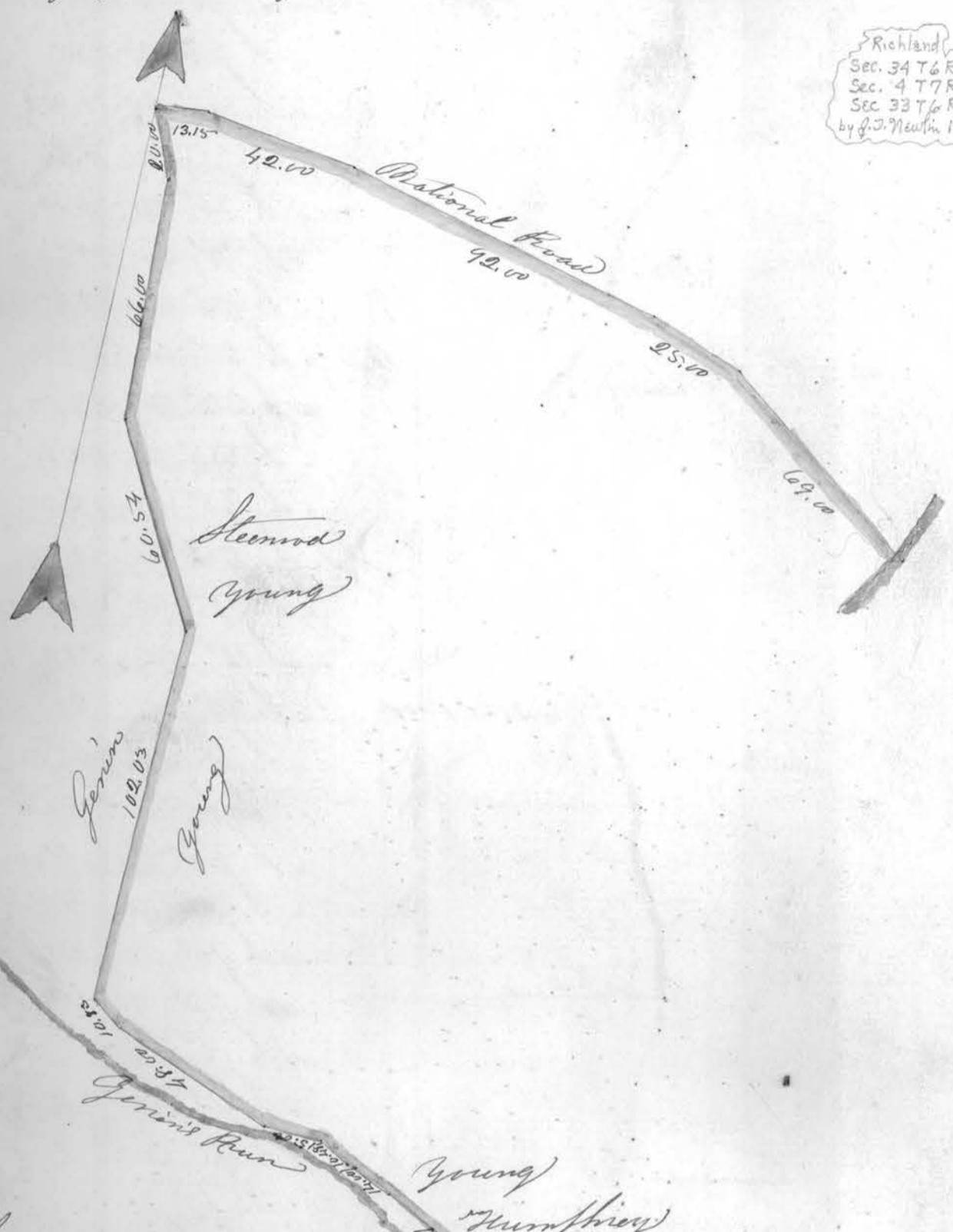

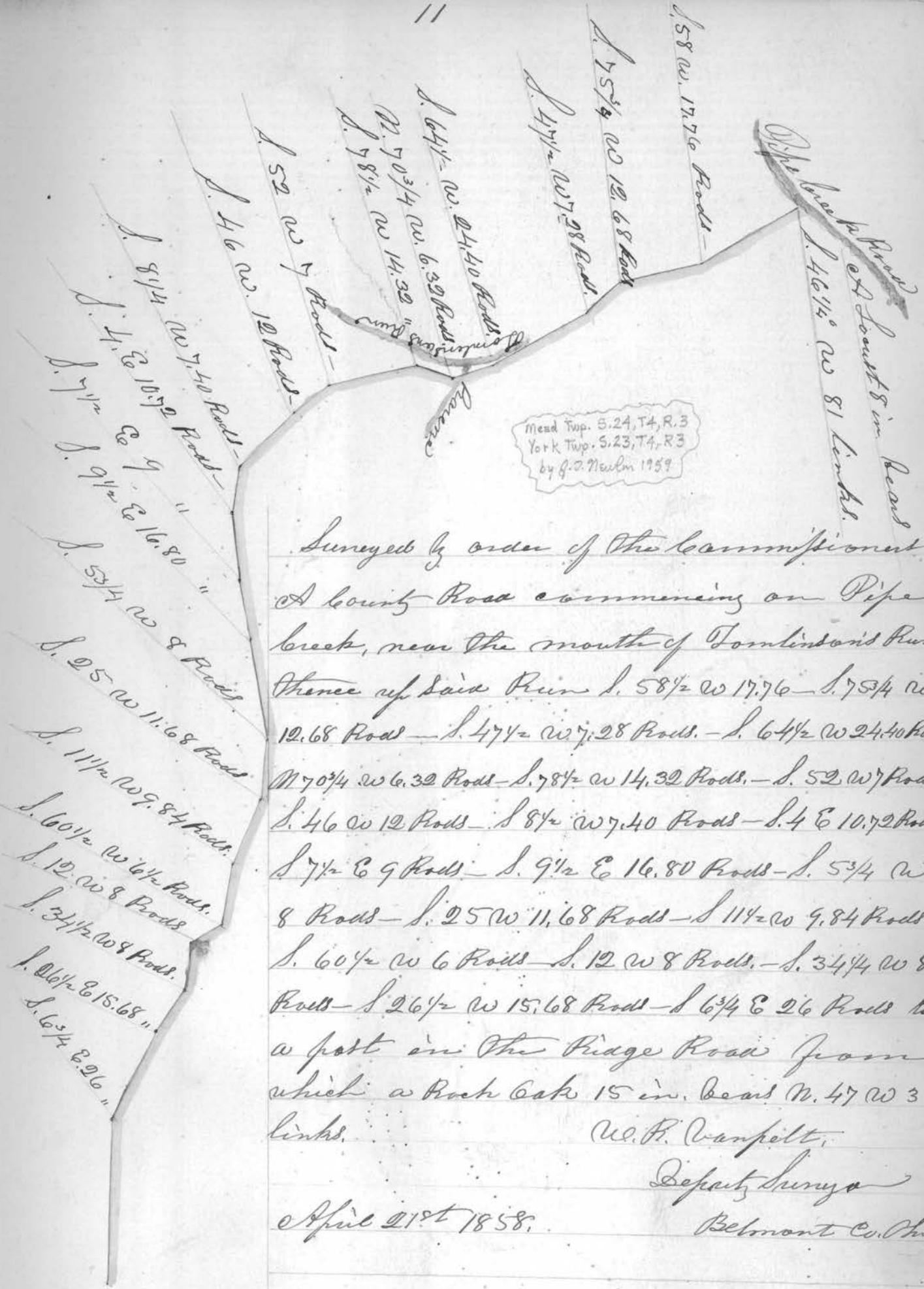

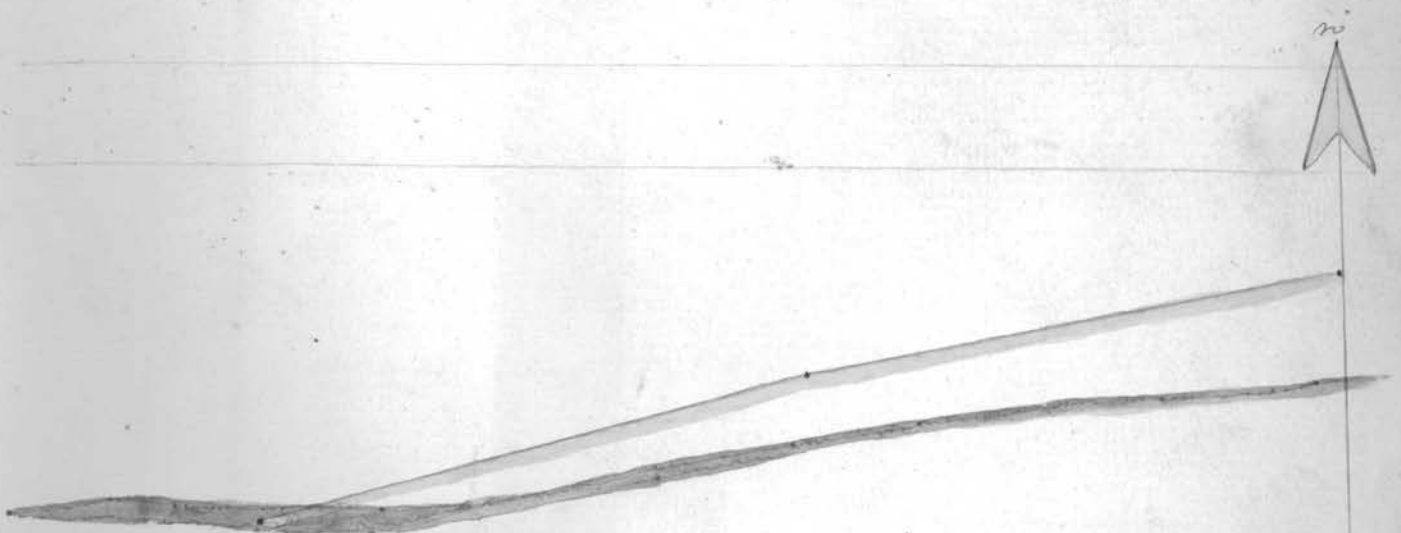

between James Plummer and — Woods.

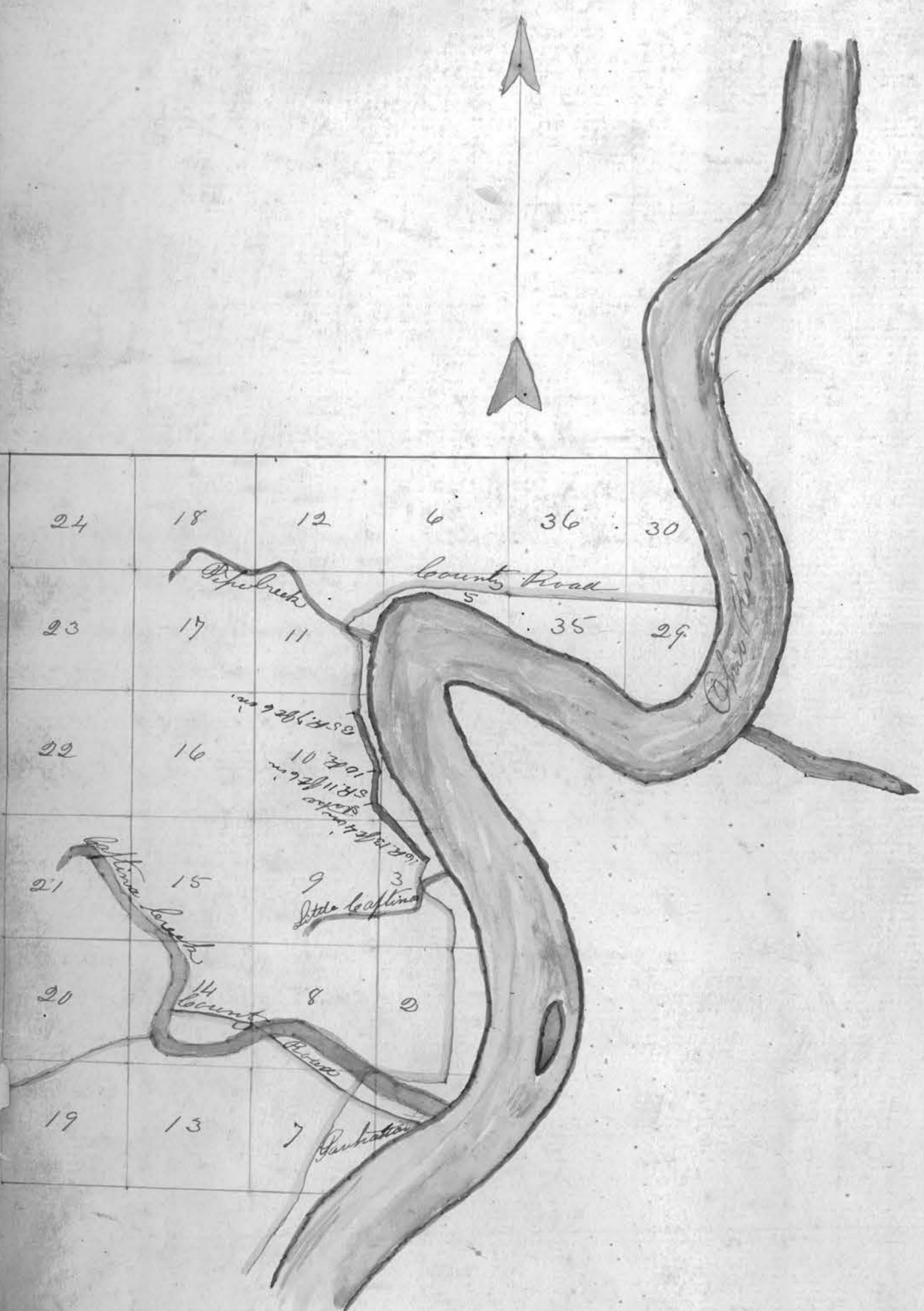

The Survey commenced at the South West end of said