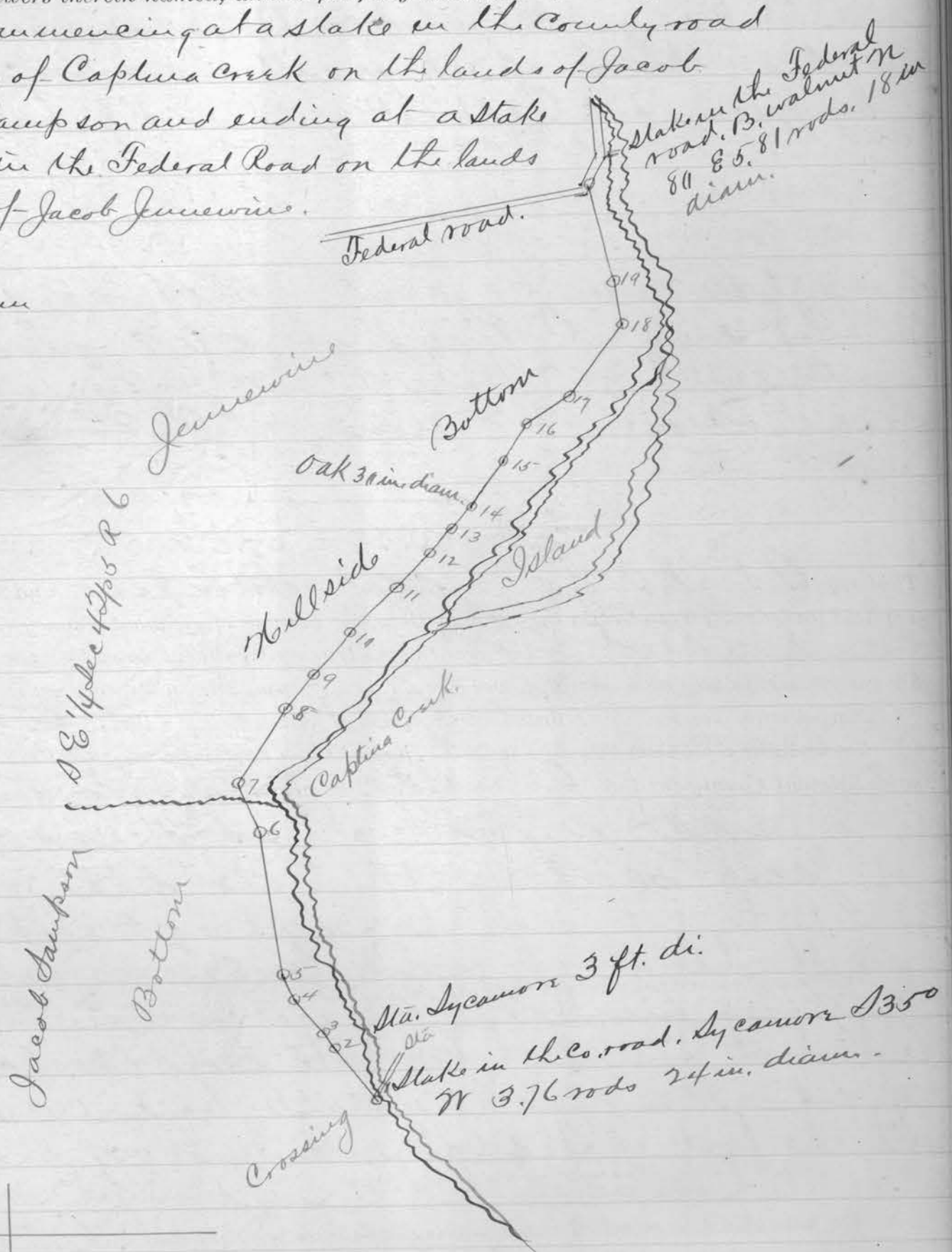

In obedience to your order, issued at your Oct 19 session, A. D. 1889, we the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with Jennings Perkins Surveyor, at Jacob Sampson on Monday Oct 28 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially the duties required of us in said order.

U V Wallaer was not present and W D Meehem was selected in his stead

Reuben Taylor and Jno Morris were selected by us as chain carriers, and Chas Jewenine as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the Establishment of said road as follows:
