AARON SHANNON

AND OTHERS

St. Clairsville, Ohio, October 29, 1917.

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, met this day in special session, present J. R. Greenlee, A. J. Geller and W. R. King, Commissioners and Bert W. Hopkins, Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that Aaron Shannon and others having filed a plat in the office of the Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, on this 29th day of October, 1917, dedicating certain lands for the alteration of a County Road, northwest of Steinersville, in York Township, Section 15, Township 4, and Range 3, and known as the "Shannon McIntyre Road" with the description of same attached thereto as follows, to-wit: Beginning for the same near the present Road a short distance north of a Tennant House on the lands of John W. McIntyre, thence passing through the lands of said John W. McIntyre and Aaron Shannon in a direction which is generally southeasterly, passing south of said Aaron Shannon's Sheep Barn to a point in the present Road and near the lane leading to Aaron Shannon's Residence. And the same is this day considered by the Board of Commissioners, and it appearing that said plat and description is regular and in conformity to law. It is ordered that the 27th day of November, A. D. 1917 at one o'clock P. M. be fixed as the date to view the same at which date they will meet at the commencing point of said proposed road and go over the route of the same. They also fix the date of December 10, 1917 at one o'clock P. M. as the date for final hearing, at the office of the County Commissioners, at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and Damages. It is further ordered that notice of the time and place for both such view and hearing be given by publication, once a week for three consecutive weeks, in the Herald-Tribune, a newspaper published, and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, met this day in Special session, present J. R. Greenlee, A. J. Geller, and W. R. King Commissioners

and Bert W. Hopkins Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that in the matter of the Alteration of the public road, petitioned for by

Aaron Shannon and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view the road petitioned for by

Aaron Shannon and others, in the Herald-Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in said county as required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the commissioners on this 27th day of November 1917 met at the time and place in said notice designated, and

did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor, ~~make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in~~ ^{whatsoever plats and surveys as may be necessary} according to law and report the same to this Board in writing on or before the 10th day of December 1917 the time set for the hearing, and

shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, accompanied with a statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation, whose land is to be taken, if the proposed improvement is established. Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than 30 feet nor more than 60 feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

SURVEYOR'S REPORT ON ROAD.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

Pursuant to your order dated November 27, 1917, I make my report to you as follows in the matter of the Dedication of the public road petitioned for by Aaron Shannon and others.

Hopkins Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that in the matter of the Alteration of the Public Road petitioned for by the Dedication of Aaron Shannon and others, the same came on to be heard for final hearing on the matter of granting said improvement, on this 10th day of December 1917, and find that notice thereof has been given as provided by law, and the former orders made herein, and after having made a view of said proposed road improvement, and having had the report of the surveyor read, and heard the protests for and against the same, find that said improvement will serve the public convenience and welfare and said improvement is granted, and the same is hereby ordered granted and established.

And the 17th day of December 1917 at 9:00 o'clock A.M. is fixed as the date for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

And it is further ordered that the Auditor cause notice in writing to be given to the owner or owners through or upon whose lands said improvement is established, and this matter is adjourned to said date.
