The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the \_\_\_\_\_ establishing \_\_\_\_\_ of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning  
 For the same at a point on the National Road at or near to Stop 22, on the Wheeling Traction Company's to Barton, Ohio, and where the present public road as now located begins; thence in a northerly direction on and along said road as now located, unless for good cause a relocation or change in same would be beneficial, to the general public, to the present termini of said road at the lands of one Andy Franz, passing through the lands of Charles Schramic, Albert Ochsenbeine, Charles Stahl, James Kutcherer, Charles Gustini, Pete Gustina, Bedrick Kutcherer, Frank Carbol, William Gasser; thence continuing in a northerly direction through the lands of Hall Gow, Albert Kinney and Edward Fox, to the termini thereof at a point on the Bridgeport, Colerain and Cadiz pike and on the lands of the said Fox, approximately five hundred yards west of what is commonly known as "Blackford's Schoolhouse".

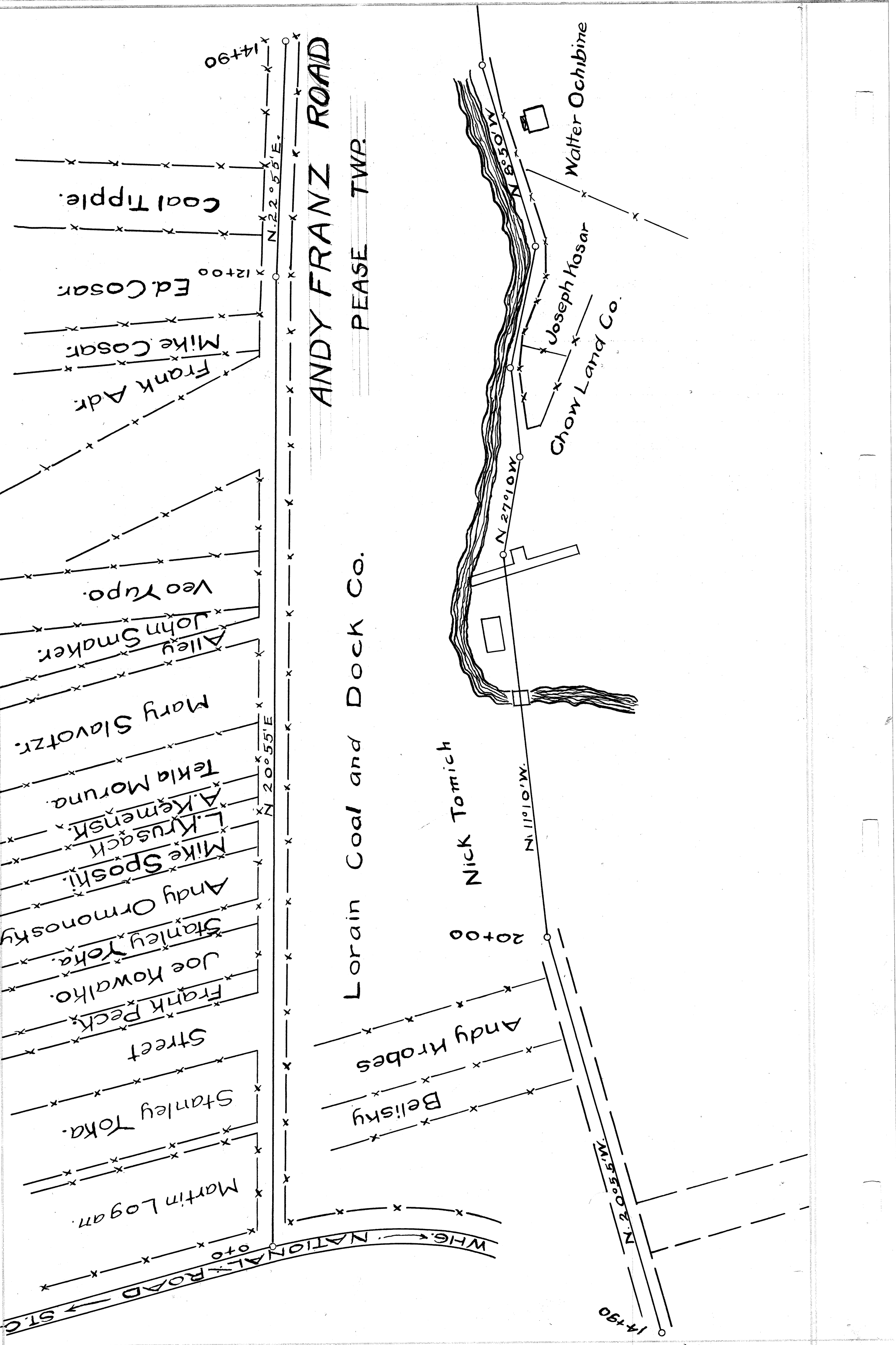

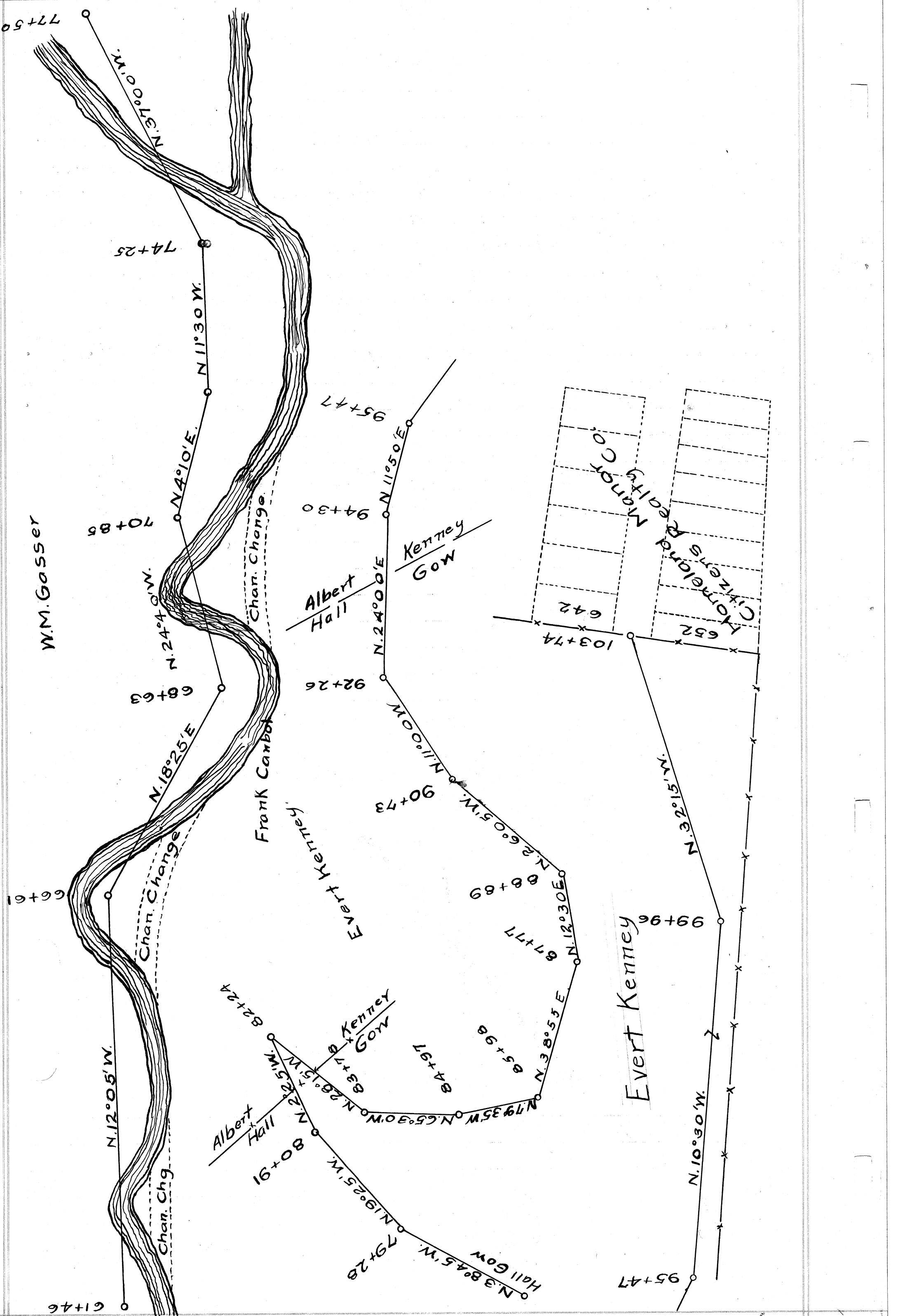
