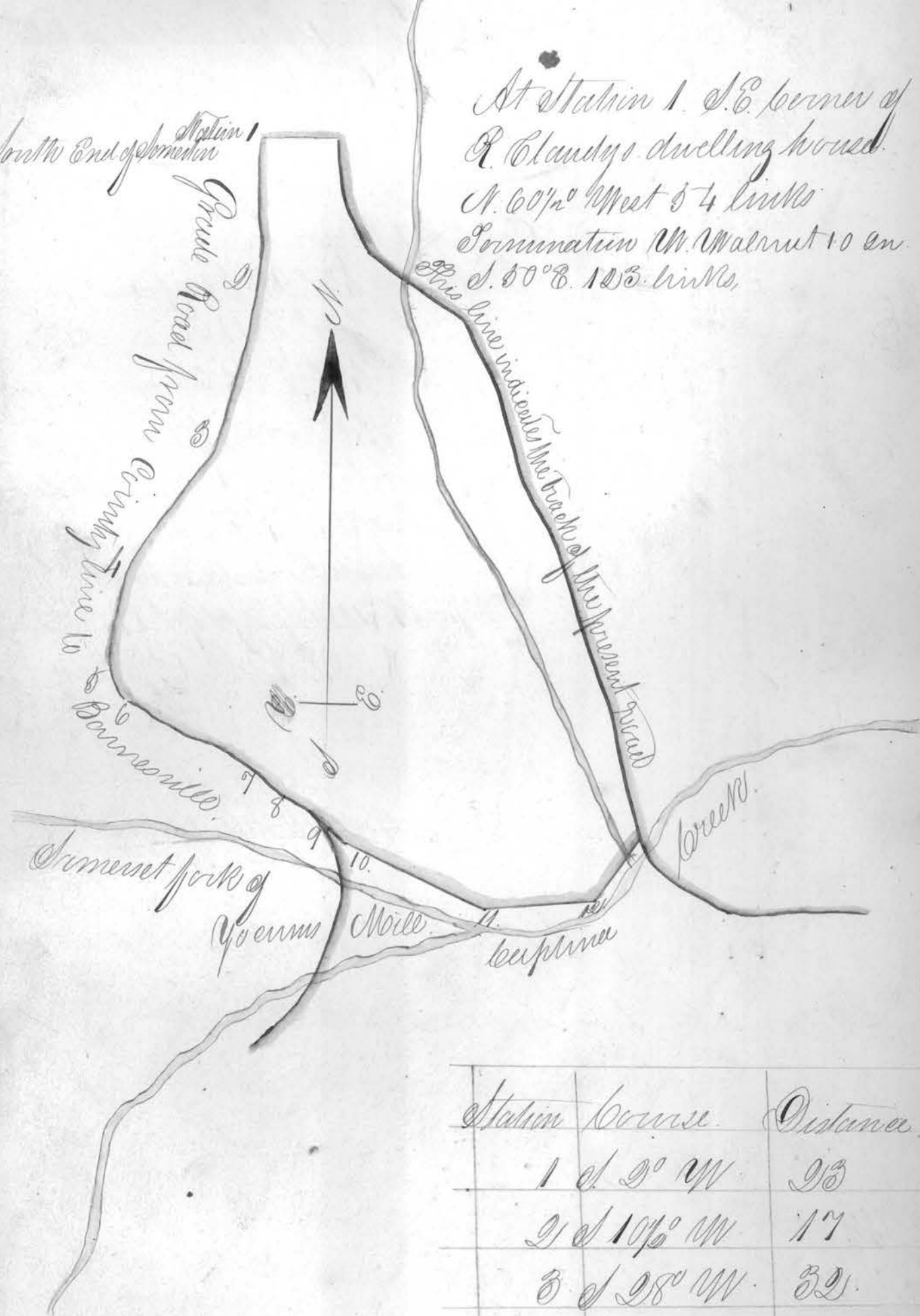

Reyners, as surveyed by Thomas Montetree. 1857.