alteration, on the upper Edge of the old Road, thence running 16 Rods 13 feet 4 inches N. N. E. Thence 5 Rods 11 feet 6 inches N. W., Thence 10 Rods N. to corner of Brick Kiln, Thence 35 Rods 7 feet 6 inches to the S. W. corner of T. Day's State. Making 68 Rods in length and 20 feet wide, of new territory or ground taken in, containing 1/2 an Acre, 2 Rods 4/33 of a Perch.

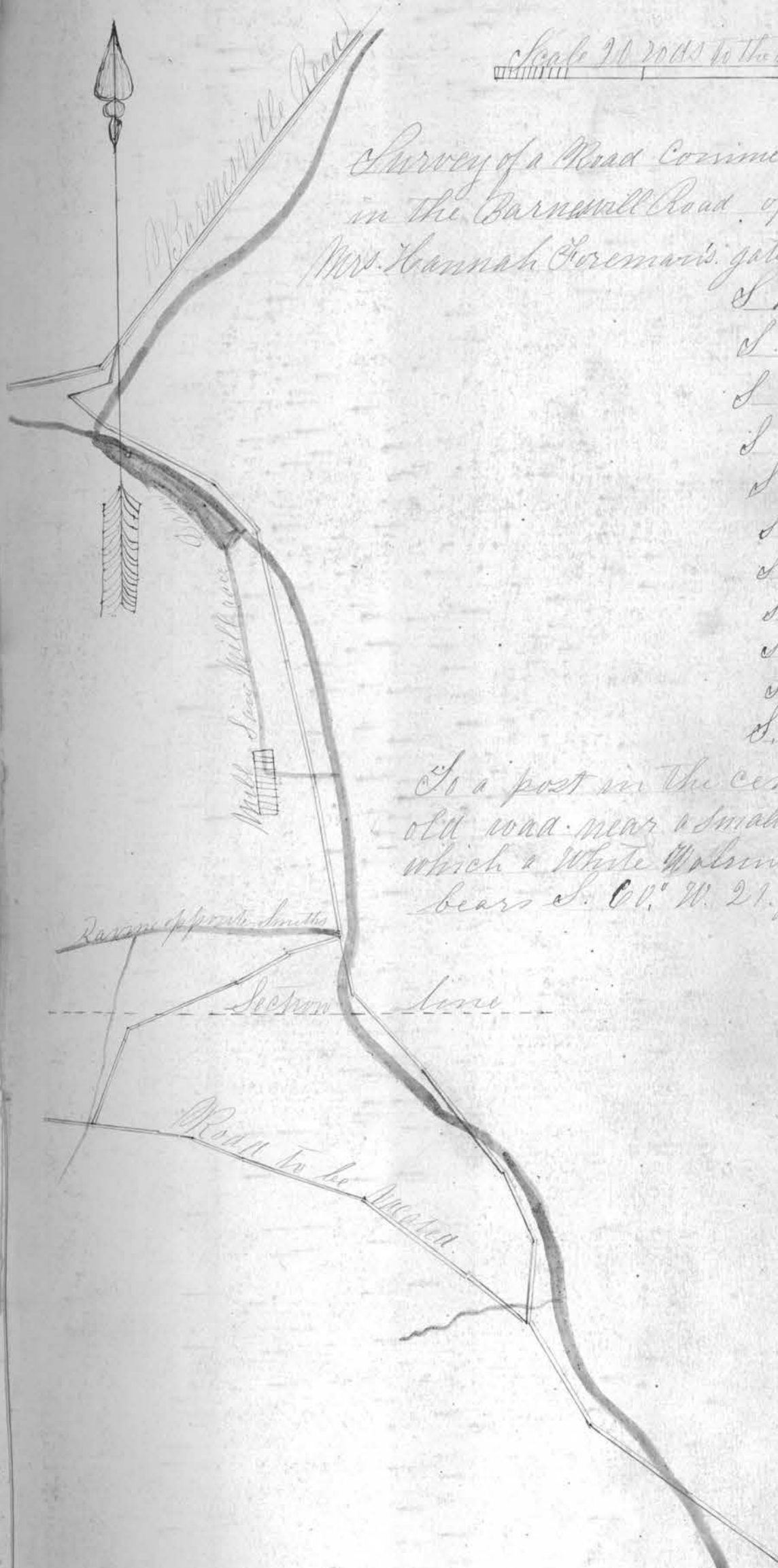

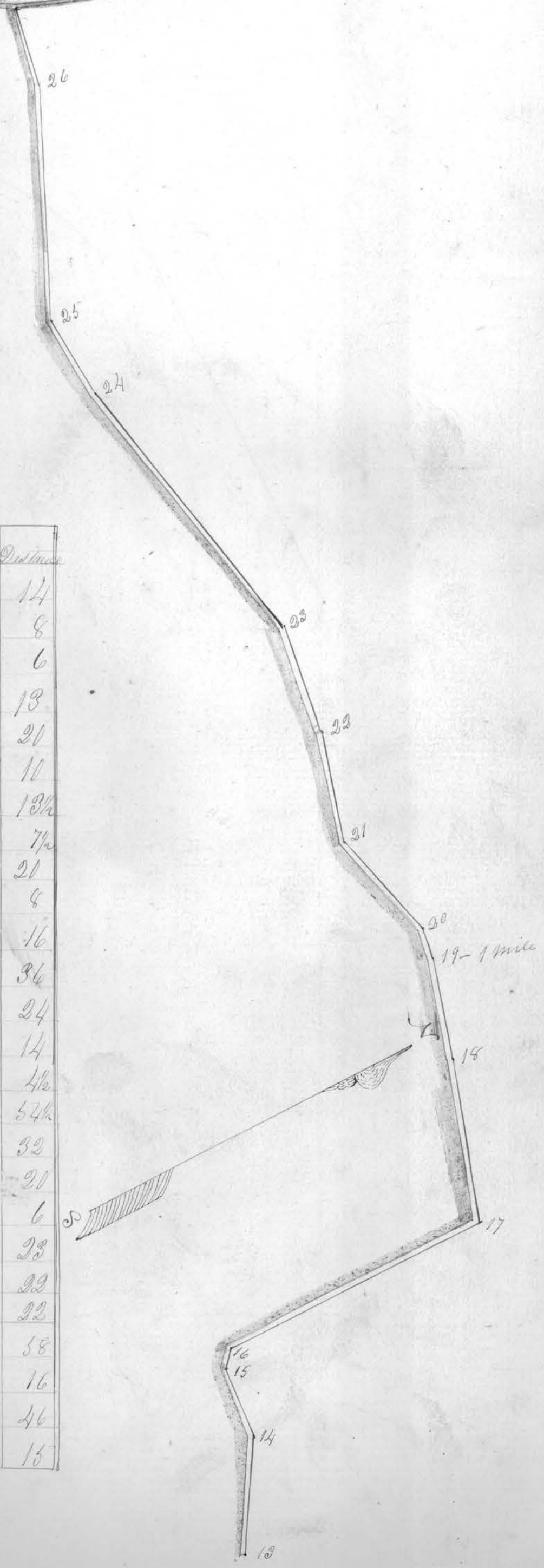


Plat of Road in

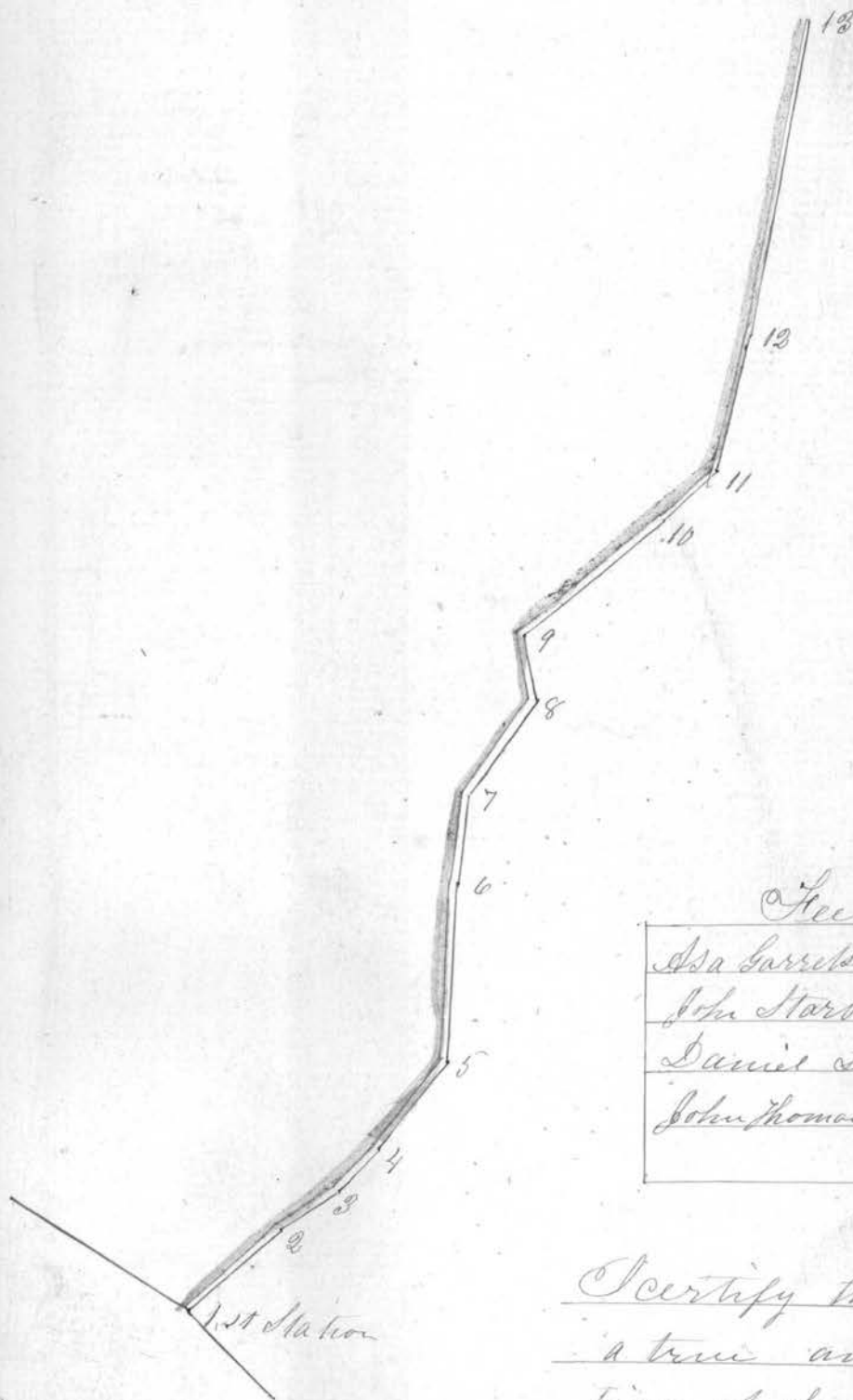
