Belmont Co, Ohio, Oct 31, 192001

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

The undersign petitioners, freeholders of said County residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience and welfare require the vacation and rededication of Flushing Twp Rds 803 & 366 a Public Road on the line hereinafter described, and make application to you to institute and order proper proceedings in the premises, for vacating & rededicating such road, the same not being a road on the State Highway System.

The following is the general route and termini of said road:

Beginning at

Vacation of Township Road 366

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Belmont and the Township of Flushing. Being part of Sections 7 and 8, Township 10 Range 6 and being a 40 foot wide right-of-way more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point at the intersection of the centerlines of Township Road 366 and Township Road 803 where a marked stone (found) at the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of said Section 8 bears South 77 degrees 18 minutes 05 seconds West 1645.78 feet.

Thence from said place of beginning and following Township Road 366 southerly, southwesterly, southeasterly, southwesterly, and southeasterly 3804.22 feet to the point of terminus on the westerly right-of-way line of relocated Township Road 366 where the above mentioned marked stone (found) at the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of said Section 8 bears North 26 degrees 32 minutes 21 seconds West 3467.50 feet.



It is further ordered that there be included in this order and made a part hereof the accompanying schedule setting forth the names if such benefited landowners, a pertinent description of such land and a statement of the amount of such compensation and damages to be paid by the owner, or owners, of each parcel of such land; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Engineer be and he is hereby directed to cause a record of the proceedings, including the survey and plat and accurate and detailed description of said proposed improvement, to be forthwith entered in the proper road records of said County; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Engineer proceed to acquire the necessary right-of-way in accordance with Sections 163.01 to 163.32 inclusive, of the Revised Code.