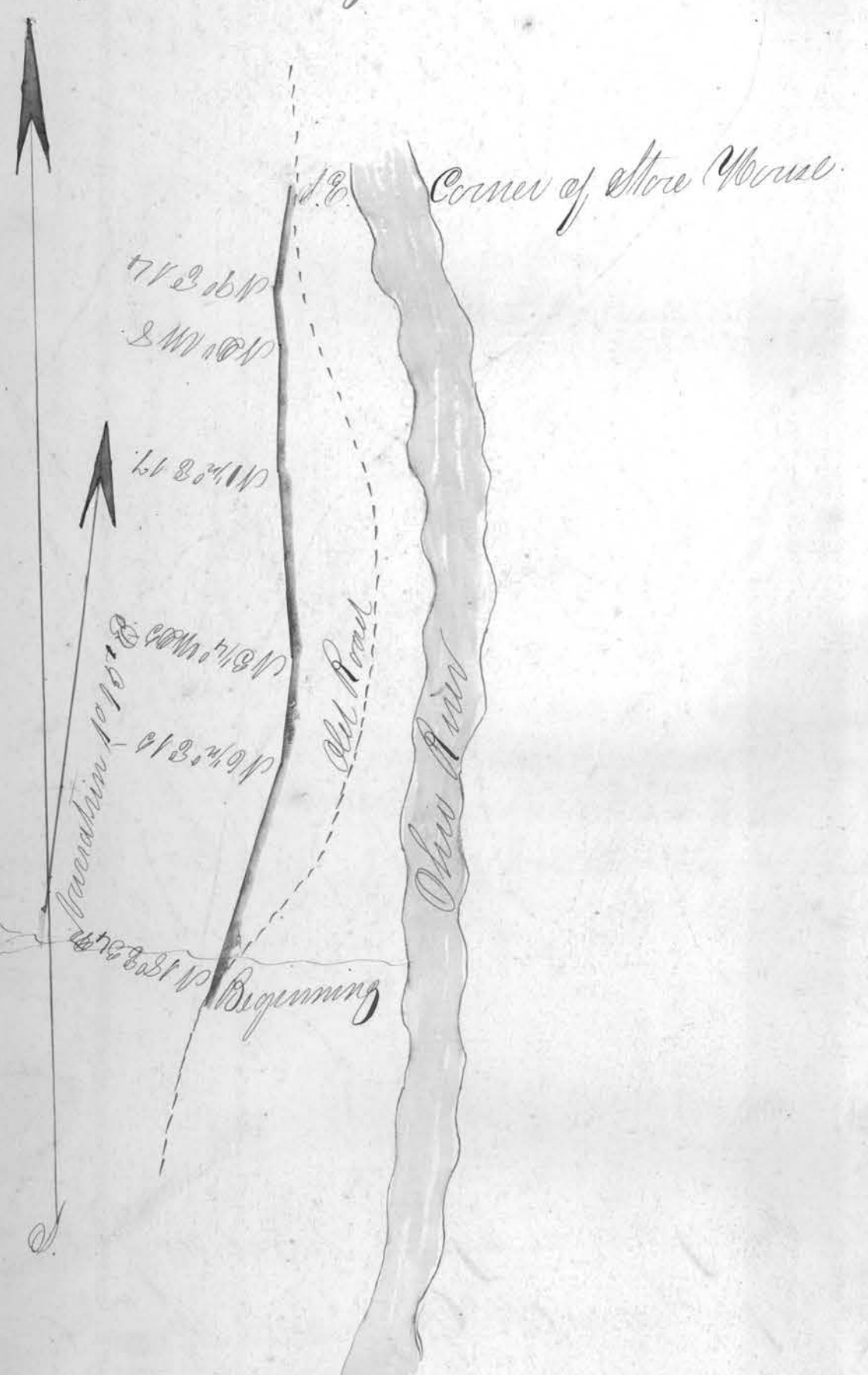

