Taylor, Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that Russell McHugh and others, have filed a petition in the office of the Commissioners of the County, on the 3rd day of october 19 42 for the vacation of a public road, along the following route, to-wit: Beginning "See previous page"

the same was this day considered by the Commissioners, and it appearing that said petition is regular and in conformity to law, and that the said Russell McHugh has filed herein a bond as required by law. It is ordered that the 5th day of January 1943, at 2:00 o'clock PM., be fixed as a date to view the same, at which date they will meet at the commencing point and go over the route of said proposed road.

They also fixed the 11th day of January 1943, at 2:00 o'clock P.M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Daily Times a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

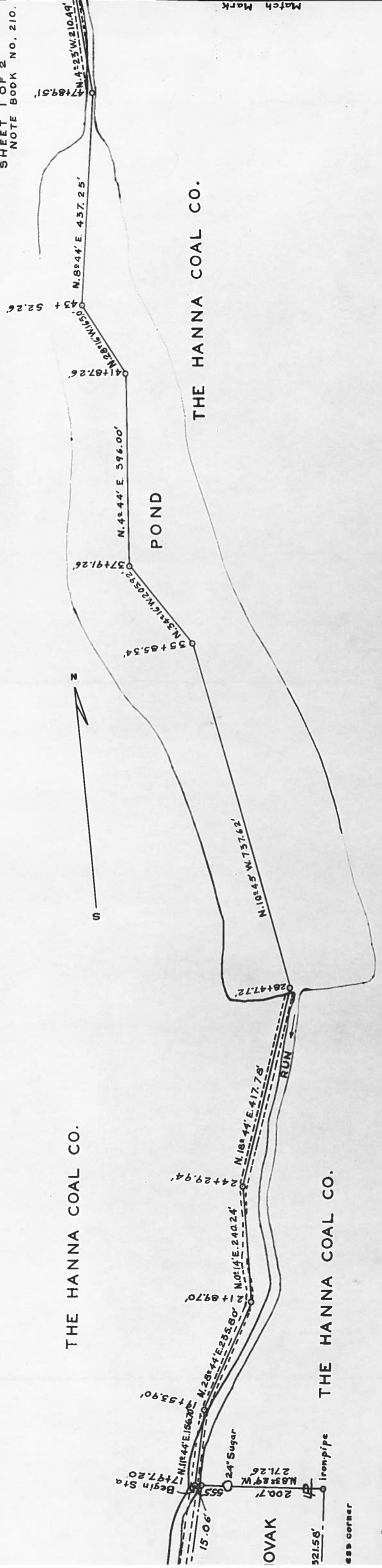

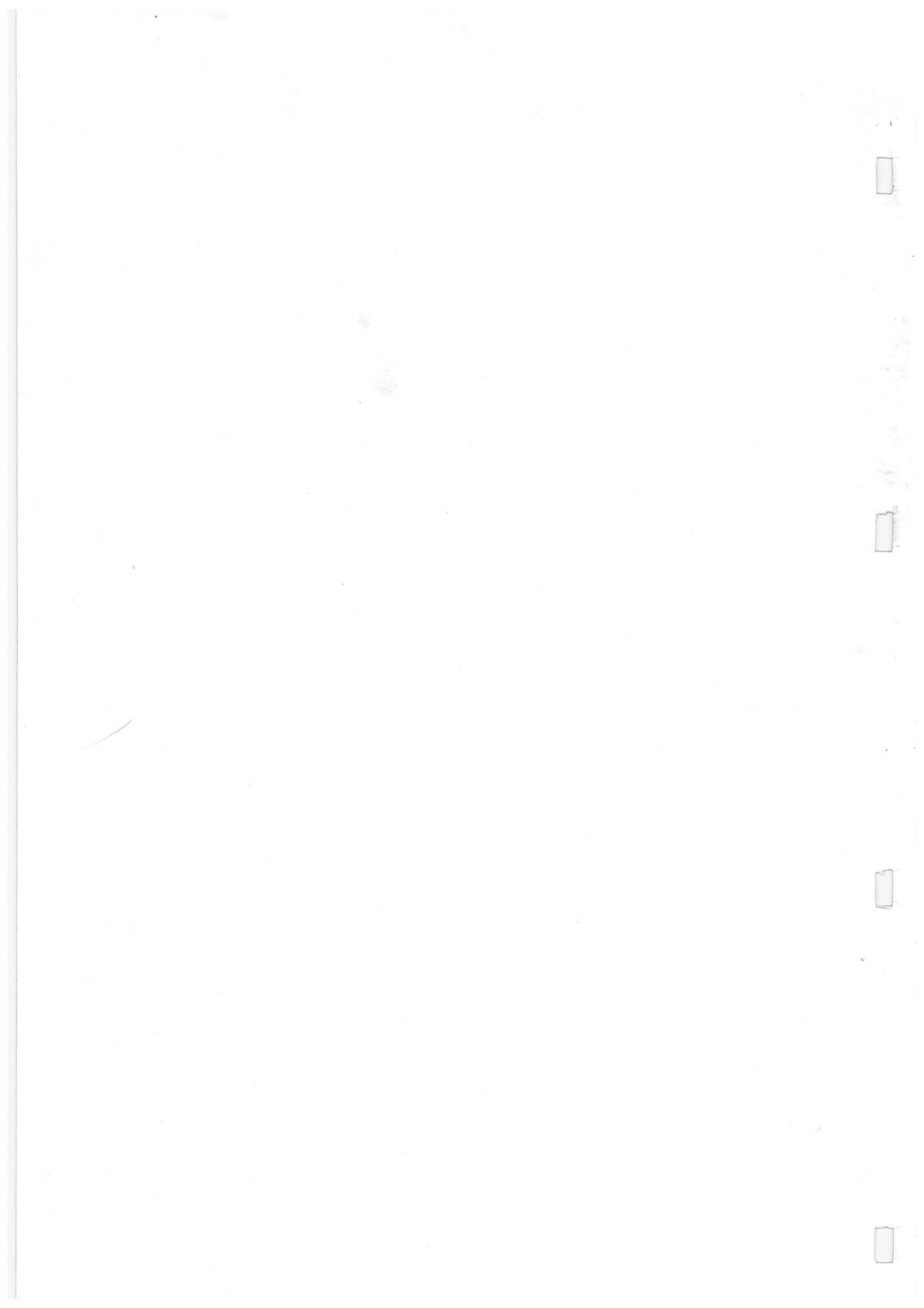

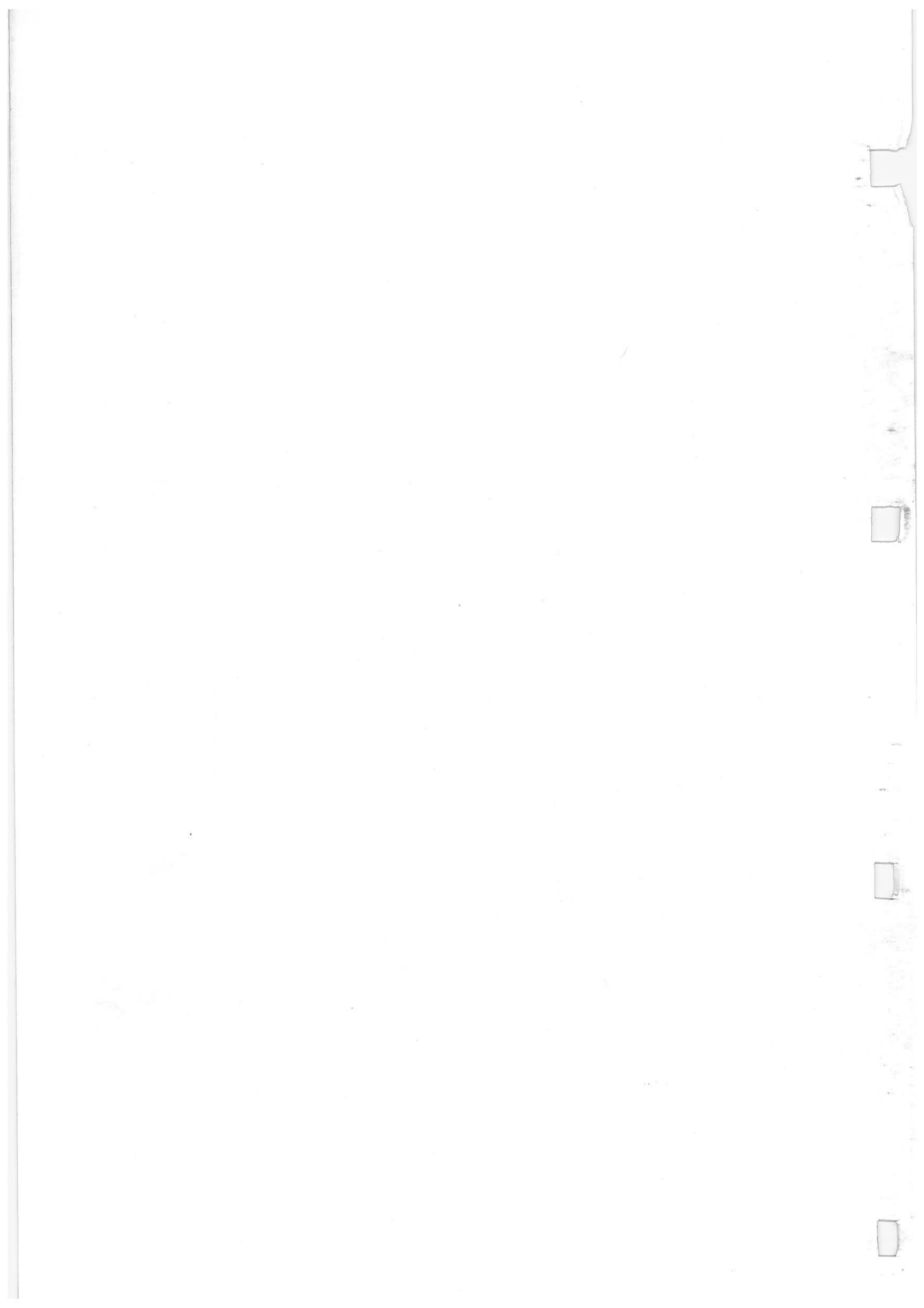
