

ROAD PETITION

For the alteration of a Road in Warren Township,

 TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the alteration of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning
 On the Public Road leading North from the Barnesville-Bethesda Road to the National Road in the Township of Warren, County of Belmont and State of Ohio, at a point in said road East of the barn located on the land of Dallas McMillen, thence leaving the present roadway in a Northwesterly direction to a point near a run, thence in a Northeasterly direction to a point in the present Public Road near the barn located within the lands of the said Dallas McMillen which lands are located in the Southeast quarter of Section 5, Township 8 and Range 6 in said County.

They also fixed the 23rd day of September 1929, at 10.30 o'clock A.M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Barnesville Enterprise a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than thirty feet nor more than sixty feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.