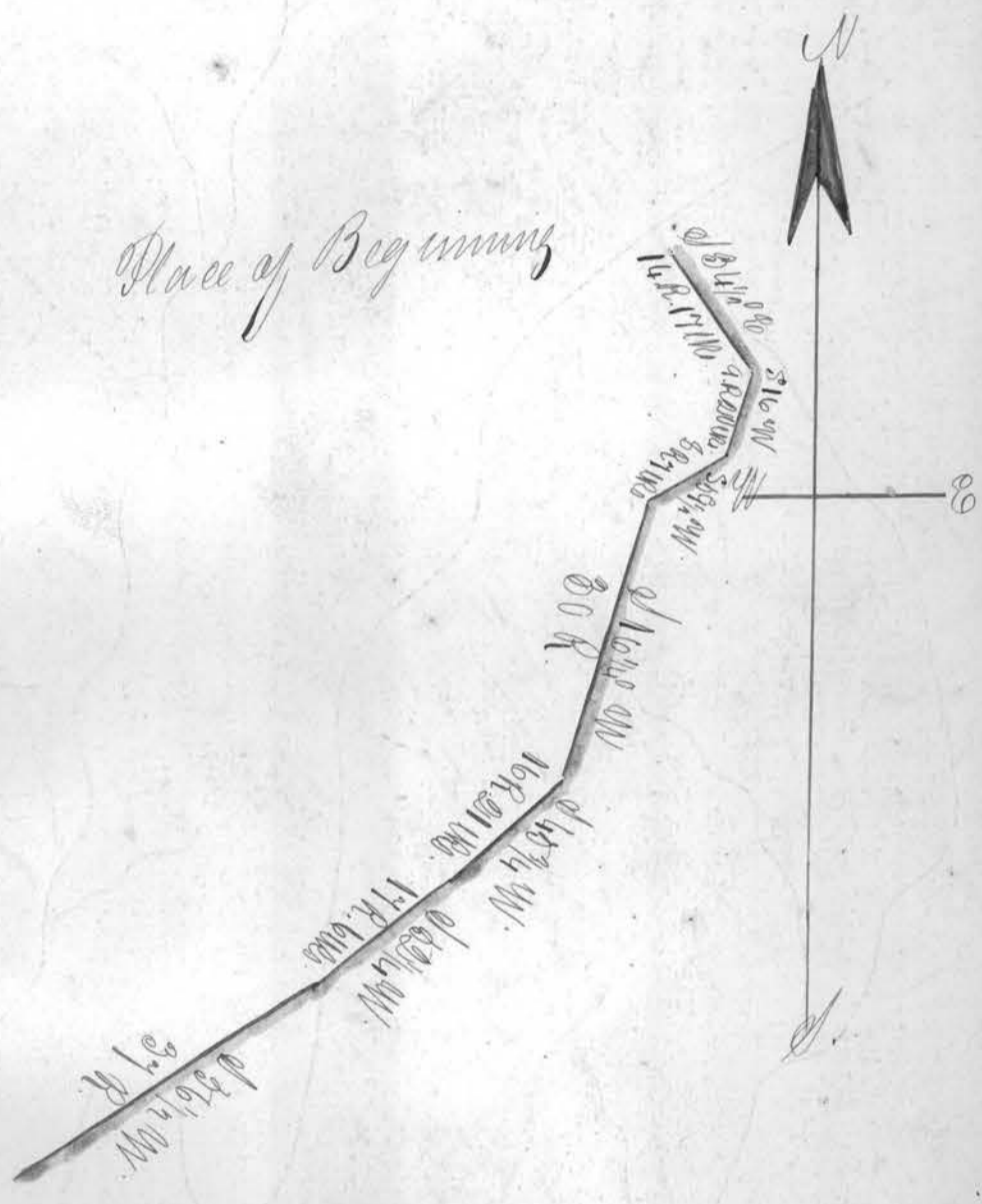

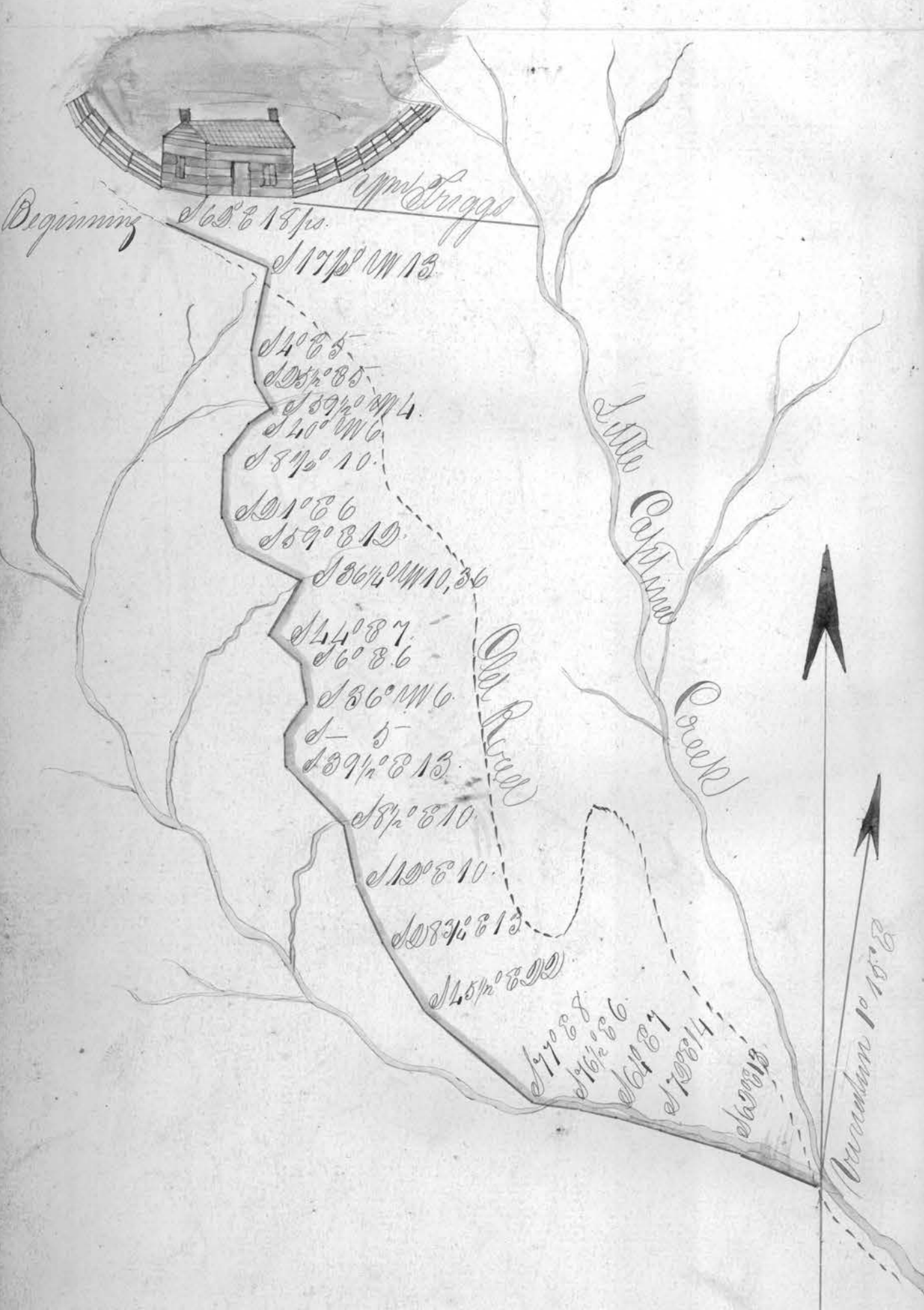
